

**Department of Primary Industries Parks Water

Application for a Temporary Water Allocation

Use this form to apply for a Temporary Water Allocation (TWA) under Section 90 of the Water Management Act 1999 (the Act)

A Temporary Water Allocation may be granted by an Authorised Officer (A Regional Water Management Officer) to permit a person to take water from a water resource for a limited period not exceeding 6 months.

the permission may only be granted if the Authorised officer is satisfied that the taking of the water would:

- a) be consistent with any relevant water management plan; and
- b) not adversely affect the taking of water by other persons with a right to take water from the water resource; and
- c) not cause material environmental harm or serious environmental harm.

You are advised to contact your Regional Water Management Officer (who are all Authorised Officers) to discuss options for accessing water including limited period transfers, watercourse authorities or temporary water allocations.

If the application is being made by a company or partnership then all members of the partnership/joint venture must complete a membership details form and attach it to this application.

The offtake coordinates must be provided in Eastings and Northings using GDA 94 and can readily determined using the LISTMap web site at <https://maps.thelist.tas.gov.au/listmap>

Steps to Completing this Form

1. Complete the applicant details. These are the details of the individual, partnership or company applying for the Temporary Water Allocation. The Department needs your full name, Australian Business Number (ABN) if you have one, mailing address and contact details. If the Application is being made by a company or a partnership then all members of the partnership/joint venture must complete a membership details form and attach it to this application as outlined above.

2. Complete the details of the water allocation. Here you need to identify the water resource from which you intend to take the water along with the coordinates in Eastings and Northings using GDA 94 of where you intend to take the water. You must also state the volume you wish to take in Megalitres (1 million litres), the period over which you intend to take the water and the purpose for which it will be used.

3. Submit the completed and signed Application

There are two options for submitting the completed application along with the WAT output;

- Post the completed application with the prescribed fee, in the form of a cheque or money order made payable to DPIUWE), to DPIUWE, Water Management & Assessment Branch, PO Box 44, Hobart TAS 7001
- or
- Lodge the completed application, with the prescribed fee, at any Service Tasmania outlet.

Your basic personal information may be disclosed to other public sector bodies where necessary, for the efficient storage and use of the information. Personal information will be managed in accordance with the Personal Information Protection Act 2004 and may be accessed by the individual to whom it relates on request to DPIPWE.
