

VISITING INTERSTATE JOCKEY INFORMATION

Any jockey wishing to ride at Tasmanian meetings must make application for a Jockey's Licence. Jockeys, Agents and/or Trainers should contact the Operations Department of the Office of Racing Integrity on 6777 1900 for full details of requirements and to obtain the necessary forms.

The following is required to be submitted in line with the National Jockey Licence procedures before processing can be actioned –

- Fully completed Application for a Jockey's Licence (No fee applicable)
- Must be currently licensed as a Jockey in home state
- Next of Kin information
- Emergency Medical information
- Copy of medical submitted with home state application and information regarding Baseline concussion test.
- Clearance from home state
- Digital passport sized photo for placement on licence card

(ORI will usually make contact with the State authority to obtain medical, clearance and photo)

Licence applications must be completed to the satisfaction of ORI by close of business at least one (1) clear **working** day prior to the race meeting.

Failure to provide the above information may mean that the Jockey may not be permitted to ride.
