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If you have not registered and have not signed a declaration (see over), your payment will be subject to a 48.5% tax deduction (known as PAYG). Non-Individual Owners (ie a member of a partnership, a Syndicate) must complete a separate form.

2. I understand that under the Tax System if I am a hobbyist participant in thoroughbred racing, I will be unable to claim an input tax credit ("refund") for Goods and Services Tax that I pay on my purchases.
3. I declare that my supply of horses for thoroughbred racing is an activity done as a private recreational pursuit or hobby or is wholly of a private or domestic nature for me.
4. I declare that my involvement in thoroughbred racing is undertaken without reasonable expectation of a profit. I will not be making a taxation deduction for any expenses associated with my involvement with thoroughbred racing.
5. Should any of these circumstances change I will advise the controlling body for thoroughbred racing in my State immediately.
