RACE 1 – UBET MAIDEN – 1220 METRES

Sir Valentine – Bumped near 1000 metres. Raced wide throughout. Raced greenly in home straight, shifted in when under pressure.

Stoners Scene – Inconvenienced after the start. Approaching 1000 metres shifted out abruptly and bumped

Tiger Tarr – Over-raced. Restrained off heels near 800 metres.

Vivre Star – Shifted abruptly shortly after the start.

Westwood – Inconvenienced after the start. Held up and restrained off heels for some distance passing the 400 metres.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby – Over raced early. Rider Sigrid Carr severely reprimanded for use of the whip 6 times prior to the 100 metres.

Cheap Trick – Hampered after the start. Restrained when tightened near 1000 metres.

Owens – Hampered after the start.

RACE 2 – ARTHUR J GALLAGHER INSURANCE BROKER CLASS 1 HCP – 1220 METRES

Killin Falls – Restrained when over racing near 800 metres. Inconvenienced near 250 metres.

Leconte – Restrained off heels near 800 metres. Saddle moved back near 150 metres resulting in rider Boris Thornton and the gelding becoming severely unbalanced and losing considerable ground.

The Desperate – Slow into stride.

Schillie Billie – Restrained off heels near 700 metres. Checked approaching 100 metres. Rider Hayley McCarthy explained that whilst it was the connections intention to race forward, the mare only jumped away moderately resulting in it possibly being caught wide and she elected to restrain and look for a position with cover. After taking into account the circumstances, Stewards accepted the explanation tendered by Miss McCarthy.

Miss Bluegrass – inconvenienced after the start.

Toorak Affair – Tightened after the start.

Our Queenie – Held up for some distance between the 600 metres and 400 metres.

Please Dance (NZ) – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 3 – OLDE TUDOR HOTEL BM72 HCP – 1420 METRES

Underplay – Fractious in barriers, warning issued. Jumped away awkwardly. Rider Chris Graham advised to exercise care when shifting ground near 800 metres to avoid tightening to other runners.

Son of Faith – Rider A Darmanin viewed film prior to correct weight.

Gee Gee Classic Boy – Restrained off heels near 300 metres.

Perplexing – Restrained after start from wide barrier.

Wanaea – Over raced early and middle stages. Tightened near 800 metres. Performed below expectations. Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that the mare felt awkward in its action. A veterinary examination subsequent to the race revealed the mare had been galloped on behind. Treated on course by Vet.

Kool Kash – Over raced between 1200 and 800 metres.

RACE 4 – TREASURY WINES ESTATES CLASS 3 HCP – 1620 METRES

Strathalbyn – Inconvenienced on the latter part of the home turn. When questioned in relation to riding the gelding more forward, rider Sigrid Carr explained that it began well and she formed the view that it would be better to ride forward rather than to be caught wide. S Carr further explained that the gelding failed to respond to her riding from the 500 metres. S Carr also stated that in light of tonight's performance it appears the gelding performs better when allowed to settle back in the field. After taking into account the circumstances, Stewards accepted the explanation tendered by Sigrid Carr.

Olly's A Star – Held up for a short distance on the latter part of the home turn.

Secrets She Has – Raced wide throughout and weakened from the 300 metres.

Alsa Doll – Examined by Vet on arrival at course. Slow into stride.

New Vision – Held up briefly on the latter part of the home turn.

Life's Quest – Rider Anthony Darmanin notified to exercise care when shifting ground on the latter part of the home turn.

Western Front – Rider Stephanie Thornton reprimanded for use of the whip 6 times prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 5 – TAS HOSPITALITY ASSOCIATION MAIDEN – 1620 METRES

The start of this race was delayed by approximately 4 minutes due to Crowbar having to be re-shod behind the barriers. As the gelding could not be re-shod, it was withdrawn by Stewards at 8.33pm

Another Brother – Over raced in the middle stages and raced wide throughout.

British – Unable to obtain a clear run between the 200 metres and 100 metres.

Saalim – Slow into stride and restrained due to wide barrier.

Totally Wicked – Raced wide throughout. Laid in under pressure over last 100 metres.

RACE 6 – CUB BM82 HCP – 1220 METRES

Erin's Element – Over raced during the middle stages.

Silver Bolt – Inconvenienced on latter part of the home turn.

Gee Gees Jet - Rider Sigrid Carr notified to exercise care when shifting ground on latter part of home turn to avoid interference.

Teriki – Briefly held up near the 400 metres.

Box of Frogs – Rider David Pires explained that when the pace quickened near the 400 metres Box of Frogs was unable to respond to his riding. D Pires added that it would be better suited over more ground.

RACE 7 – PFD FOOD SERVICES BM62 HCP (DIV 1) – 1220 METRES

Gee Gees Blondie – Tightened near 50 metres.

Steel Brom – Rider Boris Thornton accidentally dropped the whip near 200 metres.

Scouting Around – Shifted out under pressure near 50 metres. Rider Sigrid Carr was reminded of her obligations to keep her mount straight to avoid causing interference.

Col's Hero – Slow into stride.

Mediano – Slow into stride.

RACE 8 – COCA-COLA AMATIL BM62 HCP (DIV 2) – 1220 METRES

Nunivak – Inconvenienced near 50 metres. Performed below expectations. Rider David Pires explained that when he put the gelding under pressure it failed to respond to his riding. A veterinary examination after the race revealed that it was showing a poor post recovery rate.

Cuban Missile – Shifted in under pressure near 50 metres. Rider Sherry Barr notified that she should exercise care when in similar circumstances to avoid interference.

Gee Gee Sun Valley – Raced tightly with **Cameo Kiss** between 400 and 200 metres. Held up briefly near the 150 metres.

Swinging Ali – Inconvenienced near 100 metres.

Scrutineer – Slow to begin (1L).

Doubtful Folly – Inconvenienced after the start. Rider Jessie Philpot reminded of her obligations using the whip when out of contention.

RACE 9 – LUXBET BM72 HCP (2450 METRES)

Gold Librettist – Knuckled severely at the start and almost fell.

Miss Choosey – Rider Ismail Toker was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out to the end of the race. When asked for an explanation into the reasons why he did not race more forward, Ismail Toker explained he was instructed by Trainer Walter McShane to ride the mare with cover. Trainer Walter McShane explained that it had been his intention at previous runs to have the mare ridden with cover as the mare had not been finishing off her races, however for various reasons these instructions were not able to be fulfilled. Mr McShane further added that he intends to spell the mare.

GENERAL

Paul Maher, trainer of Gold Librettist was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 80(C) in that he failed to attend to his horse in the stabling area prior to its race.
