

Under What Authority May I Construct, Modify, Repair, or Remove a Dam?

Are the proposed dam works -

- On a watercourse.
- Clearing or converting greater than 1 ha of native vegetation.
- Related to a dam with a wall height above 10 metres.
- Relating to a group of dams that collectively store, hold back or impede the flow of a single body of water.
- On land owned by another person, and that person has not given their written consent to the proposed dam works.
- Inundating land owned by another person and that person has not given their written consent to the proposed dam works or any inundation.
- Taking threatened species.
- Damaging or destroying nests of threatened species.
- Located wholly or partly within a gas pipeline planning corridor.
- Located wholly or partly within a heritage area entered in the Tasmanian Heritage Register.
- On land subject to a conservation covenant.
- For a dam to store treated effluent sourced from sewage treatment plants.
- Located on land containing an area of actual acid sulfate soil.
- Located on land that is within a mapped area of salinity.
- On land that is not exempt from requiring a Forest Practices Plan, as per regulation 4 of the *Forest Practices Regulations 2007*.
- Clearing and converting a threatened native vegetation community, other than in a circumstance prescribed under regulation 4 of the *Forest Practices Regulations 2007*.
- On land subject to an agreement under Part 5 of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993*.
- Dam works that have an ANCOLD consequence category other than Very Low or Low.
- Located less than 500 metres from a RAMSAR listed wetland or wetland listed in the "Directory of Important Wetlands in Australia".
- Located within the coastal zone, as defined in the *Water Management (Division 3 Declared Works) Order 2015*.
