Bulent Muhcu and Victor Wong, who were not riding at this meeting, successfully completed concussion testing today

RACE 1 – RAINE & HORNE EASTERN SHORE 2YO HANDICAP – 900 METRES

Windrider - Jumped awkwardly and lost ground (1L). Laid in home straight and proved difficult to ride.

Moshrocket – Raced wide early and middle stages.

Gee Gee Musicmaker – Laid in home straight.

Clean Acheeva – Stood flat-footed, slow to begin (2L).

Geegee Trendsetter – Laid out when leading during early and middle stages.

RACE 2 – TASSIE CYCLES MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES

Quiet Wonder – Hung in home straight.

Stormont - Examined upon arrival on course and found to have sustained an injury to its right fore-leg. Withdrawn by Stewards at 1.11 pm.

West On Broadway – Raced greenly when racing wide during early and middle stages.

Global Princess – Hung out throughout the race. Tightened near the 50 metres. Connections advised a warning issued due to the mare's racing manners when hanging.

Miss Che Che – Held up rounding the home turn. Difficulty obtaining a clear run in the early part of the home straight. Rider Anthony Darmanin notified to exercise care when shifting ground near the 50 metres.

Taramaya – Rider David Pires notified to exercise care when shifting ground near 50 metres.

Acronym – Rider T Baker reported the filly made respiratory noise near the 50 metres. Veterinary examination subsequent to the race failed to reveal any abnormalities.

French Connection – Inconvenienced shortly after the start. Rider Georgie Catania reported that the filly felt awkward in its action during the race. Veterinary examination subsequent to the race revealed the filly to have a slow recovery heart rate.

RACE 3 – TONY CARRICK 3YO VASE – NO CLAIMS – 1100 METRES

Hard Empire – Made home turn awkwardly

Gee Gee Double Dee – Sigrid Carr severely reprimanded for use of the whip six times prior to the 100 metres.

Angel of the Abyss – Hung in when under pressure over 250 metres. Subsequent to the race Scott Brunton, trainer of the filly, reported that it had jarred up due to the firm track surface.

Count Montagu – Jumped awkwardly.

Giselle's Girl – Jumped awkwardly.

Happy Halloween – Hung out badly for some distance passing the 800 metres then continued to hang out rounding the home turn. Eased down over last 200 metres. Connections advised must trial to Stewards' satisfaction before starting again. Veterinary examination subsequent to the race failed to reveal any abnormalities.

RACE 4 – ROGERSON & BIRCH SURVEYORS BM72 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Naadam – Got its head up when being restrained approaching the 800 metres.

Step the Pedal - Subsequent to the race Scott Brunton, trainer of the mare, reported that it had jarred up due to the firm track surface.

Lazy Democracy - Subsequent to the race Scott Brunton, trainer of the gelding, reported that it had jarred up due to the firm track surface.

Bella Venus – Jumped awkwardly then inconvenienced shortly after. Laid in for a short distance near the 50 metres.

Galeocerdo - Sigrid Carr severely reprimanded for use of the whip six times prior to the 100 metres

RACE 5 – RAINE & HORNE HOBART CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Christopher Mac – Inconvenienced near the 300 metres.

Lucky Option – Hung in home straight. David Pires, rider of the mare which performed below expectations today, reported that in his view the mare failed to stretch out on the firm track surface. David Pires added that he believed the mare's tongue may have got over the bit.

Berry Wise Fox – Hung in in the home straight.

Tough Missile – Shifted in abruptly near the 300 metres, inconveniencing **Christopher Mac**.

Kirribilli Kid – Rider permitted to ride 1 kg over allotted weight. Near the 400 metres, struck the running rail and became unbalanced.

RACE 6 – RAINE & HORNE KINGSTON CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Lord Farquaad – Inconvenienced after the start

The Captain - Inconvenienced shortly after the start

Cheers Chappy – Raced wide from 700 metres.

Reann's Diamond – Restrained off heels near 800 metres and again near 400 metres, resulting in the mare throwing its head.

RACE 7 – LYDEN BUILDERS BM82 – 1400 METRES

Sound Bar - Shifted in slightly near the 800 metres and shifted in rounding the home turn. Rider Boris Thornton was severely reprimanded and advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances.

Hyperbole – Rider viewed the film prior to correct weight. Raced tight for some distance down the back straight. Near the 800 metres tightened for room. Latter part of home turn, tightened for room.

Shiralee – Jumped awkwardly.

Skip to the Moon – After hearing a submission from Trainer Rhonda Hall relating to the mare's inability to perform on firm surfaces, Stewards permitted the scratching of the mare at 3.35 pm

Brendon McCoull, the rider of Trusted Warrior pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii), the particulars being that he used his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. After taking into account Brendon McCoull's record in relation to this Rule, he was fined the sum of \$100.
