The diagram below, *TASVEG 3.0 – Summary of changes to codes*, depicts the key changes made to the classification of mapping units from TASVEG 2.0 to TASVEG 3.0. Many of the changes have arisen as a direct result of a major review of the scrub, heathland and coastal complexes vegetation mapped by TASVEG, although other changes reflect improvements in the mapping of *Eucalyptus*-dominated communities since the release of TASVEG 2.0. A summary of the changes to the classification to the *Scrub, heathland and coastal complexes* can be found in the introduction to that section.
