RACE 1 – CAMERON'S ACCOUNTANT CLASS B HCP – 1200 METRES

Pashmak – Rider Lorelle Crow notified to exercise care in relation to her whip use prior to the 100 metres and also when using the whip when her mounts are out of contention.

RACE 3 – MCKENZIE/CLARKE MEMORIAL MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Lemilkey – Raced awkwardly approaching the crossing near the 1100 metres resulting in rider Michelle Hagley becoming unbalanced and losing ground.

RACE 4 – VORTEX GALLOPING TROPHY – 1400 METRES

Dashing Devon – Rider Daniel Schmitt was granted permission to ride 1kg over its allotted weight.

RACE 6 – BRUCE CLARK MEMORIAL CLASS B HCP – 1100 METRES

Mponeng – Contacted **Mr Monarch** passing the winning post the first time then restrained off that horse's heels. Passing the 1100 metres restrained to avoid heels of Mr Monarch.

Mr Monarch – Tightened near 1100 metres by **Till Then**. Rider Yassy Nishitani (Till Then) advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

RACE 7 – NEWMANS HOME FURNISHING CLASS B HCP – 2600 METRES

Next Issue – Overraced in early stages and commenced to weaken from 1200 metres.

Undo The Shackles – Stood flat footed, lost considerable ground (10L).
