RACE 1 – SHAREE MARSHALL BM 62 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Luxembourg – Bumped at the start. Failed to muster early speed. Rider Sherry Barr explained that after being tightened at the start, Luxembourg resented racing behind the field and then had to shift wider in the home straight and ran on well.

Smartie Artie – Over-raced near the 800 metres. Rider Anthony Darmanin explained that the gelding hung out throughout and failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed bruising inside the mouth to the left lower jaw and also swelling to the near side hind bumper.

Constant Velocity – Slow to begin (1L). Hung out in the early and middle stages.

Crystal Flame – Over-raced near the 800 metres.

Gotta Have Vibe – Shifted outwards on jumping. Hung out near the 600 metre turn.

RACE 2 – RACE REPLAYS@TASRACING.COM.AU 3YO MAIDEN - 1000 METRES

Foxy Income – Jumped away awkwardly.

Smell The Honey – Steadied off heels near the 550 metres.

Georgie Catania rider of Cheap Trick was found guilty of a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding the particulars being that after passing the 250 metres she permitted her mount to shift in tightening Glistening Star in onto Foxy Income. Then again approaching the 100 metres while riding along she allowed her mount to shift in contacting Glistening Star which in turn was checked and bumped with Foxy Income which became unbalanced. Stewards deemed the interference and carelessness to be of a mid level. Georgie Catania's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting commencing 21 August 2016 and expiring 28 August 2016. In arriving at penalty Stewards took into account Ms Catania's good record.

RACE 3 – MAGIC MILLIONS MAIDEN - 1350 METRES

Mac 'N' Muhcu – Shifted in near the 300 metres and brushed the running rail before shying away from it. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Mighty Hoffa – Rider S Maher pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on 7 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 2 more than permitted. Shiralee Maher was subsequently fined \$100.

Poacher's Lad – Restrained from a wide barrier. Rider Craig Luttrell was severely reprimanded under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used the whip on 6 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 1 more than permitted. Craig Luttrell was again advised that he must endeavour to adjust his whip action.

Gee Gees Pure Wish – Connections advised that it would be their intention to have the mare ridden further forward today.

Island Tiger – Forced wider by Miss Bluegrass approaching the 400 metres. Georgie Catania rider of Miss Bluegrass was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

Sorturo – Held up for a clear run behind Mighty Hoffa near the 300 metres.

Tymoshenko – Raced wide throughout. Momentarily steadied off the heels of Island Tiger which was forced wider near the 400 metres.

RACE 4 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE BM72 HANDICAP - 1350 METRES

Electric Crimson – Shifted out at the start bumping with Classic Outlaw.

Episodes – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after the gelding struck the gate leaving the mounting yard. Layed in from the 200 metres. Performed below expectations, rider Daniel Ganderton explained that the gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Harvey Bay – Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the gelding layed in in the home straight.

Geegees Classicboy – Commenced to over-race when being steadied near the 800 metres.

Classic Outlaw – Bumped at the start. Rider Georgie Catania stated that the gelding felt very poor in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 5 – TASRACING.COM.AU CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1350 METRES

Shakespeare – Rider Sigrid Carr stated that the gelding travelled well however failed to respond to her riding from the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have back muscle pain.

My Paige Three – Approaching the 1000 metres when racing three wide, raced ungenerously when being restrained. Jockey Troy Baker then elected to go forward.

Hello Gertie – Rider Shiralee Maher was severely reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding in that near the 40 metres she permitted her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of Toorak Affair resulting in that filly being carried inwards brushing with Shakespeare and being steadied by its rider.

Questions – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 6 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN & FUNCTION CENTRE BM62 HANDICAP – 1880 METRES

Golden Kiss – Bumped shortly after the start.

Dropaclanger – Inconvenienced after the start when Pashmak shifted out away from Kinglami. Stewards adjourned an inquiry into the whip use of rider Sigrid Carr.

Western Front – Rider R Plumb stated that the gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 500 metres and he felt there may have been something amiss with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Kinglami – Bumped shortly after the start.

Mediano – Declared a late scratching at 12.45 pm when it was reported that the gelding was lame in the off hind. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate must be submitted prior to Mediana racing again.

Pardon The Spun – Bumped shortly after the start. Steadied near the 300 metres when Kinglami shifted in marginally and Golden Kiss shifted out. Rider T Baker reported that the gelding over-raced in the middle stages and failed to respond to his riding over the concluding stages.

Songs 'N' Stories – Momentarily tightened when Dropaclanger shifted in near the 200 metres.

Lomasu – Jumped awkwardly and lost ground (1L).

Pashmak – Connections advised that it was their intention to have the mare ridden further forward today. Bumped shortly after the start. Tired over the concluding stages.

RACE 7 – LUXBET ALL WEATHER DISTANCE PRELUDE – 1650 METRES

Eternal Speed – Rider Sigrid Carr stated that due to the wide barrier, the gelding got further back in the field than intended and in her opinion is one paced and failed to run on. Stewards adjourned an inquiry into the whip use of Sigrid Carr.

Holy Cat – Stood flat footed and slow to begin (4L). Bumped near the 300 metres. Connections were advised that Holy Cat must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again due to its starting manners.

Solomon's Song – Near the 1550 metres shifted ground inwards when not quite clear of Dhanraj. Rider Troy Baker was notified to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

Don Reggio – Bumped near the 300 metres.

Dhanraj – Had to be eased to avoid heels near the 1550 metres when Solomon's Song and then Welcome Invader shifted ground inwards when not quite clear

Welcome Invader – Near the 1550 metres shifted ground inwards when not quite clear of Dhanraj. Rider Georgie Catania was notified to exercise greater care when shifting ground in similar circumstances.

RACE 8 – STRIDEMASTER@TASRACING.COM.AU CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1000 METRES

Shayana – Underwent a veterinary examination as had not raced for over 12 months and was passed fit.

Triple Bee – Underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Slow to muster early speed.

RACE 2 – MAGIC MILLIONS MAIDEN - 1650 METRES

Ismail Toker rider of Sorturo pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 8 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 3 more than the permitted number. Jockey Toker was subsequently fined \$200.
