RACE 1 – NAVY MAIDEN – 3YO & UPWARDS – MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES

Mighty Hoffa - Fractious in the barriers, warning issued. Jumped away awkwardly and then slow into stride (1L).

Millmount – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

Dance South – Fractious in the barriers, warning issued. Jumped away awkwardly and had to be restrained off the heels of Gee Gee Mistachips after bumping with Miss Che Che.

Loose in Vegas – Jumped away awkwardly. Rider Adam Hyeronimus reprimanded for using his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule and the totality of his whip use.

RACE 2 – CASCADE DRAUGHT CLASS 5 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

I'm Wesley – Near the 800 metres, had to be steadied off the heels of Merrick's Beauty. Rider Ismail Toker reprimanded for using his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule and the totality of his whip use.

Gee Gee Sun Valley – Slow into stride (2L).

RACE 3 – ELWICK FUNCTION & EVENTS CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1200 METRES

Killin Falls - Laid in over the last 100 metres.

Love Magic – Slow to muster early speed.

Turtles Nest – Knuckled at the start.

Col's Hero – Rider Craig Newitt accidentally dropped his whip near the 100 metres.

RACE 4 – CARBINE CLUB 3YO PLATE - SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS - 1100 METRES

Gee Gee Spitfire – Carried in at the start by **Giselle's Girl** which jumped inwards.

Count Montagu – Rider Troy Baker was harmlessly dislodged on returning to the mounting yard. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injuries could be detected.

Gee Gee Double Dee – Over raced in the middle stages.

Giselle's Girl – Jumped inwards at the start bumping with Gee Gee Spitfire. Approaching the 900 metres had to be steadied off the heels of Gee Gee Double Dee when that filly was carried in by Chillout (Raquel Clark (a)). Rider Raquel Clark was issued with a reprimand under the provisions of AR 137(a) for careless riding.

Kepta – Slow to begin and then lost ground when bumped with Gee Gee Spitfire who was carried in by Giselle's Girl.

RACE 5 – PIMMS CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1100 METRES

The start was delayed approximately four minutes when Scuttlebutt, Another Charlee and Lonhwan were declared late scratchings on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers. Prior to the announcement of correct weight, Stewards ordered all monies invested on Lonhwan, Scuttlebutt and Another Charlee to be refunded in full. All bets made prior to 4.45 pm were to be paid less seventeen (17) cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less seventeen cents (17) in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket.

Ariconte – Rider Luke Currie reported that the gelding failed to respond to his riding in the home straight and in his opinion the gelding may have been lame in its near side fore leg. Underwent post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities could be detected.

Lonhwan - Late scratching at 4.45 pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers and becoming cast. After hearing submissions from Rider Raquel Clark, Trainer Rowan Hamer and Starter David Evans, Stewards ordered the gelding complete a satisfactory barrier trial before racing again.

Scuttlebutt - Late scratching at 4.45 pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers and striking its head resulting in bleeding from the mouth area. After hearing submissions from co-Trainer Christine Crook and Start David Evans, Stewards ordered the filly complete a satisfactory barrier trial before racing again.

Another Charlee - Late scratching at 4.45 pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers and striking its head, must complete a satisfactory barrier trial before racing again.

RACE 6 – SCHWEPPE'S TASMANIAN DERBY (LISTED) – 3YO – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS - 2200 METRES

Northwest Passage – Laid in in the home straight.

Trusted Warrior – Performed below expectations. Rider Brendon McCoull reported that the gelding may not have appreciated the firmer track surface today.

Igitur – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Rider Brad Rawiller pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule, the status of the race and the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued Brad Rawiller with a fine of \$100.

Tough Vic – Rider Anthony Darmanin accidentally dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.

Autmed - Rider Daniel Ganderton pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule, the status of the race and the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued Daniel Ganderton with a fine of \$100.

Biscay Barb – Over-raced in the early stages.

RACE 7 – MAGIC MILLIONS BOW MISTRESS (GROUP 3) – FILLIES & MARES – STANDARD WEIGHT FOR AGE – NO CLAIMS – 1200 METRES

I Love It – Entering the home straight, laid in brushing with Astro Miss. Trainer John Salanitri reported that the mare had lost an off-side fore plate during the race. Mr Salanitri further added that the mare may not have appreciated the firm track.

Lyuba – Over-raced in the early stages.

Astro Miss – Raced wide throughout.

Teriki – Rider Sigrid Carr accidentally dropped her whip approaching the 200 metre mark.

Trot On Candy – Performed below expectations. Rider Troy Baker reported that the mare was under pressure from the 500 metres before laying out rounding the home turn and failed to respond to his riding in the home straight.

Time Commands – Jumped away awkwardly and lost ground (1L). Rider Raquel Clark was questioned in regard to the tactics she adopted on the mare today, noting the mare normally races in a forward position. Ms Clark explained that with the anticipated speed in the race she did not want to be caught wide and added that the mare was racing up in class today.

RACE 8 – PFD FOOD SERVICES CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES

Solomon's Song – Late scratching at 12 noon after Trainer Scott Brunton reported that the gelding was lame. Veterinary certificate required before racing again.

Kompressor – Stood flat-footed at the start (4L), warning issued. Steadied off the heels of Magnacash rounding the home turn.

Taramaya – Stewards queried Rider Adam Hyeronimus in relation to the mare's racing manners in the early stages. Mr Hyeronimus explained that his instructions were to restrain and race back in the field but due to the slow early pace and drawing an outside barrier he had some difficulty fulfilling those instructions with the mare over racing. Mr Hyeronimus added that with the slow pace and being unable to settle the mare he elected to improve into the race passing the 1000 metres. The explanation of Mr Hyeronimus was noted.

Geegees Lillybet – Rider Troy Baker was questioned in regards to his tactics in this event as the mare led when its usual racing pattern is mid to back. Mr Baker explained that after beginning well and with the slow early pace he allowed the mare to improve forward instead of being caught wide. Mr Baker further added that the mare raced fresh after having a let-up.

Mensa Magic – Rider Ismail Toker was questioned in regards to his tactics in this event as the gelding raced forward when its usual racing pattern is mid to back. Mr Toker explained that it was his intention to settle the horse back in the field, however, after jumping well he found himself forward with the slow early pace.

Appmat – The start was delayed when Appmat lost its bridle in the barriers which then had to be refitted.
