Mehmet Ulucinar was incorrectly shown in the race book as a claiming apprentice when he is now a fully licensed Jockey.

RACE 1 – DRC LEADING TRAINER ADAM TRINDER MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

Chaff Merchant – Slow into stride (1L).

Cheap Trick – Layed in under pressure over the final 100 metres. Rider Ismail Toker pleaded guilty to charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 6 occasions which is 1 more than permitted under the rules. Ismail Toker was subsequently fined the sum of \$100.

Dad's Girl – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination prior to racing and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Over-raced in the middle stages.

Island Princess – Slow into stride. Over-raced in the early and middle stages,

Military Pass – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination prior to racing as it had not raced for over 2 years and passed fit to take its place in the field.

Irish Jeff – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Raced greenly in the home straight.

RACE 2 – DRC LEADING APPRENTICE RAQUEL CLARK MAIDEN - 1350 METRES

Another Brother – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Passing the 400 metres had to be restrained and was then tightened for room between King Shaka and Poacher's Lad.

Fought For – Layed in under pressure over the final 100 metres. Rider Raquel Clark was advised to exercise care when permitting her mount to shift ground.

Kadann – Slow into stride (1L). Rider Jacob Rule reported that the bridle became unbuckled during the race.

King Shaka – Shifted out slightly passing the 400 metres. Rider Ryan Plumb was advised to exercise more care when allowing his mount to shift ground. Passing the 100 metres was momentarily inconvenienced when Sh'Bourne Dylaca was carried inwards.

Life's Quest – Inconvenienced on jumping between Fought For and Sh'Bourne Dylaca

Poacher's Lad – Shifted in slightly passing the 400 metres. Rider Craig Luttrell was advised to exercise more care when allowing his mount to shift ground.

Tranter – Slow into stride.

Westwood – Slow into stride (1L). Raced three wide without cover throughout. Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Sh'Bourne Dylaca – Carried inwards and had to be steadied near the 50 metres. Rider Troy Baker explained that he was instructed to ride the mare more positively from the barriers. With the addition of blinkers and being caught wide early he elected to push forward and sit outside the leader.

RACE 3 – SHAREE MARSHALL MAIDEN/CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1880 METRES

Kinglami – Approaching the 1100 metres was inconvenienced when Rialto Jess shifted out. Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that he was disappointed with the gelding's performance. He further added that the gelding was inclined to lay in in the home straight. Approaching the 100 metres he believed the gelding's run had ended and he was mindful of avoiding the heels of Quaternion Eagle and Storm Gust which were shifting ground slightly.

Pardon The Spun – Over-raced in the middle stages when being restrained. Rider Chris Graham was reminded of his obligations to ensure he does not excessively slow the pace of his mount which may cause interference to any other horse.

Storm Gust – Rider A Darmanin was dislodged on arrival at the barriers. Following an examination by the on-course medical officers he was passed fit to take his engagement. A veterinary examination of Storm Gust passed the gelding fit to take his place in the field. Stood flat footed and was slow into stride (2L). Over-raced passing the 1000 metres for a short distance.

Northern Command – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Rialto Jess – Shifted out near the 1100 metres. Rider Mehmet Ulucinar was advised to exercise care when permitting his mounts to shift ground.

Songs 'N' Stories – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

Sorturo – When questioned about today's performance trainer Michael Trinder explained that due to the lack of early pace in the race and the favourable draw it was his intention to have the mare ridden more positively. Mr Trinder added that he was disappointed with the performance and the mare will now be sent for a spell.

RACE 4 – DRC LEADING JOCKEY RAQUEL CLARK CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1350 METRES

The start of the race was delayed by 3 minutes due to Wyong running late.

Gee Gees Tell All – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Into The Night – Held up for clear racing room from the 300 to the 150 metres.

Jupiter's Moon – Slow into stride. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Bonify – Near the 1200 metres had to be steadied when buffeted and tightened for room between Gee Gees Tell All and Danwish.

Questions – Slow into stride.

Toorak Affair – Slow into stride.

Rocklea Road – Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that the gelding made the 400 metre turn awkwardly and he then elected to ease down. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 5 – GORACINGTASMANIA.COM.AU BM72 HANDICAP - 1350 METRES

Sound Bar – Shifted out under pressure approaching the finish.

Geegees Classicboy – Near the 50 metres shifted in away from Underplay.

Underplay – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. Layed in under pressure near the 50 metres.

Maccy Fields – Tightened on jumping away between Underplay and Sound Bar. Rider Sherry Barr explained that she was instructed to ride positively from the barrier. After working forward early the mare then commenced to over-race through the middle stages and failed to respond to her riding from the 400 metres. Sherry Barr further added that in her opinion the mare failed to back up from last week's run.

Mediano – Trainer Rowan Hamer submitted a veterinary certificate passing the gelding fit to race today. Slow into stride.

RACE 6 – DRC H.O.Y. LE BEL OPERA CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Nielson – Rider Chris Graham pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding the particulars being that near the 400 metres he permitted his mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of Steel Brom which was carried wider and had to be checked by its rider. Stewards deemed the interference and carelessness to be of a mid level. Chris Graham's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight 4 September 2016 and to expire at midnight 11 September 2016. In arriving at penalty Stewards took into consideration Mr Graham's guilty plea, good record and inexperience.

Tara's Gem – Underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to take its place in the field.

Triple Bee – Rider Mehmet Ulucinar was granted permission to ride ½ kilo over the allotted weight (55.5 kg). Slow into stride (1L).

Steel Brom – Checked near the 400 metres.

Farnor West – Slow into stride.

New Vision – Trainer G McCulloch submitted a veterinary certificate passing the mare fit to race today. Had to be re-saddled behind the barriers. Rider Sherry Barr explained that the mare failed to stretch out from the 800 metres however did respond to her riding in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. After commencing to lose ground from the 800 metres and being uncompetitive from that point on a warning has been placed on the mares race manner and connections were advised that if New Vision continues to race in this manner further action may be taken.

Before All – Rider Shiralee Maher was granted permission to ride 1 kilo over the allotted weight (54kg). Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RACE 7 – LUXBET ALL WEATHER DISTANCE FINAL – 1880 METRES

Eternal Speed – Rider Jacob Rule pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 8 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 3 more than permitted under the rule including 3 consecutive strikes. Jacob Rule was issued with a severe reprimand for the consecutive strikes and fined the sum of \$300 for over use.

Valdez – Shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Siorca – Slow into stride (1L).

Solomon's Song – Shifted out on jumping.

Golden Kiss – Inconvenienced on jumping away.

Sandeep – Over-raced in the middle stages.

RACE 8 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE BM72 HANDICAP – 1000 METRES

Correct weight was delayed when Raquel Clark rider of Teriki and trainer Barry Campbell wished to view the official film over the concluding stages. After doing so they were satisfied and correct weight was declared.

King's Spirit – Slow into stride (1L). Layed in in the home straight.

Seven Falls – Near the 600 metres was momentarily tightened for room by Teriki and then was placed awkwardly to the inside of that mare's heels until the 400 metres.

Teriki – Momentarily tightened for room passing the 100 metres when The Captain layed in.

The Captain – Layed in rounding the home turn and in the home straight. Layed in passing the 100 metres. Rider Ismail Toker advised to straighten mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

RACE 8 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN & FUNCTION CENTRE CLASS 5 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

Anthony Darmanin rider of Foreshore Dane was found guilty of a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 6 occasions prior to the 100 metres which is 1 more than permitted under the rules. Anthony Darmanin was subsequently fined the sum of \$100.

On Wednesday 24 August an inquiry into the riding tactics of Raquel Clark (Mediano) was concluded. After evaluating all the evidence tendered, in particular submissions made by Raquel Clark, her advocate Kevin Ring and trainer Rowan Hamer, Stewards could not be comfortably satisfied to proceed with this matter any further. However Miss Clark was instructed to show more vigour in the early part of the race and to ride her horses in a manner that does not invite room for query.
