RACE 1 – MAGIC MILLIONS MAIDEN – 1000 METRES

Canam – Held up between the 450 and 300 metres.

White Hawk – Raced three wide without cover. Rider Troy Baker was reminded of his obligations with respect to his whip use prior to the 100 metres in that he used his whip on 6 occasions.

Gee Gee Mightymiss – Raced four wide without cover. Rider Georgie Catania explained that she was instructed to ride aggressively from the barriers however was unable to obtain a forward position with cover and felt she was better suited maintaining her position rather than restraining to the tail of the field. She further stated that the filly raced greenly and was inclined to lay out rounding 600 metre turn and the home turn.

Giselle's Girl – Over-raced in the early stages. Held up between the 450 and 350 metres.

Orange Encounter – A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small cut to the inside of the lower lip/gum region.

RACE 2 – SHAREE MARSHALL F & M MAIDEN - 1150 METRES

Glistening Star – Bumped near the 500 metres.

Our Caption – A veterinary certificate passing the mare fit to race was submitted prior to this race.

Somatra – Shifted out abruptly on jumping bumping with Mariah's Magic. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Mariah's Magic – Bumped at the start and was hampered. Momentarily held up near the 500 metres before shifting wider and bumping with Glistening Star.

Pelagia – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Raced greenly. Rider Troy Baker stated that the filly raced flat and in his opinion may benefit from a spell.

RACE 3 – 2016 THOROUGHBRED AWARD DINNER 26 AUGUST BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1650 METRES

Kool Kash – Rider Raquel Clark was reprimanded under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on 6 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 1 more than permitted under the rule.

Robbo The Bold – Bumped at the start. Held up between the 400 and the 300 metres.

Charcol – Shifted out after the start. Raced wide in the early stages. Laid in near the 200 metres and steadied away from the heels of Quaternion Eagle.

Dehughes – Rider Anthony Darmanin viewed the official film of the finish prior to correct weight being declared. Over-raced in the early stages. Rider Anthony Darmanin pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 6 occasions which is 1 over the number permitted under the rules. After considering submissions on penalty, Anthony Darmanin was issued with a severe reprimand.

Scouting Around – Momentarily tightened near the 600 metres.

Beer Belly – Bumped at the start.

Princess Atilla – Tightened and became unbalanced after the start. Near 1350 metres carried wide and steadied off the heels of Charcoal. Momentarily held up near the 400 metres. Rider Ismail Toker pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 7 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 2 more than permitted under the rules. Ismail Toker was fined the sum of \$200.

Rialto Jess – Stewards granted permission for Ryan Plumb to ride ½ kilo over the allotted weight (55.5kg).

Toakio Tower – Slow into stride (1L).

Sid The Sloth – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 4 – R J PRINT & SIGNS C,G&E MAIDEN - 1150 METRES

Gee Gee Black Buty – Inconvenienced at the start.

Highly Leveraged – Slow into stride.

Life's Quest - Raced three wide without cover. Layed out rounding the 600 metre turn. Layed in near the 100 metres when rider Anthony Darmanin had difficulty drawing the whip through to his left hand.

Saint's Quest – Had to have its near side fore shoe replaced behind the barriers which delayed the start by approximately 6 minutes.

Westerly Haze – Shifted out after the start. Layed out throughout.

Westwood – Slow into stride. Carried in passing the 100 metres.

Powerful Prospect – Inconvenienced at the start.

Tough Vic – Proved difficult to load and contributed to the delayed start of the race. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the gelding's barrier manners. The gelding was declared a non-runner when it was established that its barrier gate opened slower than the other barriers denying it a fair start and resulting in the gelding being slow into stride (1L) with the rider becoming unbalanced. Tough Vic was therefore declared a late scratching at start time and all monies wagered were directed to be refunded in full.

RACE 5 – TASRACING.COM.AU CLASS1 HANDICAP - 1150 METRES

Specialist – Inconvenienced when passing the 1000 metres. Tightened and checked near the 900 metres.

Dharmini - Rider Nathan Punch accidentally dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

Mercury Queen – Slow into stride (1L). Approaching the 800 metres bumped and commenced to over-race for a short distance.

Count Montagu – Raced greenly throughout. Shifted in abruptly passing the 1000 metres. Tightened and had to be steadied near the 900 metres.

Sunset Party – Raced 3 wide without cover.

Hoodwinked – A post-race veterinary inspection revealed that this mare had bled from both nostrils. Trainer Dylan Clark was advised of the provisions of AR 53A (4) in that Hoodwinked may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any racecourse for a period of two (2) months and it may not start in any race for a period of three (3) months effective today, whereafter it is to satisfactorily trial over at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward.

Rider Raquel Clark pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding in that approaching the 900 metres she permitted her mount to shift ground inwards tightening Count Montagu in onto Specialist resulting in Count Montagu being restrained and Specialist being checked with both horses losing their positions, La Belle Moi which was following had to be checked by its rider. Stewards deemed the interference and carelessness to be of a mid to low level. Raquel Clark's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight 28 August 2016 and to expire at midnight 4 September 2016. In arriving at penalty Stewards took into consideration Miss Clark's guilty plea, her good record and Count Montagu's manners.

Gee Gees Cool Gal – Shifted out approaching the 800 metres and bumped with Mercury Queen.

La Belle Moi – Checked near the 900 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed that this mare had bled from both nostrils. Trainer Gary White was advised of the provisions of AR 53A (4) in that La Belle Moi may not be trained, exercised or galloped on any racecourse for a period of two (2) months and it may not start in any race for a period of three (3) months effective today, whereafter it is to satisfactorily trial over at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward.

Poacher's Son – Slow into stride (1L).

RACE 6 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1000 METRES

Rougeau – Jumped away awkwardly.

Concentrate – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Ariconte – Tightened on jumping between Rocklea Road and Secrets She Has. Shifted in slightly near the 400 metres.

One More Red - Approaching the 400 metres was steadied off the heels of Ariconte.

RACE 7 – LUXBET ALL WEATHER SPRINT FINAL – 1150 METRES

Valiant Warrior – Laid in in the home straight and proved difficult to ride. Performed below expectations, rider Jake Bayliss stated that the gelding travelled well through the race but failed to respond to his riding from the 300 metres and hung in. Rider Jake Bayliss was harmlessly dislodged on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Sound Bar – Raced three wide without cover.

Le Bel Opera – Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that the gelding travelled well through the run and in his opinion may have got to the front too quickly and then lacked the turn of foot that it had shown at its most recent starts. D Ganderton added that in his opinion the gelding races better when it has another horse to chase down. Co trainer Mr Leon Wells informed that the gelding will now be sent for a spell.

Vigilante – Knuckled on jumping away. Momentarily tightened and had to be steadied near the 800 metres.

Underplay - Slow into stride. Momentarily held up near the 200 metres.

RACE 8 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN & FUNCTION CENTRE CLASS 5 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

Maccy Fields – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

Gwemrae – Slow into stride.

O'Reillys Geegee - Over-raced in the middle stages.

Foreshore Dane – Stewards will inquire into the whip use of rider Anthony Darmanin prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 9 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN & FUNCTION CENTRE BM72 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Sigrd Carr rider of Steel Moon pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii), the particulars being that she used her whip on 7 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 2 more than permitted under the rule. After considering submissions on penalty and taking into account Ms Carr's record in relation to this rule, she was fined the sum of \$600.

RACE 6 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN & FUNCTION CENTRE BM62 HANDICAP – 1880 METRES

Sigrd Carr rider of Dropaclanger pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii), the particulars being that she used her whip on 6 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 1 more than permitted under the rule. After considering submissions on penalty and taking into account Ms Carr's record in relation to this rule, she was fined the sum of \$300.

RACE 7 – LUXBET ALL WEATHER DISTANCE PRELUDE – 1650 METRES

Sigrd Carr rider of Eternal Speed pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii), the particulars being that she used her whip on 6 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 1 more than permitted under the rule. After considering submissions on penalty and taking into account Ms Carr's record in relation to this rule, she was fined the sum of \$300.
