Comments / Explanations:

*Rider B Muhcu and S Maher to produce medical before riding again.

**Trainer S Brunton was fined \$50.00 for his late rider notification of his riders tonight. When assessing penalty stewards took into account the submission made by Mr Brunton as to why he was unable to notify his riders within the required time.

RACE 1 – ELECTRO REWIND MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

British – Jumped awkwardly.

Impulsive Lager – Inconvenienced 500 metres.

Lads Curfew – Shifted out near 500 metres. Rider advised to exercise care.

Saalim – Tightened after start and lost ground.

Biscay Barb – Acting on a report from the starter that the gelding was difficult to load Stewards notified connections that it must trial to their satisfaction prior to starting again.

Crowbar – Difficult to load. Warning issued.

Knight To Remember – Slow into stride (1L).

Aggie – Inconvenienced 500 metres.

Aviginian – Commenced to tire from 600 metres, rider H McCarthy could offer no explanation. Connection advised they would evaluate its immediate racing future.

Oxford Road – Inconvenienced 500 metres.

Gee Gees Talk Fest – Got head up when being restrained near 1200 metres. Tightened approaching winning post.

RACE 2 – RIVERVIEW HOTEL CLASS 3 HCP – 1400 METRES

Son Of Faith – Laid in early part of the home straight.

Windell – Performed below expectations. Rider S Barr explained the gelding failed to respond to riding from 800 metres. Veterinary examination subsequent to the race revealed no apparent abnormality.

Hushama – Performed below expectations. Rider S Thornton stated that the mare may not have appreciated the firmer ground tonight and may be better suited over a longer distance.

RACE 3 – MCCRIMMON INSURANCE BM72 HCP – 1400 METRES

Steel Moon – Inconvenienced shortly after start.

Underplay – Some difficulty in obtaining a clear run in the home straight. Rider Anthony Darmanin was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out to the end of the race.

Beaufort Lad – Laid in when under pressure over the last 100 metres.

Valdez – Held up for a short distance rounding home turn.

Maccy Fields – Rider S Carr reported that the mare over raced when leading which may have contributed to it weakening slightly in the home straight.

O'Reillys Geegee – Restrained off heels for some distance after passing 800 metres. Held up briefly near 400 metres and again a short distance latter.

RACE 4 – FRANK FEENEY 60TH MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Highly Leveraged- Contacted on jumping away and became slightly unbalanced. Shortly after start restrained off heels and lost ground.

Vivre Star – Restrained off heels near 700 metres. Held up near 300 metres and then had difficulty obtaining a run shortly after.

Hellmuth – Shortly after the start shifted out abruptly taking **Mully's Idol** out onto **Highly Leveraged** which was taken out over the heels of **Carnaby Road**. Restrained when over racing near 800 metres.

Bush Mayhem – Checked off heels near 700 metres.

RACE 5 – LEGAL SOLUTIONS BM82 HCP – 1200 METRES

Sound Bar – Raced wide throughout.

Vandermeer – Performed below expectations. Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that in his view the gelding may be better suited over a further distance.

Geeges Soprano – Inconvenienced after start.

Private Currency – Victor Wong reprimanded for use of the whip seven times prior to 100 metres.

Minute Repeater – Anthony Darmanin reprimanded for use of the whip six times prior to 100 metres.

Red Eagle – Hampered near the 400 metres.

Step The Pedal – David Pires reprimanded for shifting ground near 400 metres when insufficiently clear.

RACE 6 – WORDSMITH NEWMARKET HCP – 1200 METRES

Up Cups – Stephanie Thornton rider of the gelding was reprimanded for use of the whip six times prior to the 100 metres. Miss Thornton was also reminded of her obligations when using the whip when out of contention.

Geegees Goldengirl – Rider G Catania notified to exercise more care when shifted in slightly near the 800 metres resulting in **Erin's Element** which had been over racing being restrained.

Erin's Element – Restrained 800 metres.

Jerilderie Letter – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – CUCCINA CLASS 1 HCP – 1200 METRES

Korn Broke – Hampered on jumping. Lost ground (2L).

Please Dance – Subsequent to race noted that it had lost a plate in running.

RACE 8 – RUSTY JACKS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 HCP – 1600 METRES

Life's Quest – Kicked behind barrier. Examined by vet. Passed fit to run.

Sir Marmaduke – Over raced middle stages.

Geegees Lillybet – Hampered after start. Lost ground two lengths. Held up briefly rounding home turn.

Totally Wicked – Over raced early stages. Rider H McCarthy reprimanded for use of whip six times prior to 100 metres.

Zemiro – Laid out near 1200 metres when checked off the heels of **Sir Marmaduke**. Laid out near 400 metres. Rider D Thornton could offer no explanation for its disappointing performance.

Somatra – Rider could offer no explanation for the disappointing performance.
