

# Permit to Take Wildlife

## TO PURSUE COMMON WOMBATS AFFECTED BY MANGE

### FACT SHEET AND APPLICATION FORM

If you would like to treat mange-affected wombats in the wild, you must be permitted to do so. Please read this information before completing and submitting your permit application

#### What permits are needed?

To treat a mange-affected wombat using a pole and scoop, a Permit to Take Protected Wildlife (PTT) for Common Wombats (*Vombatus ursinus*) is required. This permit authorises the permit holder to administer moxidectin (Cydectin®).

The use of moxidectin as a treatment requires a permit from the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) available from Wombat Protection Society of Australia LTD (WPSA). A copy of a current *Permit to*

*Allow Supply and Minor Use of a Veterinary Chemical Product for use in Wombats* must be attached for each applicant.

#### What does 'take' mean?

The term 'take' has a broad meaning under the *Nature Conservation Act 2002*.

'Take' for the purpose of this permit refers to pursuing. This does not include capture and possession of wombats.

#### Who can apply?

Community groups or individuals wanting to treat wombats can apply.

The Department cannot grant an application for a PTT unless the Secretary is satisfied that it is necessary or desirable to do so.

The Secretary retains the authority to reject any permit application and also to apply conditions to any permit issued. Allow 4 weeks for processing your application, from receipt of application to

completion of the permit assessment process.

#### Where can I treat wombats?

Permission must be sought from the relevant land manager(s) to access land.

The wombats must be treated *in situ*. This permit does not authorise the removal of wombats from the wild for further treatment.

#### How do I apply?

Complete and send in the attached application form (not this fact sheet).

If you require other people to hold a permit also, they must jointly apply as part of your application. Please ensure each person requiring a permit completes the additional permit holders form, (the last page of this application form) and send as part of your application.

You are required to provide this information by the *Nature Conservation Act 2002* and regulations made under this Act. Failure to provide this information may result in your

application not being able to be processed.

Your personal information will be used for the primary purpose for which it is collected, and may be disclosed to contractors and agents of the Natural and Cultural Heritage Division, law enforcement agencies, courts and other organisations authorised to collect it.

Your basic personal information may be disclosed to other public sector bodies where necessary, for the efficient storage and use of the information. Personal information will be managed in accordance with the *Personal Information Protection Act 2004* and may be accessed by the individual to whom it relates on request to DPIPWE. You may be charged a fee for this service.

### What will I receive?

If your application is successful, you will receive the main permit holder document in your name and an additional permit for each person who jointly applied with you.

### What do I have to do?

Comply with permit conditions.

Distribute additional permit holder documentation.

### Returns

Permit holders are required to complete the Data Sheet Example 1 to record moxidectin treatment in accordance with attachment 3 of the *DPIPWE Mange Treatment Protocols and Euthanasia Guidance: For the application of moxidectin (Cydectin®) to treat Sarcoptic mange in wild wombats (Vombatus ursinus) in Tasmania*, Version 3, Jul 2020. A copy of this data sheet is provided with the permit.
