### RACE 1 – LUXBET.COM MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES

The start of this race was delayed firstly when **Etown** proved difficult to load into its barrier stall and then further delayed when **Candlepins** also proved slightly difficult to load.

**My Kingdom** – Over-raced in the middle stages. Held up for a clear run and had to be steadied off the heels of Farewell Angelina from the 500 metres until the 400 metres. Rider Shuji Amano accidentally dropped his whip near the 100 metres.

**Berroco** – After being bumped at the start, was taken in over the heels of Hushama and lost ground. Shifted in abruptly near the 200 metres obliging Rider Daniel Ganderton to stop riding.

**Bravest of Hearts** – Shifted in on jumping and bumped with Berroco.

**Farewell Angelina** – Shifted out on the home turn brushing with Static React.

**Candlepins** – Slow to begin (2L). Raced greenly in the home straight and when approaching the 100 metres shifted in and bumped with A Matter of Time.

**O'witchway** – Slow to begin (2L).

### RACE 2 – SCHWEPES BM62 HCP – 2100 METRES

**Toakio Tower (NZ)** – Checked near the 1900 metres when Street Talent shifted out. Had to be steadied off heels when passing the 1700 metre mark.

**Street Talent** – Approaching the 1900 metres brushed the running rail and shied before shifting out. Lost ground from the 600 metres. When questioned, Rider Craig Luttrell stated that the gelding resented racing in amongst the field and did not respond to his riding from the 600 metres onwards.

\*\*\* Stewards upgraded the track rating to SLOW 7 at 1.05 pm \*\*\*

### RACE 3 – PFD FOOD SERVICES MAIDEN – 3YO & UPWARDS – MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1400 METRES

**Appmat** – Slow to begin (1L).

**Gee Gees Pure Wish** – Failed to respond to Shuji Amano's riding. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Intriguingly** – Missed the start (2L).

**Island Tiger** – Held up for a clear run from the 300 metre mark until the 100 metre mark.

**Speedy Future** – Shifted out shortly after the start, bumping with Mighty Hoffa.

#### **RACE 4 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS 3YO MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1200 METRES**

**Alexander Benjamin** – Hampered on jumping when Scuttlebutt shifted in and took its running.

**Tough Vic** – Late scratching at 2.10 pm after initially being reluctant and then failed to be loaded into its barrier stall. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on Tough Vic to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 2.10 pm were to be paid less seventeen cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less fifteen cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. The connections were advised that prior to starting again, Tough Vic must trial to Stewards' satisfaction in an organised trial.

**Angel of Abyss** – Fractious in the stalls and reared on jumping. The connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the filly due to its barrier manners.

**Scuttlebutt** – Proved difficult to load and kicked out striking a barrier attendant who had to be attended to by the Ambulance Officers. The connections were advised that a warning has been placed on Scuttlebutt. Jumped awkwardly and shifted in. Layed in over the concluding stages.

#### **RACE 5 – CUB CLASS 1 HANDICAP (DIVISION 1) – 1100 METRES**

**Dharmini** – Was inclined to over-race in the early stages.

**Nuclear Hero** – Missed the start (2L).

**Chelsarli** – Jumped inwards at the start, hampering Mel Loves Vodka who lost ground in consequence.

**Our Cheerio** – Had to be re-saddled behind the barriers.

**Husna** – Jumped awkwardly.

**The Stockman** – Nuclear Hero initially made contact with The Stockman's hindquarters before the gelding was tightened near the 600 metres when Husna was carried in marginally by Our Cheerio. The Stockman then commenced to over-race and had to initially be steadied off heels before commencing to over-race. All riders were advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

#### **RACE 6 – MMIB CLASS 1 HANDICAP (DIVISION 2) – 1100 METRES**

**Shakespeare** – Momentarily tightened near the 450 metres.

**Genuine Art** – Was withdrawn at 3.18 pm by order of Stewards acting on veterinary advice when the mare was found to have bleeding from its mouth from a tooth injury and after having its near hind leg cast in the barrier. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on Genuine Art to be refunded in full. All successful wagers made prior to 3.18 pm were to be paid less twenty one cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less seventeen cents in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket.

**Millrace** – Laid in under pressure approaching the 100 metres.

**Flying Eco** – Slow to begin (2L) and failed to muster early speed.

**Little Elsa** - Prior to the race, Mr T Evans, the trainer/owner of Little Elsa, advised that the filly did not handle the synthetic track at its previous start and raced further back than intended. Today his jockey

will endeavour to take up the filly's normal forward position. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race. Little Elsa was ridden accordingly

### **RACE 7 – TRC MEMBERSHIP BM62 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES**

**Lander Dollar** – Slow into stride (1L).

**Snippetee Bee** – Rider Sigrid Carr accidentally dropped her whip near the 250 metres.

**Manchero** – Jumped awkwardly.

**Gee Gees Style** – Prior to the gates releasing, Gee Gees Style lunged forward striking the gates and was then slow to begin.

**Vigilante** – Slow into stride losing one length and then bumped by Aquila Reale.

**Aquila Reale** – Slow into stride and then inconvenienced by Manchero at the start and lost one length.

### **RACE 8 – FATHER'S DAY CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

**D'inzeo** - Late withdrawal at 1.48 pm at the owner's request due to today's track conditions.

**Accounted Four** – Slow into stride (1L).

**Constant Velocity** – Bumped at the start.

**Kelly's Diva** – Shifted in at the start and bumped with Constant Velocity.

### **RACE 9 – BOOK NOW CAUFIELD CUP LUNCHEON BM72 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

The start time of this race was amended from 5.05 pm to 5.08 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Private Currency** – Slow to begin (1L). Victor Wong, the rider of Private Currency pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres which is two more than the permitted number under this Rule. After considering submissions on penalty and taking into account Victor Wong's record in relation to this Rule, he was subsequently issued a severe reprimand. .

**Tiger Jack** – A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities with the gelding.

Stewards adjourned an inquiry involving Jockey Daniel Ganderton, the rider of Tiger Jack in race 9 as he had left the course.
