RACE 1 - BRIGHTON COUNCIL 2YO MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1000 METRES

Copperhead Road - Late scratching at 9.19 am after Trainer David Brunton reported that the gelding had injured its off-fore knee.

This race started two minutes behind schedule due to a number of horses being difficult to load and several horses having their first start.

Bosporus – Slow to begin (2L). Carried wider entering the home straight by **Kandahar** (Craig Luttrell). Rider Craig Luttrell was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground in similar circumstances.

Kandahar – Laid in rounding the home turn. Laid in under pressure in the home straight. Approaching the 200 metres, shifted in abruptly. Rider Craig Luttrell reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout.

Koppar Champion – Approaching the 400 metres, was tightened between **Foreeva** and **Kandahar** when that gelding laid in under pressure.

Moon Rocker – Difficult to load, warning issued. In not taking more severe action Stewards were mindful the gelding was on debut.

The Golden Jet – Jumped away awkwardly and bumped with **Gee Gees Queenie**.

Gee Gee Musicmaker – Stewards approved a late gear change due to an administrative error. Near side blinker replaced with near side bubble cheeker. Trainer Leon Wells was reprimanded under LR 7.2 for lodging an incorrect Stable Return.

Gee Gees Queenie – Knuckled at the start.

RACE 2 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS – SET WEIGHTS - 1100 METRES

Gee Gee Pureblonde – Trainers Leon, Dean & Trent Wells were fined the sum of \$50 under AR 140A(2) for presenting the gelding without winkers.

Like a Spectre – Knuckled soon after the start.

Tom Archie – Slow to begin (1L).

Weekend Whisky – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 3 – CROWN LAGER MAIDEN/CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (DIVISION 1) – SET WEIGHTS – 1600 METRES

Euro Express – Commenced to give ground from the 500 metres. Rider Georgie Catania reported that the gelding travelled well until placed under pressure and thereafter the gelding failed to respond to her riding. Trainer Christie Burt reported that the gelding could not stay the distance and the rider had indicated to her that the gelding got its tongue over the bit.

Saalim – Slow to begin (2L).

Street Talent – Commenced to give ground from the 500 metres. Rider Boris Thornton (a) reported that the gelding failed to respond to his riding throughout the event.

Little Elsa – Held up for clear racing room from the 550 metres until the 450 metres.

Pop a Lefty – Stewards questioned Rider Sigrid Carr regarding the tactics she adopted in the early part of the race when she raced wide. Ms Carr explained that it was her intention to race wide in the back straight and after drawing a wide barrier from the 1600 metre start, she elected to stay wide, the explanation was noted.

RACE 4 – CASCADE DRAUGHT MAIDEN/CLASS 1 HANDICAP (DIVISION 2) – SET WEIGHTS – 1600 METRES

Belmont – Jumped away awkwardly before shifting out carrying **Northern Command** out on to **Mag Wheels**. At the same time **Zemiro** shifted in marginally resulting in **Korn Broke** clipping the heels of **Mag Wheels**.

Liffey Lad – Hung out rounding the turn at the 1400 metres.

Korn Broke – Slow to begin (1L). Clipped the heels of **Mag Wheels** soon after the start. Rider Raquel Clark (a) explained that the filly was reluctant to fully stretch out after receiving interference at the start. A veterinary inspection subsequent to the race failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Intriguingly – Slow to begin (1L). Raced wide throughout.

RACE 5 – WOLF BLASS LADY LYNETTE – FILLIES & MARES, SET WEIGHTS AND PENALTIES – NO CLAIMS – 1100 METRES

Sh'bourne Spirit – Performed below expectations. Rider Brad Rawiller reported that the mare did not feel comfortable in its action throughout the race. A veterinary inspection subsequent to the race revealed the mare to be lame in its off fore-leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of soundness is required before racing again. Trainer Bill Ryan reported the mare will now be retired.

Erin's Element – Jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin (2L).

Step the Pedal – Had some difficulty obtaining clear racing room near the 200 metres. Rider David Pires reported that the mare was off the bit in the early stages and was carried wide rounding the home turn before being momentarily held up for a clear run in the early part of the home straight.

Galeocerdo - Approaching the 200 metres, Rider Sigrid Carr accidentally dropped her whip.

RACE 6 – SCHWEPPE'S CLASS 3 HANDICAP - 1100 METRES

Lord Farquaad – Hampered at the start between **Boart** and **Apriano** who jumped outwards.

Genuine Art – Late scratching at 3.26 pm after being unable to be loaded into its barrier stall. Prior to the announcement of correct weight, Stewards ordered all monies invested on **Genuine Art** to be refunded in full. All bets made prior to 3.26 pm were to be paid less seven cents in the

dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less eight cents in the dollar on the value of the place ticket. The connections were advised that **Genuine Art** must satisfactorily complete a barrier trial before being permitted to race again.

Boart – Passing the 200 metres shifted ground to the inside of **Apriano** and carried **Lord Farquaad** inwards. Rider Craig Luttrell was found guilty of a charge of careless riding under AR 137(a) the carelessness being that near the 300 metres, he shifted out when insufficiently clear of **Crystal Flame** and as a result **Crystal Flame** had to be checked by its rider. Craig Luttrell's riding licence was suspended for two Tasmanian race dates commencing at midnight on Wednesday, 25th January 2017 and to expire at midnight on Friday, 3rd February 2017.

Col's Hero – Approaching the 600 metres, tightened for room between **Where's Scotty** and **Apriano** when that gelding laid in.

Ohsotuf - Stewards granted permission for Rider Hayley McCarthy (a) to ride this gelding one kilo over its allotted weight

Where's Scotty – Bumped with **Col's Hero** near the 400 metres.

RACE 7 – KEVIN SHARKIE HOBART GUINEAS 3YO – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS – LISTED – 2100 METRES

Shadow Prince (NZ) – Approaching the 1800 metres, **Shadow Prince (NZ)** and **Amaword** bumped. Rider Thomas Sadler reported that the gelding travelled well throughout but failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres and in his opinion, the gelding would derive benefit from today's run. Rider reprimanded for using the whip six times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account the totality of his whip use and his record under this Rule.

Amaword – Laid in over the concluding stages.

Trusted Warrior – Laid in over the concluding stages. Rider Sigrid Carr pleaded guilty under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) the particulars being that she used her whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. After taking into account her recent record in relation to this Rule, totality of the whip use and also the context of the race, Miss Carr was fined the sum of \$400.

Life On the Wire – Jumped in at the start hampering **Alexander Benjamin**. Over-raced passing the 1400 metres.

Lord Derby – Over-raced passing the 1600 metres.

RACE 8 – PIMMS SUMMER CUP – WEIGHT FOR AGE – NO CLAIMS – 2200 METRES

Taiyoo – Faulted at the 300 metres inconveniencing **Thunder Teddington (GB)**. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a fractured off hind pastern and was thus humanely euthanized by the Club's veterinary surgeon.

Settler's Stone – Rider Jarrod Todd issued a severe reprimand under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his very good record under this Rule, totality of his whip use and also the context of the race.

Electric Crimson – Rider Georgie Catania explained that the gelding failed to respond to her riding from the 500 metres. Ms Catania added that the gelding was not suited by the set weight conditions of this race.

Kanji – Rider Mehmet Ulucinar reported that the gelding travelled well until racing into a softer section of the track between the 600 metres and the 400 metres. The gelding then failed to respond to his riding.

Thunder Teddington – Performed below expectations. Rider Craig Newitt reported that the gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 900 metres. Stable representative Andy McArdle reported that the gelding had not settled in after travelling however had pulled up well after the run.

RACE 9 – DERBY DAY FEB 3 BM72 HCP – 1600 METRES

King Manu (NZ) – Performed below market expectations. Rider Stephanie Thornton (a) reported that the gelding travelled well throughout and dipped near the 300 metre mark. Miss Thornton further stated that the gelding may have come to the end of its preparation and in her opinion is better suited to a longer distance.

Smoke ‘n’ Whisky – Slow to begin (2L).

Olly’s a Star – Hampered soon after the start when **Cheryl’s Horse** shifted in.

Fund Trader –Stewards issued Rider Chris Graham (a) with a severe reprimand under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule and the totality of his whip use.

Supplementary Report: TTC – Longford – 1st January 2017

Race 2 – T A Bricknell Maiden – 1400 metres

Stewards today inquired into the reasons for **Liffey Lad** (Yassi Nishitani) being checked approaching the 1000 metres. After taking evidence from Riders David Pires (**Argentico**), Bulent Muhcu (**Fashion Tycoon**), Yassi Nishitani (**Liffey Lad**) and Sigrid Carr (**Tilmosa**), Stewards were of the opinion that **Tilmosa**, who was racing four wide, shifted in marginally taking **Fashion Tycoon** in towards **Liffey Lad**. At the same time **Argentico** shifted out and bumped with **Liffey Lad** which was being restrained off the heels of **Fashion Tycoon**. After taking into account all the evidence and the camera angles available, Stewards could not attribute blame to any one rider and as such reminded all riders to exercise more care when in similar circumstances.
