Comments/Explanations

Kyle Maskiell was replaced on his engagement in Race 1 due to his late arrival on course.

Rider Rose Pearson advised Stewards that she would be unable to attend today's meeting as she had missed her flight from Melbourne.

RACE 1 – TASRACING.COM.AU LIVE STREAMING MAIDEN – 900 METRES

Bushranger Boy – A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small cut to the off side foreleg which required treatment on course.

Snowing Sun – Underwent a veterinary examination prior to racing and was passed fit to take its place in the field.

Millie Mateba – Raced ungenerously approaching the 600 metre turn then shifted out bumping with Kaoru. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor cuts to the inside and outside of the near hind fetlock.

Shanghai Lily – Placed awkwardly between runners approaching the 400 metres and had to be steadied.

Ty Dash – Caught wide in the early stages and raced ungenerously near the 600 metres.

Canam – Rider Raquel Clark reported that her mount hung out from the 600 to the 400 metres.

Stem Cell – Rider David Pires was granted permission to ride 1 kilo over the allotted weight (54kg). Bumped after the start when Bushranger Boy shifted in. Crowded shortly after the start when Kaoru shifted out.

RACE 2 – HAPPY RETIREMENT ANNETTE ANSELL MAIDEN - 1150 METRES

Glory Blaze - Rider Bulent Muhcu was advised to exercise more care when allowing his mounts to shift ground. Hung in approaching the winning post contacting Orange Encounter which shifted inward checking Turbogoebananas.

Saint's Quest – Commenced to over-race when being steadied off the heels of Glory Blaze near the 800 metre turn. Held up from the 550 metres until entering the home straight. Inconvenienced near the 300 metres when Glory Blaze shifted in despite the efforts of the rider. After being inconvenienced near the 300 metres, the gelding continued to be held up until passing the 100 metres.

Dad's Girl – Layed in under pressure in the home straight.

Glistening Star – Momentarily inconvenienced at the start when Orange Encounter shifted out.

Tonsils – Shifted in on jumping bumping with Saint's Quest. Caught wide in the early stages.

Irish Jeff – Proved difficult to load. Connections were advised a warning has been placed on the gelding's loading manners. Caught wide in the early stages, Layed in under pressure in the home straight. Rider Kyle Maskiell was reminded of his obligations about using his whip when not in contention.

RACE 3 – GO RACING MAIDEN/CLASS 1 - 1650 METRES

Ronaldo's Goal – Rolled in approaching the winning post on the first occasion tightening the running of Kinglami. Continued to lay in leaving the home straight tightening Gee Gees Tell All and Questions which lost its position.

Kadann – Caught wide in the middle stages and elected to go forward.

Questions – Raced ungenerously in the middle stages. Rider Jessie Philpott explained that the mare failed to respond to her riding from approaching the home turn and in her opinion Questions was one paced and may be due to be spelled.

Rialto Jess – Shifted out and bumped with Sh'Bourne Dylaca near the 150 metres.

Sh'Bourne Dylaca – Tightened and bumped by Storm Gust which shifted in abruptly near the 150 metres.

After inquiring into the interference near the 150 metres, Stewards advised riders A Darmanin and M Ulucinar to exercise care when shifting ground.

RACE 4 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN BM62 HANDICAP - 1350 METRES

Himation – Steadied off heels near the 200 metres.

Tara's Gem – Steadied near the 1050 metres after commencing to race keenly and clipped the heels of Tuesdaynitedelight.

Don't We Love It – Slow to begin (1L).

Tambro's Game – Disappointed for a clear run when tightened inside Don't We Love It near the 500 metres and also tightened on the inside when Himation shifted out.

Foreshore Dane – Fractious and reared in the barriers. Connections were advised that a warning was issued against the mare's barrier manners.

Tuesdaynitedelight – Galloped on near the 1050 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a skin cut over the near hind tendon. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate must be submitted prior to the mare racing again.

Beer Belly – Raced three wide throughout.

New Vision – When questioned about the apparent improved performance Trainer Graeme McCulloch could offer no explanation other than a change to a senior rider. Rider B Muhcu was

advised of the provisions of AR 137A(4)(b) in that when using the whip his hand must not be raised above shoulder level.

Sid The Slouth – Rider Shiralee Maher was granted permission to ride the gelding 1 kilo over the allotted weight (54kg). Slow into stride (1L).

Kyle Maskiell rider of Himation was reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding the particulars being that he permitted his mount to roll outwards after being steadied off the heels of Beer Belly near the 450 metres tightening Tambro's Game outward onto Don't We Love It.

RACE 5 – LUXBET CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1350 METRES

Into The Night – Over-raced in the early and middle stages and raced three wide.

Mercury Queen – Hung in approaching the 150 metres and had to be steadied off the heels of Black Hills.

Another Brother – Slow to muster early speed.

Black Hills – Had to be steadied off the heels of Mariah's Magic and commenced to over-race for some distance passing the 1000 metres.

Crib Point – Rider Craig Luttrell was granted permission to ride ½ kilo over the allotted weight (54kg).

RACE 6 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE BM72 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Teriki – Jumped away awkwardly.

The Captain – Inconvenienced and steadied off heels near the 750m.

RACE 7 – WAGYU PIE COMPANY BAKEHOUSE CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Exclusive Saturday – Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Rougeau – Slow into stride (1L).

Concentrate – Underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers and was passed fit to take its place in the field.

Secrets She Has – Caught wide throughout.

Ariconte – Tightened at the start when Morgatoche jumped inwards.

Gee Gee Sun Valley – Shifted out entering the home straight but was unable to establish a clear run to the inside of Secrets She Has.

RACE 8 – DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA BM72 HANDICAP – 1650 METRES

Electric Crimson – Caught three wide in the early stages and elected to race forward.

Valdez – Shifted out on jumping bumping with Charcol.

Gwemrae – Approaching the 1100 metres was restrained off the heels of Dehughes and was taken three wide and ridden forward from that point on. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages and then raced three wide for the remainder of the event.
