RACE 1 – LUXBET 3YO MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES

Angel of the Abyss – Declared a late scratching at 8.45 am after the filly was found to have an elevated temperature. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate must be tendered prior to Angel of the Abyss racing again.

Jansz – Bumped with Monobrow near the 500 metres. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight.

Monobrow – Jumped awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages. Bumped with Jansz near the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the filly to have blood in its mouth from a minor abrasions and a small ulcer in the left commissure.

RACE 2 – SCHWEPPE MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS – SET WEIGHTS – 1200 METRES

Etown – Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the gelding due to it being difficult to load. Inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.

No Alibi Needed (NZ) – On jumping shifted in, bumping with Heaps of Heart.

Farewell Angelina – Jumped awkwardly and bumped with Gee Gees Talk Fest on several occasions.

Gee Gees Talk Fest – Rider V Wong explained that the mare was reluctant to race close to the heels of Farewell Angelina near the 1100 metres and he elected to restrain. Approaching the 800 metres V Wong again reported that this mare was reluctant to race near the heels of Blushing Pink when that mare over reacted and shifted out when being steadied by its rider.

Kuusela – Laid in under pressure near the 150 metres. The mare continued to shift in for the remainder of the event.

Mighty Hoffa – Over raced in the early stages.

RACE 3 – PFD FOOD SERVICES MAIDEN – 3YO & UPWARDS, - SET WEIGHTS – 1600 METRES

Another Brother – Commenced to over-race before shifting out and inconveniencing Chaff Merchant near the 1100 metres. Held up from the 600 metres until approaching the 400 metres. Laid in near the 250 metres and bumped with Chaff Merchant.

Fought For - Rider Raquel Clark was reminded of the provisions of AR 137A(4)(c) in that she used the whip when out of contention. Rider reported that the gelding failed to handle today's track

conditions. Stewards inquired into the reasons why Fought For had to be steadied before losing its position at the 500 metres. It was established that Powerful Prospect to its outside had laid in marginally and there had also been a marginal shift from Geegees Close Call which carried King Shaka out slightly. Stewards deemed no one rider culpable for the incident and all riders were advised to exercise care when shifting ground in the future.

Geegees Close Call - Rider Victor Wong reported that the gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres and in his opinion did not handle today's track conditions. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer Trent Wells reported that the gelding will now be retired.

Highly Leveraged – Shortly after jumping steadied away from the heels of Fought For after being carried out when Quaternion Eagle carried King Shaka outwards. Rider Anthony Darmanin reported during this incident that his off side iron became momentarily caught in the tail of Fought For. Bumped with King Shaka when entering the back straight.

King Shaka – Commenced to over-race approaching the 1400 metres when being steadied off the heels of Geegees Close Call.

Street Talent – Shifted out upon entering the home straight and bumped with Intriguingly. When questioned in regards to the tactics adopted today rider S Maher explained that she was instructed to ride the mount forward as the gelding had performed better when ridden forward in Victoria.

Westwood - Kyle Maskiell was issued with a severe reprimand under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres which is one more than permitted.

RACE 4 – AUSTRALIAN RACING TOURS CLASS 5 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Beluga Miss – Blundered on jumping. Elected to shift back to the inside from behind the heels of Gee Gees Jet near the 200 metres.

Bella Venus – Jumped awkwardly

Sunday Cider – Over raced in the early stages.

RACE 5 – FUJI XEROX HOBART BM62 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES

Ashalar – Rider Brendon McCoull explained that he elected to go to the inside in the home straight as the gelding resented racing in amongst other horses. Brendon McCoull further explained that it was the connections' intention to evaluate the gelding's immediate racing future.

Accounted Four – Slow to begin (1L). Inconvenienced when the pace eased near the 1500 metres.

Big Pegg – Inconvenienced when the pace eased near the 1500 metres. When racing in restricted room, was held up for some distance and bumped with Dropaclanger entering the home straight. Rider David Pires reported that the mare failed to handle today's track conditions.

Pretoria Miss – Slow to begin (1L)

Toakio Tower – Slow to begin (2L)

Dropaclanger – Slow to begin then steadied off the heels of Big Pegg.

Princess Atilla – Checked near the 500m when attempting a narrow run between Big Pegg and Dropaclanger when Big Pegg was carried out by Ashalar and Solomon's Song, at the same time Big Pegg had to be steadied away from the heels of Welcome Invader (R Clark) who shifted in when insufficiently clear. Raquel Clark was issued a reprimand for careless riding.

RACE 6 – RAINE & HORNE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Gotta Have Vibe – Declared a late scratching at 10.15am due to no available rider.

Genuine Art – Jumped in at the start and bumped with Parisian Lush. Rider Anthony Darmanin reported that the mare travelled well throughout the event but failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres. Mr Darmanin further added that the mare returned to the mounting yard with its tongue over the bit. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer Scott Brunton confirmed that the tongue was over the bit and that the mare had pulled up well.

Gee Gees Cool Gal – Rider Kyle Maskiell reported that he accidentally dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

Chelsarli – Jumped away awkwardly and lost ground (2L). Rider Mehmet Ulucinar reported after correct weight that he did not have his gear prior to the start being affected and was placed at a disadvantage. Mr Ulucinar was advised to bring such matters to stewards' attention prior to correct weight being declared.

Sparkling Moon – Bumped at the start with O'Lohn Star. Rider Troy Baker explained that the mare was reluctant to stretch out in the early stages of the event and in his opinion was displaying signs of attempting to buck. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Galeocerdo – Jumped out at the start and bumped with Sunday School.

Parisian Lush – Bumped at the start and lost its position between Genuine Art and Danzqui when Danzqui shifted out. Momentarily steadied when Hushama shifted out near the 400 metres.

O'Lohn Star – Jumped away awkwardly and became unbalanced when bumping with Gee Gees Cool Gal.

Little Elsa – Shifted in at the start.

Hushama – Steadied away from the heels of Danzqui when that mare shied away from O'Lohn Star near the 1000 metres.

***** Stewards downgraded the track rating to HEAVY (9) at 4.15 pm *****

RACE 7 – CUB BM82 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Lander Dollar – Performed below market expectations, trainer Scott Brunton reported that the gelding was very disappointing and never let down at any stage of the race. Mr Brunton further added that the gelding will now be retired.

Vigilante – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. When queried on his lack of vigour over the concluding stages, Ismail Toker stated that Vigilante was making a respiratory noise, therefore he did not ride it out fully to the line. Stewards advised Ismail Toker that under the provisions of AR 140(b) if he believes there is something that has affected his mount he must report it to Stewards on return to scale. Mr Toker further added that in his opinion the gelding did not handle the track conditions combined with distance of today's event. Trainer Scott Brunton agreed with Mr Toker's explanation.

Meconsul – Rider Georgie Catania reported that the gelding over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Flying Cruiser – Slow to begin (2L)

RACE 8 – ROGERSON & BIRCH SURVEYORS CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Geeges Lillybet - Jumped in at the start carrying Kelly's Diva in on to Miss Choosey.

The Stockman – Lost its position shortly after the start when Speedhump rolled in marginally.

Sid The Sloth – Slow to begin and then inconvenienced when Sphero shifted out.

SUPPLEMENTARY REPORTS

Apprentice Kyle Maskiell pleaded guilty to a charge under LR 25(2)(h) and was issued with a severe reprimand for smoking whilst riding trackwork at the Longford Training Centre recently.

Apprentice Kyle Maskiell pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 82 and was fined \$100 for using an electronic device (mobile phone) whilst riding trackwork at the Longford Training Centre recently.

At an inquiry on 30 August at the Office of Racing Integrity, track work rider Trent Wells pleaded guilty under AR 81A(i)(a) in that whilst riding track work on 3 June 2016 at Devonport, he had a prohibited substance in his system, namely codeine and morphine. After taking evidence from Mr Trent Wells and on advice from Racing Analytical Services, Stewards were satisfied that this had occurred due to Mr Wells' use of over-the-counter cold and flu medications. After taking this into account as well as his forthright evidence, Stewards issued a reprimand on this occasion.
