Trainer Nigel Schuurin (Rather Heroic) and Co-trainer Kirstin Whelan (Littlerayov) were each fined the sum of \$50 for presenting their horses later than acceptable to the mounting yard prior to the start of Race 3.

RACE 1 – WOLF BLASS MAIDEN – 3YO & UPWARDS – SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES

Stewards ordered the withdrawal of **Monobrow** at 8.06 am after it was reported the Stable had omitted to scratch the mare prior to 7.30 am. Co-trainers Chris Crook and Imogen Miller were reprimanded under the provisions of LR14.1 for failing to scratch by the prescribed time. In assessing not to impose a more severe penalty Stewards took into account that their negligence did not prevent another runner from gaining a start.

Island Pirate – Slow to begin (1L).

Global Princess – Rider Anthony Darmanin reported that the mare dipped near the 75 metre mark causing him to become momentarily unbalanced.

Gold Phoenix – Jumped away awkwardly. Performed below expectations. Rider Georgie Catania explained that the filly failed to respond from the 400 metres, and she elected to ease down over the final 150 metres as she felt there may have been something amiss with the filly's action. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection and no apparent injuries could be detected.

Sunset Streaker – Over-raced in the early stages.

RACE 2 – ROSEVEARS WATERFRONT TAVERN MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS – SET WEIGHTS – 1400 METRES

Cloudy Bay - Late scratching at 12.36 pm by order of Stewards when the gelding was unable to be loaded into its barrier stall, satisfactory trial required before racing again. Prior to the announcement of correct weight, Stewards ordered all monies invested on Cloudy Bay to be refunded in full with no other betting deductions applicable.

Country Way (NZ) – Jumped outwards at the start. Over-raced from the 1100 metres until the 700 metres due to the slow pace.

Vivre Star – Approaching the 50 metres, tightened for room between Quaternion Eagle and Super Leane.

Gee Gees Free Hero – Slow to begin (1L).

Striking Prospect – Slow to begin and then had to be steadied off the heels of Like a Spectre when that gelding jumped away awkwardly and shifted ground outwards. Became unbalanced shortly afterwards.

No Money No Honey – Raced greenly in the home straight.

Liberty Ann – Slow to begin (1L). Raced greenly and shifted out approaching the 800 metres carrying Striking Prospect wider on the track.

Tom Archie – Slow to begin (1L). Raced wide throughout.

RACE 3 – CROWN LAGER BM62 HANDICAP – 2100 METRES

Rather Heroic – Apprentice Hayley McCarthy issued severe reprimand in that she used her whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account her record under this Rule, the context of the race and the totality of her whip use.

Gold Librettist – Approaching the 150 metres, shifted out taking Rather Heroic wider on the track.

Ocean Star – Laid in in the home straight.

Sport of Kings – Slow to begin (1L).

Littlerayov – Performed below market expectations. Rider Anthony Darmanin could offer no explanation.

Mediano – Slow to muster early speed (3L). Rider Raquel Clark was reprimanded for using the whip when out of contention.

Sh'bourne Dylaca – Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with Gold Librettist.

RACE 4 – SCHWEPPE'S OPEN HANDICAP – 1100 METRES

Gee Gees Jet – Rider Sigrid Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account her poor record under this Rule, the totality of her whip use and subsequently issued Sigrid Carr with a fine of \$200.

Cuban Missile – Slow to begin (1L). Inconvenienced when Gee Gees Jet jumped outwards at the start.

RACE 5 – PRICELINE ELWICK STAKES – 2YO – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS – LISTED – 1100 METRES

Foreeva was declared a late scratching at 1.25 pm acting on veterinary advice when the filly was found to be lame in its near hind leg. Foreeva has been stood down from racing pending a veterinary certificate.

Copperhead Road – Fractious in barriers, warning issued. Rider David Pires reported that the gelding failed to muster early speed.

Geegee Trendsetter – Jumped inwards at the start carrying My Summa Jam in on to Copperhead Road. Rider Craig Newitt reported that the filly had to work hard early to obtain the lead before weakening over the final stages. Rider further stated that in his opinion the filly would benefit from being able to obtain a softer run early. Jockey Craig Newitt pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued Craig Newitt with a reprimand.

Derasa – Laid in under pressure in the home straight and had to be corrected by its rider.

Pateena Arena – Laid in in the home straight and had some difficulty obtaining clear racing room.

My Summa Jam – Rider Michael Dee was harmlessly dislodged en-route to the barriers and was examined at the barriers by the on-course paramedics before the start of the race. My Summa Jam also underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was passed fit to take its place in the field. The connections were advised that My Summa Jam has had a warning placed against it due to its unruly behaviour on its way to the barriers.

RACE 6 – LUXBET THOMAS LYONS STAKES – WEIGHT FOR AGE- NO CLAIMS – LISTED – 1400 METRES

Admiral – Laid in in the home straight.

Hellova Street – Laid out over the final 100 metres.

Powercharged – Approaching the 1000 metres, had to be restrained when over-racing and placed awkwardly on the heels of Lord da Vinci before bumping with the hindquarters of Admiral.

Geegees Brightstar – Jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin (2L).

Box of Frogs – Approaching the 1100 metres, the gelding threw its head in the air when being restrained. Rider Anthony Darmanin explained that with the slow pace and being caught wide, he elected to allow his mount to stride forward as it was over-racing.

RACE 7 – LES LEES STRUTT STAKES – 3YO FILLIES – SET WEIGHTS – NO CLAIMS – LISTED – 2100 METRES

The start of this race was delayed approximately four minutes due to the late scratching of Blue Ocean at the barriers.

Hot Dipped – Inconvenienced and had to steady off the heels of Della Terra approaching the 1000 metres when that filly shifted out.

Toorak Affair – Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed the filly to have bled from its left nostril. Connections advised that Toorak Affair must complete a 1000 metre gallop in the presence of a Steward prior to racing or trialling again.

Blue Ocean – Fractious in the barriers before undergoing a veterinary examination and found to be bleeding from a laceration to right stifle area, subsequently declared a late scratching at 3.38 pm on veterinary advice. Must submit a veterinary clearance before racing again. Prior to the announcement of correct weight, Stewards ordered all monies invested on Blue Ocean to be refunded in full. All bets made prior to 3.38 pm were to be paid less thirteen (13) cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less twelve cents (12) in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket. Acting on a report from the starter a warning was issued for the filly's barrier manners.

Triband – Slow to muster early speed (2L). Rider Michael Dee pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule, the status of the race and that Triband finished third, the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued Michael Dee with a fine of \$200.

Robin's Doll – Slow to muster early speed (2L). Rider Craig Newitt pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on nine occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule, the status of the race and the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued Craig Newitt with a fine of \$300.

Husson's Kiss – Rider Georgie Catania pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on seven occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account her record under this Rule, the status of the race and the totality of her whip use and subsequently issued Georgie Catania with a fine of \$100.

RACE 8 – LUXBET HOBART CUP – NO CLAIMS – GROUP 3 – 2400 METRES

Up Cups – Eased down over the concluding stages. Rider Craig Newitt stated that he felt there may have been something amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in front, veterinary certificate required before racing again.

Lucky Lucky Lucky – Rider Luke Currie stated that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions. Rider Luke Currie pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on nine occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule, the status of the race and the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued Luke Currie with a fine of \$200.

Cool Chap – Performed below market expectations. Rider Kerrin McEvoy could offer no explanation other than the gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 500 metres.

Gladstone – Rider Anthony Darmanin pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule, the status of the race and that Gladstone finished third, the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued Anthony Darmanin with a fine of \$200.

Count da Vinci (NZ) - Rider David Pires pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on six occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record under this Rule, the status of the race and that Count da Vinci won the race, the totality of his whip use and subsequently issued David Pires with a fine of \$200.

The Princeling – Rider Raquel Clark pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on eight occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account her record under this Rule, the status of the race and the totality of her whip use and subsequently issued Raquel Clark with a fine of \$200.

RACE 9 – WINNING EDGE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Winston Wolfe – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

O'loughlin – Jumped away awkwardly and bumped with Banca Boy. Over-raced when racing wide.

Berry Wise Fox – Over-raced when racing wide.

Phantasmagoria – Stewards granted permission for Apprentice Hayley McCarthy to ride the mare half a kilogram over its allotted weight of 54.5kg.

Bounce Back – Approaching the winning post, was tightened for room when Winston Wolfe laid in under pressure carrying Banca Boy inwards.

All Bar Madison – Rider Raquel Clark was harmlessly dislodged en-route to the barriers and was examined at the barriers by the on-course paramedics before the start of the race. All Bar Madison galloped for some distance before being re-captured and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barriers before being passed suitable to race. The connections were advised that All Bar Madison has had a warning placed against it due to its unruly behaviour on the way to the barriers.

Crib Point – Jumped away awkwardly and was then hampered between Berry Wise Fox and Marbel Duke. Approaching the 600 metres attempted to improve along the rails where there was barely sufficient room and had to be restrained by its rider when Gee Gees Talk Fest laid in.

RACE 10 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS BM72 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES

Cheryl's Horse – Hampered soon after the start between Hyperbole and Don Reggio which shifted in. Stewards intend to inquire into Rider Stephanie Thorton's whip use during the event.

Blaze Forth – Momentarily tightened for racing room near the 50 metres when O'Reillys Gee Gee laid out under pressure and Harvey Bay laid in.

The Master Speed – Raced three wide without cover.

Hyperbole – Held up for clear racing room approaching the 600 metres until approaching the 400 metres. Performed below market expectations. Rider Brendon McCoull stated that after being slightly slow away and receiving some interference shortly after the start, the mare got further back than intended.

O'reillys Geegee (NZ) – Laid out under pressure in the home straight. Stewards intend to inquire into Rider Craig Newitt's whip use during the event.

You Didn't – Performed below expectations. Rider David Pires stated that after travelling wide for the majority of the event, failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres.
