### Comments / Explanations:

### RACE 1 – WALK THE BOARDWALK @ LAUNCESTON SEAPORT MAIDEN – 1220 METRES

**British** – Inconvenienced over last 100 metres.

**Argillite** – Difficult to load. Warning issued.

**Somatra** – Slow to begin (1L).

**Annie's Shiraz** – Restrained near 1000 metres. Performed below expectation, apprentice Jessie Philpot explained that the filly failed to respond to her riding from the 600 metres. Ms Philpot added that she would suggest to connections that a nose band be fitted which may assist the filly.

**Gemini** – Apprentice Raquel Clark rider of Gemini pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding the particulars being approaching the 1000 metres she permitted her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of **Annie's Shiraz** resulting in that filly having to be restrained. The rider's licence of Ms Clark was suspended for a period of 1 Tasmanian race meeting commencing midnight 19 October 2016 and expiring midnight 26 October 2016.

**Kirby Jane** – Jumped inwards, shortly after eased off heels of **Annie's Shiraz** which jumped outwards. Rider explained that after sustaining some interference shortly after the start the filly failed to respond to her riding for the remainder of the race.

**Radiate** – Unable to be loaded. Late scratching 6.21pm. Deductions 4 cents win, 5 cents place. Trial to Stewards satisfaction before starting again.

**Run Dora Run** – Commenced to weaken from 400 metres. Warning poor performance. Rider Georgie Catania could offer no explanation. Connections now advised the filly will be retired.

### RACE 2 – CUBE SEAPORT CLASS 2 HCP – 1220 METRES

**Shiralee** – Tightened after start.

**Cameo Kiss** – Began moderately. Restrained near 800 metres off the heels of **Hushama**. Rider explained that it was connections intention to ride back in the field given that it was first up from a spell.

**Tuscan Classic (NZ)** – Apprentice Sigrid Carr reported that the gelding raced greenly and displayed a tendency to hang in throughout the race.

**Qui Samer** – Inconvenienced near 700 metres. Held up rounding home turn. Disappointed for a run approaching 100 metres.

**Alilad** – Raced awkwardly near the 700 metres.

### **RACE 3 – SEAPORT RESTAURANTS MAIDEN – 1420 METRES**

**Saint's Quest** – Inconvenienced after start.

**Totally Wicked** – Slow to begin (1L). Performed below market expectations. Apprentice Raquel Clark explained that she was instructed to have the gelding in a handy position, however after missing the start she was unable to fulfil those instructions. Ms Clark further added that the gelding over raced during the early and middle stages and from the 400 metres failed to respond to her riding.

**Smart Selection** – Examined by vet prior to race as had not started for over 12 months. Slow to begin (1L).

### **RACE 4 – LUXBET BM72 HCP – 1420 METRES**

**Just Call Me Fred** – Shifted out near 1200 metres rider will be reprimanded. Performed below expectations rider Ismail Toker explained that it felt flat and failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres.

**Magnasa** – Held up for a run approaching the 100 metres.

**Dillon Hall** – Raced wide throughout.

**O'Reillys Geegee (NZ)** – Over raced near the 1200 metres.

**Himation** – Sustained an injury to its hind legs.

**Sentry Duty** – Restrained near 1200 metres.. Craig Luttrell rider of Sentry Duty pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding. The particulars being that near the 400 metres he permitted his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of **The Stockman** resulting in that gelding having to be restrained. The rider's licence of Mr Luttrell was suspended for a period of 1 Tasmanian race meeting commencing midnight 19 October 2016 and expiring midnight 26 October 2016.

**The Stockman** – Slow to begin (1L). Over raced near 1000 metres, struck running rail. Restrained near 400 metres.

### **RACE 5 – MUD BAR & RESTAURANT CLASS 1 HCP – 1420 METRES**

**Ariconte** – Performed below expectations. Rider could offer no explanation. Subsequent to meeting trainer reported had pulled up well however will give the gelding a brief let up

**Life's Quest** – Over raced at various stages. Held up rounding home turn. Rider Daniel Ganderton reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out to the end of the race.

### **RACE 6 – FISH 'N' CHIPS @ LAUNCESTON SEAPORT CLASS 5 HCP – 1120 METRES**

**Concentrate** – Inconvenienced shortly after start.

**Rikishi** – Queried riding tactics. Rider Craig Luttrell explained that he was instructed to lead given that the mare had performed well some time ago when ridden aggressively. Rider further added that mare commenced to weaken from 400 metres and that in his view had held its breath during the race which may have contributed to it weakening. Trainer Steven Davis reported that in its four runs since arriving in Tasmania it has been connections intention to ride forward and attempt to lead, however this intention

has not been fulfilled due to drawing wide barriers and being slow to begin. Mr Davis added that he would evaluate the mare's immediate racing future with his stable.

### **RACE 7 – LEVEE FOOD COMPANY BM62 HCP – 1220 METRES**

**Son Of Faith** – Over-raced from 1000 metres. Unable to obtain a clear run for the entire home straight.

**Sunset Party** – Reared over in stripping stalls, veterinary examination passed fit to run.

**Sparkling Moon** – Slow into stride.

After viewing the Stewards patrol films Apprentice Shiralee Maher, rider of second place getter **Hello Gertie** lodged a protest against **Speckie** being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference over the concluding stages. It was established that passing the 50 metres **Speckie** shifted in and brushed **Hello Gertie**, however the Stewards could not be satisfied that the interference suffered was greater than the winning margin and the protest was dismissed.

### **RACE 8 – DINE OUT AT LAUNCESTON SEAPORT MDN/CL1 HCP – 2130 METRES**

**Geegees Lillybet** – Raced wide throughout.

**Kadann** – Difficult to load. Warning continued to be issued. Slow to begin (2L).

**Northern Command** – Due to slow pace over raced from the 1900 metres for some distance before being allowed to stride to the lead from 1200 metres.

**Rialto Jess** – Apprentice Sigrid Carr used the whip on eight occasions prior to the 100 metres. Fined the sum of \$200.

**Tranter** – Commenced to weaken from 600 metres. Warning issued for poor performance.
