Shane Keeler driver of HERBIE HAZE pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 163 (1)(a)(iii) for causing interference to SUZY ZEBRA near the 1400 metres. After considering submissions on penalty, Mr Keeler was fined the sum of \$100.

RACE 5 – JIM ALEXANDER MEMORIAL – 2079 METRES – Standing Start

Prior to entering the parade ring CAPTAIN MORDECAI was examined by the vet who found it was lame in the off fetlock and unfit to start. Subsequently withdrawn at 2.15pm. Connections advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness to be submitted prior to starting again.

YANKEE AVENUE galloped out, took no competitive part in the race, trailed the field, continue RODS.

Prior to All Clear, Stewards were notified that the winner of the race NO ISSUE may have started from its incorrect handicap mark. After interviewing Starters Warren Fisher and Boyd Hoare, it was established that NO ISSUE had started from the 40M handicap instead of 50M. Stewards ordered that NO ISSUE be declared a non-runner and amended the placings to read 1st ANOTHER CEEBEE, 2nd PUNCHINELLO, 3rd VIEW STREET.

GENERAL

Drivers Shane Keeler, James Jakowenko and Peter Jakowenko all pleaded guilty to a charge under AR231(2) Misconduct, the particulars being that Mr James Jakowenko engaged in threatening and intimidatory behaviour towards Mr Keeler and during the course of that behaviour also engaged in abusive language towards him in the horse stabling area. Mr James Jakowenko was fined the sum of \$1,000, \$750 of which was wholly suspended for two years.
