Comments / Explanations:

**Apprentice Kyle Maskiell was severely reprimanded pursuant to AR 120(b) for accepting a ride for which he was unable to make the weight.*

RACE 1 – BIG BARGIN BOTTLE SHOPS 2YO DEBUTANTE – 900 METRES

Geegee Blackprince – Unable to be reshod, declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 11.16am. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested on Geegee Blackprince to be refunded in full. All bets made prior to 11.16am were to be paid less 14 cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and 16 cents in the dollar on the value of the place ticket.

Geegee Rock'n'Run – Tightened and had to be restrained approaching the 200 metres when **Gee Gee Musicmaker** (V Wong(a)) laid in under pressure. V Wong (a) advised to exercise more care when in similar circumstances.

Moshrocket – Over-raced and raced greenly in the early and middle stages. Near the 400 meters over raced and had to be steadied when attempting a tight run to the inside of **Geegee Rock'n'Run**. Rider Craig Luttrell was found guilty of a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding. The particulars being near the 600 metres he permitted his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of **Gee Gees Queenie** resulting in that filly having to be steadied by its rider and losing its position. Craig Luttrell's licence to ride in races was suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting. Commencing at midnight 9 November 2016 and expiring at midnight on 13 November 2016.

Gee Gee Lanett – Layed in in the home straight.

Gee Gee Musicmaker – Layed in in the home straight.

Gee Gees Queenie – Steadied and lost its position when tightened for room near the 600 metres.

RACE 2 – INSURANCE SOLUTIONS TASMANIAN MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Scott Market – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with **West Burton**.

Trusted Warrior – Shifted in after start.

West Burton – Bumped on jumping away. Performed below market expectations. Rider Sigrid Carr stated that the gelding failed to respond to her riding throughout the event. Subsequent to the race trainer Stuart Gandy stated that the gelding had pulled up well and it was his intentions to step the gelding up in distance.

Static React – Slightly slow to begin then hampered soon after the start.

Jo Anconi - Treated post-race by veterinary surgeon after showing signs of colic, must produce veterinary clearance prior to racing again.

RACE 3 – JET COURIERS MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Crown Of Hearts – Rider Craig Luttrell explained that the gelding over-raced in the early stages and was inclined to hang out. Craig Luttrell further added that he elected to ease the gelding down in the home straight after the gelding made a respiratory noise. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have an irregular heart rate and suspected atrial fibrillation, must produce veterinary clearance post 1000m gallop prior to racing again.

No Alibi Needed – Jumped inwards at the start.

Shorty Knox – Hampered on jumping away.

Argillite – Rider Brendon McCoull stated that the mare hung in in the home straight. Shifted out near the 200 metres when not fully clear of **My Kingdom**, rider advised to exercise more care when permitting his mounts to shift ground.

Heaps Of Heart – Apprentice Nathan Punch was dislodged when leaving the mounting yard, cleared by medical officers. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider reprimanded for using whip six times prior to 100m.

RACE 4 – DOUGGIES OFFICE EQUIPMENT WAREHOUSE BM62 HCP – 1200 METRES

Am I There Yet – Slow into stride (1L).

Bella Venus – Apprentice Kyle Maskiell pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres, fined \$100.

Aquila Reale – Jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride (2L). Performed below market expectations. Apprentice Raquel Clark stated that the mare was in season and was reluctant to stretch out.

Boart – Three wide without cover throughout. Jockey Craig Luttrell accidentally dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

White Turf – Bumped near 400 metres.

Triple Bee – Slow into stride (1L). Approaching the 400 metres was momentarily held up and had to steady off the heels of **Milson** and as result bumped with **White Turf**.

RACE 5 – GORACINGTASMANIA.COM.AU CLASS 1 HCP – 1100 METRES

Under Milkwood – Knuckled on jumping and as a result was slow into stride. Steadied off heels near the 800 metres when over racing, then raced wide without cover for the remainder. Apprentice Shiralee Maher stated that it was her intention to have the gelding further forward however, after beginning poorly she was unable to take up a forward position early.

Marmalady – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Laid out rounding the home turn carrying **Under Milkwood** wider on the track. Apprentice Nathan Punch stated that the mare failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer Gary White stated that the gelding had pulled up well and in his opinion did not appreciate the girth cover. Mr White intends to continue with the preparation.

Kepta – Held up for clear racing room approaching the winning post.

Faith In Georgina – Knuckled on jumping away and as a result lost ground (2L).

A Matter Of Time – Stewards intend to inquire into the reasons for **A Matter Of Time** having to be restrained near the 900 metres.

RACE 6 – WLF ACCOUNTING & ADVISORY GOODWOOD HCP – 1100 METRES

The start of this race was delayed 6 minutes due to **Hellova Street** having to be reshod.

Hellova Street – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Geegees Doublejay – Jumped away awkwardly and lost ground (2L).

Valiant Warrior – Shifted in near the 800 metres. Apprentice Kyle Maskiell was advised to exercise more care when allowing his mounts to shift ground. Performed below expectations. Rider stated that he was disappointed with the gelding performance after travelling well however it failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres and he elected to ease the gelding down over the final 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a slow heart rate recovery. Subsequent to the race meeting trainer Adam Trinder stated that the gelding had pulled up well and it was his intentions to continue with the preparation.

Gee Gee Red Prince – Momentarily tightened near the 800 metres.

Silver Bolt – Shifted in near the 1000 metres when not fully clear of Geegees Soprano. Rider Mehmet Ulucinar was reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding. Bumped near the 300 metres. Laid in over the final 100 metres.

Tshahitsi – Held up for clear racing room approaching the 200 metres until passing the 100 metres.

Gee Gees Top Notch – Tightened on jumping away and lost ground (1L). Rider Sigrid Carr was found guilty of a charge under AR 137(a) careless riding. The particulars of the charge being that near the 300 metres she permitted her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of **Geegees Soprano** resulting in that gelding being tightened between **Gee Gees Top Notch** and **Silver Bolt** and having to be checked by its rider. Sigrid Carr's licence to ride in races has been suspended for 1 Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight on 2 November 2016 and expire at midnight on 9 November 2016. In determining penalty Stewards took into consideration Ms Carr's good record under this rule.

Geegees Soprano – Momentarily tightened near the 1000 metres. Bumped near the 400 metres. Tightened and had to be checked near the 300 metres.

Private Currency – Bumped near the 400 metres. Stewards intend to inquire in to the whip use of Victor Wong.

RACE 7 – OFFICE NATIONAL HOBART BM72 HCP – 2100 METRES

Holy Cat – Slow into stride (1L).

Accounted Four – Hung out in the home straight. Rider Sigrid Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres, fined \$100.

Electric Crimson – Rider David Pires was reprimanded under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres. Severely reprimanded pursuant to AR 137(b) for failing to ride his mount out to the finish in particular the last two strides. In not taking further action Stewards could not be comfortably satisfied that his actions had affected the placings.

O'Riellys Geegee – Rider Georgie Catania stated that the gelding did not appreciate the firmer surface today and in her opinion races better on tracks with more give. Rider Georgie Catania was reprimanded under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using her whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres.
