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The proponent is required to submit an environmental impact statement (EIS), to the satisfaction of the Director, Marine Resources DPIPWE, consistent with section 23 of the *Marine Farming Planning Act 1995*.

The proponent must contact the Planning Authority (PA) prior to the submission of an application to prepare a draft marine farming development plan and provide preliminary details of the proposed draft marine farming development plan. The PA will use this information to prepare specific guidelines for the EIS to be prepared by the proponent.

The specific guidelines prepared by the PA should not be interpreted as excluding from consideration other matters deemed to be significant or matters that emerge as significant from environmental studies, public comment or otherwise during the course of the preparation of the EIS.

Items that must be lodged with this application:

- a. An environmental impact statement as discussed above.
- b. The prescribed fee, being **\$1,190.70 – GST exempt**
