RACE 1 – FURNITURE CITY GRADE 6 515M

Real Stylist, Buckle Up Eve and Jay Em Dee were slow out. Soon after the start Real Stylist and Buckle Up Eve bumped. On the first turn Tee Cee Benny and Buckle Up Eve bumped. In the back straight Real Stylist checked off the heels of Lecktra Mick, checking Buckle Up Eve. Approaching the third turn Tee Cee Benny contacted the rail. On the third turn Buckle Up eve and Real Stylist bumped on several occasions, checking Buckle Up Eve. On the home turn Buckle Up Eve and Jay Em Dee bumped, checking Jay Em Dee and Tee Cee Benny. Buckle Up Eve underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration to a left hind toe. Buckle Up Eve has been stood down from racing for a period of 2 days. When questioned in relation to the race manners of Buckle Up Eve trainer representative Mrs R Johnson stated that the greyhound has a tendency to strike itself and with the addition of the injury sustained this may have had an effect on Buckle Up Eve racing wider rounding the third turn. Taking these factors into account and viewing the official replays Stewards took no action against Buckle Up Eve. Tee Cee Benny underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected.

RACE 2 – KINGSLEY JARMAN FENCING NO PENALTY FINAL M/6NP 278M

Nightmare Miss was slow out. Soon after the start Abbeys A Fencer and Tom Tom Drum bumped. In the back straight Trooper Class and Miss Houdini bumped. Approaching the first turn Miss Houdini checked off the heels of Trooper Class. On the first turn Nightmare Miss and Aware bumped, checking Aware. At the same time Abbeys A Fencer and Tom Tom Drum bumped, checking Tom Tom Drum and Miss Houdini. Approaching the home turn Bomb Tapp and Trooper Class bumped, checking Trooper Class. On the home turn Bomb Tapp crossed wide and checked off the heels of Miss Fencer. At the same time Abbeys A Fencer and Tom Tom Drum bumped. Bomb Tapp raced wide in the home straight.

Asgard Warrior, I'm Mad and Hawk Fencer were slow out. Soon after the start Fabulous Gem, Fergie's Vixen, Summer Swift and Nicky Dal's Girl bumped, checking Fergie's Vixen, Summer Swift and Nicky Dal's Girl. Approaching the first turn Summer Swift checked off the heels of Fergie's Vixen. Shortly after Nicky Dal's Girl and Asgard Warrior bumped, checking Asgard Warrior. On the first turn I'm Mad and Fergie's Vixen bumped, checking Fergie's Vixen. On the home turn Nicky Dal's Girl checked off the heels of Fabulous Gem, checking I'm Mad and Hawk Fencer.

RACE 4 – SIMONS CARPET ONE MIXED 4/5 600M

Shiny New and Flippant were slow out. Soon after the start He's A Boomer and Lady Rappa bumped and as a result He's A Boomer checked off the heels of Lashing Freda. On the first turn Frank Behave, Bearville Wigi, Lashing Freda and Lady Rappa bumped, checking Bearville Wigi, Lashing Freda, Lady Rappa and Flippant. Entering the front straight Shiny New checked off the heels of Frank Behave. Approaching the second turn Shiny New and Frank Behave bumped. On the home turn Flippant, Lady Rappa and Frank Behave bumped, checking Frank Behave. A post-race swab sample was take from He's A Boomer, winner of the event.

RACE 5 – LUXBET RACING CENTRE LAUNCESTON GRADE 5 (1) 515M

Trainer representative Mrs R Johnson was reprimanded pursuant to GAR 33(4) for presenting Yogo Hara with the incorrect identification card. Swift Move and Family Challenge were slow out. Soon after the start Storm Chief and Hat Trick Babe bumped. In the front straight Swift Mover and Yogo Hara bumped. Approaching the first turn Hat Trick Babe and Whistledown bumped, checking Whistledown. At the same time Swift Mover and Blatter bumped. Shortly after Family Challenge checked off the heels of Yogo Hara. On the second turn Bounding Boomer and Swift Mover bumped, severely checking Swift Mover which fell, checking Yogo Hara. Entering the back straight Whistledown and Blatter bumped. On the third turn Whistledown and Hat Trick Babe bumped. At the same time Family Challenge checked off the heels of Bounding Boomer. Swift Mover underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have muscle soreness to the left shoulder. Swift Mover has been stood down from racing for a period of 10 days. Family Challenge underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected.

RACE 6 – STEVE KING LADIES BRACELET HEAT 1 SE 515M

The start of this race was delayed approximately 3 minutes due to the lure having to be replaced.

Soon after the start She's A Trinket, Olivia's Dream and Chandalar bumped. Approaching the first turn Chandalar galloped on the heels of Furious Floss, checking both greyhounds. Entering the back straight Furious Floss checked off the heels of Let's Win Cash, checking Olivia's Dream. On the third turn She's A Trinket and Quiet Bay bumped, checking She's A Trinket. Approaching the home turn See Blue's Girl and Quiet Bay bumped. On the home turn See Blue's Girl, Quiet Bay and Magic Moz bumped. Entering the home straight Quiet Bay, See Blue's Girl and Furious Floss bumped. In the home straight Quiet Bay, See Blue's Girl, Furious Floss and Magic Moz bumped, checking Furious Floss. Shortly after See Blue's Girl and Quiet Bay bumped. At the same time Magic Moz and Furious Floss bumped. Approaching the finish Quiet Bay, See Blue's Girl, Furious Floss and Magic Moz bumped.

RACE 7 – STEVE KING LADIES BRACELET HEAT 2 SE 515M

Misty Fiord was slow out. Soon after the start Amity Class, Miss Myra and Howzat Patsy bumped, checking Howzat Patsy. In the front straight Profound eased. Approaching the first turn Miss Myra crossed to the rail checking Kinloch Angel and Profound. On the first turn Katey Roman and Amity Class bumped, checking Katey Roman. Approaching the finish Broadway Miss and Amity Class bumped. Profound underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr B Deverell in relation to the race manner of Profound in the front straight. Acting on their own observations, viewing the official replays and taking evidence from Mr Deverell Stewards were of the opinion that Profound had eased and in doing so had failed to pursue the lure with due commitment throughout the event pursuant to GAR 69A(1). Acting under the provisions of GAR 69A(2)(a) Profound has been stood down from racing for a period of 28 days at Launceston and until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

In the front straight Bongioletti and Spring Gully Jed bumped. Approaching the first turn Bongioletti checked off the heels of Spring Gully Jed. Entering the back straight Bongioletti and Spring Gully Jed bumped. In the home straight Diamond Image and Nellie Vee bumped.

RACE 9 – A TOTAL CAR RENTALS MAIDEN 515M

Trainer Mr M Eales was informed that he must submit a veterinary certificate confirming the injury within 48 hours to the Office of Racing Integrity pursuant to LR 25.6.

Queen Miela was slow out. Soon after the start Really Steely, Queen Miela and Satin Stylist bumped. In the front straight Bridwood Goldy, Shanlyn Poppy and Queen Matilda bumped. Approaching the first turn Queen Miela and Satin Stylist bumped. On the first turn Really Steely and Queen Miela bumped, checking Queen Miela. In the back straight Satin Styliat checked off the heels of Really Steely. Approaching the home turn Satin Stylist and Really Steely bumped. In the home straight Satin Stylist and Really Steely bumped. Bridwood Goldy raced wide in the home straight. Satin Stylist underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected.

Approaching the first turn Ferrari Mia, Nut Cruncher and Another Fencer bumped, checking Nut Cruncher. On the first turn Ferrari Mia, Bomber Heppell, Family Fantasy and Happy Hippy bumped, checking Bomber Heppell, Family Fantasy and Happy Hippy. Family Fantasy underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have a laceration to the left front paw. Family Fantasy has been stood down from racing for a period of 5 days.
