Comments / Explanations:

The explanation from G McCulloch for the late rider of Morgatochie was accepted.

RACE 1 – LUXBET.COM BM82 HCP – 1600 METRES

Holy Cat – Slow to begin, lost ground (2L).

Tycoon Navigator – Slow to begin, lost ground (1L).

Solomon's Song – Rider Sigrid Carr was fined the sum of \$300 for using her whip on eight occasions prior to the 100 metres. Miss Carr was also severely reprimanded for using her whip on consecutive strides on one occasion.

Subsequent to this race the track was upgraded to GOOD 4 at 1.45PM

RACE 2 – LUXBET 3YO HCP – 1000 METRES

Gee Gee Double Dee – Rider Sigrid Carr explained that the filly which in her view was slightly disappointing maybe better suited when being allowed to race more freely.

Miss Bluegrass – Inconvenienced after the start.

RACE 3 – CARLTON DRAUGHT MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Grave Digger – Over raced at various stages.

C'Est Bon – First start and commenced to weaken noticeably from the 400 metres.

RACE 4 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Tranter – Rider accidentally dropped whip on latter part of home turn.

West Burton – Weakened noticeably from the 400 metres. Troy Baker rider of the gelding explained that the gelding failed to respond to his riding throughout however on return to scale connections reported that the saddle had slipped back. A Veterinary examination subsequent to the race revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Bella Abati – Held up between 600 to 400 metres. Laid out early part of home straight.

Miss Waddington – Jumped in shortly after the start resulting in **Tranter** being tightened and hampered and **Tough Vic** also being hampered. Restrained near 1000 metres.

Della Terra – Raced greenly in the home straight and proved difficult to ride.

Sunset Streaker – Over raced early

RACE 5 – WOLF BLASS CLASS 5 HCP – 1400 METRES

Ultimate Doom – Slow to begin (2L).

The Captain – Laid in for a short distance near 200 metres. Rider Stephanie Thornton reprimanded for use of the whip in consecutive strides on one occasion.

Squire – Slow to begin (1L).

RACE 6 – SCHWEPES CLASS 1 HCP – 1000 METRES

Tuscan Classic – Raced wide throughout, made home turn awkwardly.

The Desperate – Slow to begin (2L).

Count Montagu – Inconvenienced when shifted out away from **Tough Missile** near 200 metres.

Scrutineer – Inconvenienced near 200 metres. A veterinary examination after the race revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Marmalady – Raced awkwardly for a short distance near 600 metres.

Morgatoche – Rider Jesse Philpot reprimanded for using her whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 7 – HOBART CUP FEB 5TH BM72 HCP – 2100 METRES

Dillon Hall – Over raced early.

Gwemrae – Over raced middle stages. Performed below expectations. Rider Raquel Clark explained that Gwemrae over raced in the early and middle stages and then failed to respond to her riding from the 600 metres.

Remorse – Slow to begin (2L).

RACE 8 – PURE BLONDE CLASS 2 HCP – 1200 METRES

Cuban Missile – Tendency to lay in in the home straight.

Swinging Ali – Shifted in. Rider notified to exercise care after shifting in near the 1000 metres when not fully clear.

O'Loughlin – Tightened after start.

Qui Samer – Tightened near 1000 metres.

Col's Hero – Eased near 1000 metres when tightened. Over raced middle stages.

SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT

TTC Wednesday 2/11/2016 Race 1 Doug Towns Maiden 1200M

Stewards today concluded their inquiry that related to Stephanie Thornton, rider of Tremotino being found guilty of a charge of careless riding. Miss Thornton was suspended for one Tasmanian race date commencing midnight the 22nd of November and expiring midnight the 23rd of November.

Stewards today concluded their inquiry into the reasons for A Matter Of Time having to be restrained near the 900 metres. It was established that approaching that point of the race Gotta Have Vibe (C Graham), shifted in when not sufficiently clear of Marmalady resulting in that mare putting pressure on Morgatoche and Kepta which resulted in A Matter Of Time racing tight and having to be restrained.. Shortly after this N Punch rider of Marmalady was unable to relieve the pressure placed on runners to his inside due to Under Milkwood improving to his outside. After taking into account all of the circumstances stewards took no further action other than to severely reprimand Chris Graham for initially tightening Marmalady.
