Trainer Kaye Milne was fined the sum of \$50 for presenting Kanji later than acceptable in the mounting yard prior to race 6.

RACE 1 – LUXBET LAUNCESTON CUP IN FEBRUARY – 1600 METRES

Argentio – Jumped away awkwardly and bumped with Zemiro. Rider Georgie Catania reported that the horse laid in in the home straight.

Matiano – Rider Anthony Darmanin was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground entering the home straight when insufficiently clear of Rangaondarun. Stewards noted that Argentio had laid in contributing to this incident.

Sir Marmaduke – Rider Hayley McCarthy advised to exercise more care when shifting in approaching the 1300 metres when she was insufficiently clear of Argentio and Intriguingly. Rider reported the horse laid out in the home straight.

Intriguingly – Rider Stephanie Thornton reported the pre-race plan was to go back but after jumping well, she elected to ride forward.

On A String – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Rider Sigrid Carr reported the gelding was not suited to the slow tempo and was left flat footed when the pace quickened near the 400 metres.

Paint Vegas Red – Begun awkwardly. Held up for clear racing room on the latter part of the home turn.

Millrace – Hampered and lost its position at the start between On A String and Belmont when Rangaondarun jumped away awkwardly and bumped with On A String carrying that gelding outwards. Over raced in early and middle stages.

RACE 2 – JANSZ CORPORATE MARQUEE MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Cincha – Late scratching at 5.43pm on veterinary advice when the gelding pulled a shoe and was found to be lame.

Fought For – Approaching the 1000 metres over raced after being restrained off the heels of Tranter and bumping with Sir Valentine.

Westwood – Laid in in the home straight.

Fearless Filou NZ – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Tilmosa – Rider Ismail Toker reported after travelling keenly in the run, the mare failed to respond to his riding in the home straight.

Tranter – Approaching the 800 metres over raced for a short distance.

French Connection – Raced wide throughout. Laid in in the home straight. Trainer Gary White reported that the filly appreciated the step up in distance to the 1400 metres.

Gee Gee Mightymiss – Performed below market expectation. Rider Raquel Clark reported the filly was one paced.

Mystic Spirit – Laid in away from French Connection near the 150 metres. Rider Bulent Muhcu was queried in regards to the tactics adopted on the filly. Mr Muhcu explained that it was the connections intention to race forward last start however after receiving interference soon after the start was unable to fulfil those intentions. Trainer Mr A Trinder confirmed that it was the connections intention to ride the filly forward in future events.

RACE 3 – MOSCOW CIRCUS AT MOWBRAY BM62 HCP– 1400 METRES

Dangerpet – Rider Chris Graham was issued a severe reprimand for careless riding, the carelessness being that he shifted in near the 900 metres when insufficiently clear of Episodes which had to be restrained by its rider.

Steel Brom – Rider Sigrid Car reminded of her obligations to ride her mounts out to the end of the race. In not taking more action Stewards could not be satisfied that her actions affected the placings.

Kool Kash – Raced wide throughout.

Tycoon Navigator – Slow into stride (2L).

Leconte – Held up for clear racing room between 200 and 50 metre mark.

Dehughes – Slow into stride (1L). Near the 600 metres attempted to improve into a run where there was insufficient room to the inside of Treat Me Right and had to be restrained when that mare laid in.

Lazy Democracy – Rider Nathan Punch explained that he improved into the race as instructed, however the gelding failed to respond to his riding in the home straight. Mr Punch further added it may not be suited by the tempo of the race.

RACE 4 – AUTOBARN 2YO MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Kandahar – Jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride (2L).

Knees Are Bung – Laid out rounding the home turn. Rider Bulent Muhcu was advised his whip action was above shoulder height entering the home straight. Mr Muhcu explained that the horse laid out at this point and he was mindful of using the whip in his usual manner as Oceania Hope was in close proximity and he did not want to accidentally strike that filly.

Overplay – Raced greenly throughout and shifted in abruptly under pressure in the home straight.

The Golden Jet – Slow to begin (1L).

Gee Gee Musicmaker – Tightened near the 800 metres when Overplay was racing greenly before that colt was corrected by its rider.

Oceania Hope – Bounded in the air at the start.

RACE 5 – TAS HOTEL & CATERING SUPPLIES MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Gee Gee Pureblonde – Hampered and lost ground at the start (2L) when George's Gambol shifted out at the start and bumped with Shivida which was carried out on to Gee Gee Pureblonde.

Silver Reset – Jumped out at the start inconveniencing Roitfeld and Pura Vida.

Acheeva Dream – Harmlessly dislodged Boris Thornton enroute to the barriers. Raced greenly throughout. Rounding the turn at 700 metres shifted out away from the running rail and clipped heels of Pura Vida. Rider Boris Thornton reported that the gelding, in his opinion, raced green and was field shy. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injuries could be detected.

Shivada – Rider Hayley McCarthy was reprimanded for using the whip on seven occasions.

Pura Vida – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after being galloped on near the 700 metres, no apparent injuries could be detected.

It's Overrated – Performed below expectation. Rider Stephanie Thornton reported the filly travelled well throughout however failed to respond when placed under pressure.

RACE 6 – CORPORATE GOLF DAY BM82 HCP – 2100 METRES

White Turf – Rider Anthony Darmanin reported the mare was under pressure from the 1000 metres and felt something amiss on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination found the mare to be lame in the off fore and was treated on course. White Turf has been stood down from racing pending a veterinary certificate.

Kanji – Jumped outwards at the start. Bumped with Olly's A Star near the 400 metres.

Player One – Jumped away awkwardly and bumped with Sound Bar. Over raced in the early stages.

Smoke 'N' Whisky – Over raced in the early stages.

RACE 7 – FASHIONS FOR FILLIES 19TH FEBRUARY CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Steel Dan – Laid out rounding the home turn. Rider Chris Graham was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground as he allowed his mount to get too close to the heels of the runner in front.

Gee Gee Rich Ruby – Jumped out at the start and bumped with Quiet Wonder, inconveniencing that gelding. Lost near hind plate in running.

Bonify – Raced three wide throughout.

Assez Bien – Held up for clear racing room entering the home straight.

Ohsotuf – Rider Hayley McCarthy was permitted to ride the gelding 1kg over the allotted weight of 54kg.

RACE 8 – MILLINERY PARADE AT THE MERCURE CLASS 3 HCP – 1200 METRES

Before All – Eased down in the home straight. Rider Georgie Catania reported that the gelding changed stride throughout the event and never felt comfortable with its action and laid out. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding was sore in both front fetlocks. Before All has been stood down from racing pending a veterinary certificate.

Charlemagne's Girl – Held up on the latter part of the home turn.

Reann's Diamond – Held up on the latter part of the home turn.
