

# LIVING MARINE RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT 1995

## GUIDELINE ISSUED UNDER SECTION 75

### FISHING LICENCE (VESSEL) CONDITIONED NON-TRANSFERABLE

### ABALONE-ONLY

I issue the following guideline under Section 75 of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*. This guideline replaces the guideline dated 24 July 2006.

#### 1. Short title

This guideline may be cited as *Minister's Guideline (Fishing Licence [Vessel] Conditioned Non-Transferable Abalone-Only) 2013*.

#### 2. Related matter

This guideline is issued so that the holder or the supervisor of a fishing licence (abalone dive) may apply for and may be granted one or more of a non-transferable fishing licence (vessel) for the taking of no other fish than abalone.

#### 3. To whom guideline is issued

In performing a function or exercising a power relating to any application for the grant of a fishing licence (vessel) by the holder or by the supervisor of a fishing licence (abalone dive), the Minister's delegate is to take into account, in addition to any other matter the delegate considers relevant, the following guideline.

#### 4. Guideline issued

- a) That in the case of an application for the grant of a fishing licence (vessel) by the holder or by the supervisor of a fishing licence (abalone dive), should the fishing licence (vessel) be granted, it should be granted with the following conditions:
  - i. it is non-transferable; and
  - ii. it can only be used to take abalone.
- b) The grant, renewal and variation of vessel prescribed fees are to be for the same period and amounts as for a fishing licence (vessel).
