2 main points:

Tasmanians should not be classed as visitors. That it an insult to the history of Tasmanian's bushwalking and the contributions they have made to building huts and tracks, weeding, maintenance etc in parks and reserves.

Development should be restricted to the fringes of national parks/world heritage areas, not within them. Any new huts should be for public use. Consider investing in more walks outside of Cradle Mt and Freycinet which are often overrun - increased tracks in areas such as Maydena, Strathgordon, Queenstown, Tullah, Rosebery, Zeehan, Smithton, Wynyard etc would bring much needed increased tourism and \$ to these areas.
