

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

RACE 1 – DOWLING MCCARTHY TYRES MAIDEN – 1600 METRES

Comical Ending - slow to jump.

RACE 3 – ADAM BROOKS MP CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1000 METRES

Comsuadi - Slow to jump.

Bounce Back - Eased up with 300m to race as the rider Daniel Schmitt felt it was sore in front. A post-race veterinary examination revealed severe lameness in the horse's off-fore leg. The horse will require a veterinary clearance prior to its next race start.

RACE 4 – KING ISLAND AIRLINES MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Bring On Friday - Slow to muster early speed on jumping to trail the field by four lengths shortly after.

RACE 6 – JIM MCKENZIE AGENCIES GALLOP CLASS A HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Island Flight - Approaching the 800m rider Rhonda Mangan had to take hold and ease her horse for a stride when tightened for room on her outside by **Mponeng** (Daniel Schmitt). Jockey D Schmitt was advised to take more care when looking to make a forward move.

RACE 7 – KING ISLAND FOODWORKS CLASS B HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Mr America - Fractious after being loaded in the barriers; had to be taken out, undergo a veterinary check and then re-loaded. Slow to muster speed on jumping.

An inquiry into the latter stage of the finish of this race was held over to be heard at the next race meeting on the 1 January 2017.
