

Savage River National Park

Reservation History

The Savage River National Park reservation history has been compiled from a variety of sources and whilst all effort has been made there can be no assurance that it is a complete and accurate historical record for this reserve.

History last updated 19 August 2010

Date	Description
30 April 1999	At the commencement of section 14 of the <i>Regional Forest Agreement (Land Classification) Act 1998</i> ; 17,980 hectares of Crown land (indicated on CPR Plan 4351) was declared to be reserved land in the class of national park and given the name Savage River National Park , and taken to have been so declared under the <i>National Parks and Wildlife Act 1970</i> .
31 December 2002	The <i>National Parks and Wildlife Act 1970</i> was replaced by the <i>National Parks and Reserves Management Act 2002</i> and the <i>Nature Conservation Act 2002</i> . At the commencement of the <i>Nature Conservation Act 2002</i> the reservation of the Savage River National Park under the former <i>National Parks and Wildlife Act 1970</i> was carried forward into the <i>Nature Conservation Act 2002</i> by virtue of Section 77 of that Act.
