The Permission Document that will result from this application when issued, will give permission to shoot specified game and vermin on land specified in the document, subject to conditions. The Permission Document that will be issued is for the purpose of satisfying Section 39 of the Firearms Act 1996, requirements relating to recreational hunting or vermin control.
