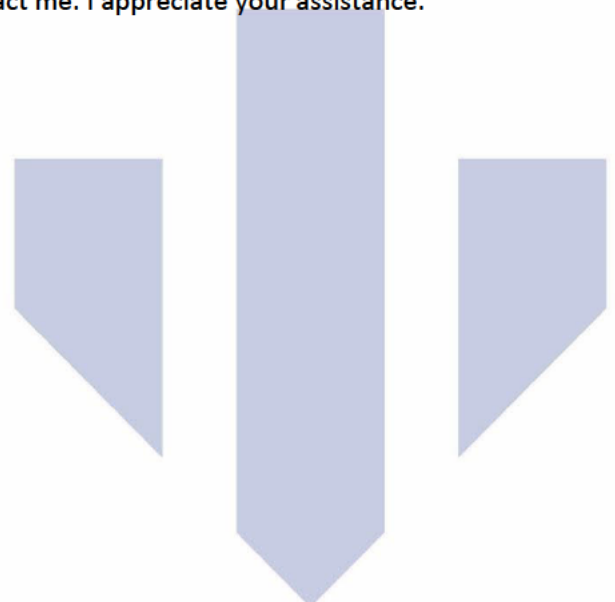
We are currently in discussion with parties to potentially rent the floors in this environment, which is critical to the economic stability of the building after all the closures that have occurred in our industry.
