Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – BURNIE CITY COUNCIL STAKES – 2500 METRES

A pre-race swab sample was taken from MODERN CHIC.

KEAYANG RUSTLER galloped out and has been placed right out of the draw at the request of trainer Heath Szczyпка.

FUTURE PROMISES which galloped out will be placed out of the draw and must now complete three consecutive satisfactory performances to be reinstated.

UNION FORCE which galloped out has been placed out of the draw.

LIKE IT IS and MODERN CHIC were held up and unable to be tested over the concluding stages.

A post-race swab sample was taken from DODGERMEMATE, winner of the event.

RACE 2 – TJ CONTRACTING MOBILE – 2180 METRES

A pre-race swab sample was taken from ODINS WITCHBLADE.

MARTY WILLIAMS which broke after the start has now been placed out of the draw for future mobile start events. The gelding then tired to finished beaten 137 metres and has been stood down from racing for 10 days and until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

GOOD LOOKING which was out of position at the start will be on its last chance in the draw. That gelding then finished to be beaten 142 metres and will now be stood down from racing for 14 days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

ODINS WITCHBLADE was out of position at the start and will be placed on its last chance in the draw.

MAJOR GILES pulled hard in the score up and whilst racing with a trail.

MURO DI SILENCIO was tightened near the 500 metres when pursuing a run between MARTY WILLIAMS which was tiring and ODINS WITCHBLADE which had commenced a three wide move.

RACE 3 – NICHOLS SOUND AND COMMUNICATION PACE – 2180 METRES

Due to the water truck not operating properly an additional water truck was put into operation and when commencing watering an excess of water was applied on the home turn which then required remedial track works and consequently the start of race 3 was delayed by 18 minutes.

A pre-race swab sample was taken from WHO IS HARDEEN.

AMBERLU ANGUS which galloped out has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

STARANGE CONDUCT which galloped out has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

LAST GUY STANDING which galloped out will continue to be placed out of the draw.

PARWILL had a tendency to race rough and hang throughout the event.

DAYRAID has been placed back in the standing start draw.

LAST GUY STANDING hung in throughout the event, most noticeably over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination showed no apparent abnormalities.

Entering the home straight OUTLAW NZ(J Laugher) raced rough and then had a tendency to hang in over the concluding stages. MASTER CHARLIE (J Walters) also shifted out under pressure in the home straight. The two briefly locked wheels approaching the finish.

BYMARJAC raced rough near the 500 metres then broke free of interference racing off the back straight on the final occasion checking PARWILL, and has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

The all-clear in this was delayed as driver Jack Laugher (OUTLAW NZ) asked to view the films of the concluding stages. After doing so Mr Laugher was satisfied and the all-clear was then given.

RACE 4 – ROBERTS LTD RURAL STAKES – 1892 METRES

A pre-race swab sample was taken from MONARCO PLAYBOY.

Due to the significant delay to the start time of Race 3 the start of Race 4 was also delayed by 7 minutes

As the start was affected BLUES ACE(J Laugher) shifted out, severely checking EMJAYS ALFIE(J Walters) before shifting in and then again shifting out and again severely checking EMJAYS ALFIE. BLUES ACE has now been placed out of the draw in future standing start events. As a result of BLUES ACE shifting ground BOUTIQUE ART and MI MAKAROVA were also checked after the start.

MONARCO PLAYBOY was fractious at the start.

THE REAL REVEREND shifted in after the start.

FREDS UNDER FIRE which galloped out will continue to be placed out of the standing start draw.

MY HIGHLIGHTS (Mark Yole) had to race wide around the galloping BLUES ACE and EMJAYS ALFIE rounding the first turn.

RACE 5 – BURNIE SHOW SOCIETY PACE – 2180 METRES

Due to the delayed start time of the previous two races the start of Race 5 was delayed by two minutes.

A pre-race swab sample was taken from JANE GRANT.

THE STATE OF PLAY NZ and BLISSTAR both galloped out and have been placed on their last chance in the draw.

VITAL SIGN which galloped out then continued to gallop for an excessive distance and has been placed out of the draw.

REGAL IDEA and BARAGOOLA which both galloped out will continue out of the draw.

BARAGOOLA pulled hard and raced rough in the early stages and then shifted out and contacted the sulky of BLISSTAR (G Rattray) with two laps to travel and raced rough inconveniencing REGAL IDEA (D Dornauf). BARAGOOLA has now been placed on its last chance to race truly. Trainer Brady Woods advised that the gelding had made contact to its sulky with its hind legs during the race, making it difficult to control, and that he would hitch the gelding differently to correct this and that he would also make changes to the headgear worn by the gelding and that he intends to trial BARAGOOLA before it again races.

RACE 6 – COASTAL ENGINEERING AND BELTING MOBILE – 2180 METRES

As the starter called runners up to the mobile barrier track lighting on five light towers on the turn out of the home straight failed and the start was aborted. Runners were then sent off the track whilst attempts were made to rectify the faulty lighting. When the fault was unable to be rectified Stewards then abandoned the remainder of the race meeting.
