Additional text from the form: 'The licence holder must maintain records that demonstrate compliance with the licence conditions. The licence holder must provide the records to the Minister with the records in the event that the Minister requires them. The licence holder must be passed the records to the Minister on request.'

Your water licence gives you the right to take water under the *Water Management Act (1999)*. To be compliant with your water licence (**Who**), you need to take the specified amount of water (**What**) from the named water source (**Where**) at the right time (**When**).

Who

can take the water?

- only the person whose name is on the licence or persons under the licence holder's direction
- apply to DPIPWWE for an amendment

What

volume of water can be taken?

- only the volume stated on the licence under 'period amount'

Where

can the water be taken from?

- only from water source and location as stated on your licence
- contact DPIPWWE to discuss offtake locations

When

can the water be taken?

- only during the period stated on the licence

There are a number of conditions on licences, including requirements to keep records and to pass inflows.

DPIPWWE generally assumes most licence holders do the right thing most of the time. Education and informal warnings are often the first step taken with any licence compliance activity.

Formal action may be taken if a licence holder either intentionally or consistently breaches their licence. Formal action includes fines and a system of demerit points similar to that used for traffic offences.
