



### TASVEG 4.0 now available

The Tasmanian Vegetation Monitoring and Mapping Program (TVMMP) is pleased to announce the latest update to the TASVEG mapping layer with the release of TASVEG 4.0.

### What is TASVEG?

TASVEG is a comprehensive digital map of Tasmania's vegetation. The map depicts the extent of more than 150 vegetation communities, including coastal heathland, eucalypt forest and alpine communities.

TASVEG is a digital mapping resource that underpins legislated native vegetation conservation provisions, policy, vegetation management agreements and monitoring at both State and Commonwealth levels. TASVEG is a vital tool for biodiversity research and monitoring, land use planning and sustainable management of Tasmania's unique natural resources.

### What's new in the TASVEG 4.0 release?

A comprehensive metadata statement and release notes have been prepared for TASVEG 4.0 and are available on the [TASVEG documentation web page](#).

The TASVEG 4.0 release includes updated information for:

- New or updated mapping for many areas across the state, including high priority areas such as King Island, the central plateau and extension areas to the TWWHA.
- Improvements to mapping of high conservation value communities, especially those vulnerable to the impact of wildfire e.g. *Athrotaxis* communities and *Sphagnum* peatland.
- Integration of significant mapping contributions from external stakeholders.

TASVEG 4.0 is available now via LISTmap and can be requested as a standalone file for use within a Geographic Information System (GIS).

### How can I access TASVEG?

### What about TASVEG 3.0?

TASVEG 4.0 is now the official vegetation map of Tasmania and its release signals the retirement of TASVEG 3.0.

The publication of the TASVEG 3.0 Web Mapping Service (WMS) on LIST will remain active until the end of August. Users who have applications or services pointing to the TASVEG 3.0 WMS should redirect all links to the new TASVEG 4.0 WMS to ensure continued functionality.
