S Maher produced a medical clearance allowing her to ride today.  
V Wong to produce medical certificate of fitness and complete concussion test before riding again.

### **RACE 1 – LONGFORD CUP NEW YEARS DAY 3YO MAIDEN – 1200 METRES**

**Belrock Boy** – Tightened after start. Raced greenly middle stages.

**Lemilkey** – Tightened after start. Laid in in home straight.

**Liffeybeau** – Over raced when leading.

**Tom Archie** – Jumped awkwardly

**Valerius** – Slow to begin. 1 length.

**White Hawk** – Laid in approaching the 100 metres.

**Mag Wheels** – Warning issued. Difficult to load.

**Sassy As** – Slow into stride.

### **RACE 2 – BOOK YOUR XMAS FUNCTION CLASS 2 HCP – 1200 METRES**

**Greensborough** – Restrained off heels near 800 metres. Shifted out and tightened **Willby Rules** passing 400 metres before being corrected by rider. Hayley McCarthy notified to exercise care when in similar circumstances. Subsequent to the race Hayley McCarthy reported that the gelding displayed a tendency to lay out for the majority of the race.

**Sea Ruler** – Overraced early and middle stages.

**Willby Rules** – Tightened near 400 metres.

**Black Hills** – Fractious after being loaded in barriers. After considering recent record connections were advised it must trial to stewards satisfaction prior to starting again.

**Miss Mai Ho** – Slow into stride. Checked near 1200 metres. Inquiry adjourned.

**New Vision** – Rider G Catania reported that mare failed to respond to riding throughout the race.

### **RACE 3 – LUXBET CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES**

**Steel Dan** – Performed below expectations. Rider Boris Thornton reported failed to respond to riding from 400 metres and raced flat.

**Gallow Gate** – Raced wide throughout

**Schillie Billie** – Performed below expectations. Rider Anthony Darmanin explained that the mare received some pressure during the early and middle stages which was contrary to its last start when it was able to dictate when leading. A Darmanin added that it failed to respond to his riding from the 800 metres. Swab samples were taken.

**Gemini** – Rider Ismail Toker explained the filly raced tightly rounding the home turn and then in his view failed to stretch out fully in the home straight.

**I Love This Bar** – Performed below expectations. Rider Georgie Catania explained that the filly failed to respond to her riding from the 600 metres.

**Shakespeare** – Rider Victor Wong reprimanded for using a whip on 6 occasions prior to the 100 metres.

**Sunset Party** – Held up rounding home turn and in early part of home straight, then had difficulty in obtaining a clear run.

**Commanding Dash** – Held up later part of home turn

**Slinky Malinky** – Rider Nathan Punch explained that after drawing a wide barrier the mare commenced to over race when disputing the lead. Punch added that he was reluctant to attempt to restrain as he felt his saddle may slip forward.

### **RACE 4 – GREAT NORTHERN EXPERIENCE MAIDEN – 1400 METRES**

Start of race slightly delayed due to Mighty Hoffa harmlessly dislodging S Maher after leaving mounting yard

**Matsan** – Slow into stride. Raced wide early. Inconvenienced 400 metres.

**Mighty Hoffa** – Late scratching 8.30pm when unable to be ridden to the barrier. Connections advised must trial to steward's satisfaction before starting again.

**New Release** – Had not started for almost two years. Examined by vet on arrival to course. Passed fit to run.

### **RACE 5 – ST MICHAELS 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY MAIDEN– 1200 METRES**

**Highly Leveraged** – Slow to begin 2 lengths

**Liffey Lad** – Rider V Wong dislodged near 300 metres. Inquiry adjourned.

**Pistol Jack** – Performed below market expectations. Raquel Clark rider of the gelding explained that she felt that the gelding was showing signs of soreness. Subsequent to the meeting trainer Angela Brakey reported that the gelding had initially not eaten up and was showing signs of being effected by the run however it had improved and will continue on with it's preparation.

**Silver Reset** – Apprentice Chris Graham fined the sum of \$200. \$100 wholly suspended for six months for using his whip 7 times prior to the 100 metres.

**Gee Gees Rusty** – Daniel Ganderton rider of the gelding reported that it raced awkwardly at various stages during the race.

**Trusted Warrior** – Inquiry adjourned into whip use of rider B McCoull prior to the 100 metres.

#### **RACE 6 – TAS HOSPITALITY ASSOCIATION CLASS 5 HCP – 1200 METRES**

Start of race re scheduled to 9.45 PM due to ambulance being required to transport Victor Wong to hospital.

**Bideford (NZ)** – Subsequent to the race Ismail Toker rider of the gelding reported that it made a respiratory noise during the race.

**Trot On Candy** – Rider Troy Baker reprimanded for use of whip 6 times prior to the 100 metres.

#### **RACE 7 – LAUNCESTON MITSUBISHI BM62 HCP – 2100 METRES**

Start of race re scheduled to 10.17 pm however due to the barrier incident involving **Prominent Star** the race commenced at 10.22 pm.

**Gold Librettist** – Jumped awkwardly

**Prominent Star** – After being loaded into the barrier the gelding sat down and then became cast. Late scratching 10.18PM. Connections advised must trial to steward's satisfaction before starting again.

**Sh'bourne Dylaca** – Over raced early and middle stages due to slow pace.

#### **RACE 8 – TAS HOTEL & CLUB SUPPLIES BM72 HCP – 1600 METRES**

**Bidirectional** – Hung in home straight

**Zippered Up** – Rider D Pires reported that the mare hung in for the majority of the race and proved difficult to ride.
