

Commercial Wallaby Hunters Licence

FACT SHEET AND APPLICATION FORM

If you wish to sell the skin, fur or carcass (meat) of any wallaby, you need a Commercial Wallaby Hunters Licence (CWHL). Please read this information before completing and submitting your licence application

What does a CWHL authorise the holder to do?

A CWHL authorises the holder to:

- take and possess wallaby for commercial purposes in accordance with the conditions of the licence during the open season; and
- sell the meat (carcass with skin) of any wallaby taken by the holder to an accredited game meat processor (human

consumption) or an accredited pet food works, within the meaning of the *Primary Produce Safety Act 2011*, or to the person in charge of the operation of any accredited game meat processor or accredited pet food processor, within the meaning of that Act; or

- sell the dead wallaby or part of the dead wallaby in accordance with your licence conditions

To take wallaby at night using a vehicle and spotlight, you must be the holder of a Crop Protection Permit for wallaby.

When is the season?

The Commercial Wallaby Season in Tasmania commences annually in late February. Specific season dates are available from the DPIPWE website.

Who can apply?

A person who holds a Game Harvester Skill Set (Game Meat Hunters and Shooters)* accreditation or equivalent.

When applying for a CWHL, you must identify:

- how you will be taking the wallaby;
- whether you will be taking wallaby on the Tasmanian mainland or on Flinders or King Island;
- the commercial purpose; and
- whether you are the holder of an appropriate game harvester accreditation.

How do I apply?

Complete and lodge the attached application form (not this fact sheet) in person

at any Service Tasmania service centre.

What will I receive?

If your application is successful, you will receive your licence and return documentation.

What do I have to do?

Comply with licence conditions.

A holder of a CWHL must complete a monthly return. Each monthly return details the month it relates to and the due date.

A new licence will not be granted if return details for each month have not been received.

Licence Renewal

There is not a renewal application form for this licence.

The attached application form must be completed and lodged at any Service Tasmania service centre each year.

Personal Information

Personal information we collect from you in

connection with your licence application will be used by DPIPW for the purpose of managing, assessing, advising upon and determining the relevant application and may be used for other purposes permitted by the *Nature Conservation Act 2002* and regulations made under this Act. You are required to provide this information by the *Nature Conservation Act 2002* and regulations made under this Act. Failure to provide this information may result in your application not being able to be processed. Your personal information will be used for the primary purpose for which it is collected, and may be disclosed to contractors and agents of the Natural and Cultural Heritage Division, law enforcement agencies, courts and other organisations authorised to collect it. Your basic personal information may be disclosed to other public sector bodies where necessary, for the efficient storage and use of the information. Personal information will be managed in accordance with the *Personal Information Protection Act 2004* and may be accessed by the individual to whom it relates on request to DPIPW. You may be

charged a fee for this service.

Wallaby means?



Bennett's wallaby (*Macropus rufogriseus*) Grey with black nose and legs, middle digit on front leg longer than the rest, reddish-brown on the neck, long grey tail.

And:



Tasmanian Pademelon or rufous wallaby (*Thylogale billardierii*). Stocky build, chocolate brown with golden fur underneath, digits all the same length on front leg, short brown tail.
