### Comments

\*Trainer Rowan Hamer was fined the sum of \$50 for his late rider notifications in Race 1.

Trainers Tegan Keys, Paul Maher, Yassy Nishitani and John Blacker were all fined the sum of \$50 for presenting horses to the mounting yard later than acceptable.

### RACE 1 – TASBREEDERS BM62 HCP – 1620 METRES

**Kool Kash** – Slow to begin. Checked soon after the start and lost ground when Swinging Ali shifted in. Held up for clear racing room and unable to be fully tested. Rider Stephanie Thornton explained that after receiving interference at the start she was unable to fulfil her pre-race instructions and take up a forward position. Ms Thornton added that when she was looking to improve racing towards the home turn she was inconvenienced by Turtles Nest. Ms Thornton's explanation was noted.

**Dillon Hall** – Raced three wide in early stages before progressing forward and racing outside the leader from the 800 metres.

**Fund Trader** – Laid in in the home straight.

**Alilad** – Jumped awkwardly. Weakened from the 400 metres. Performed below expectation, Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that the gelding raced flat and hung out and, in his opinion, may have come to end of its preparation. Trainer Mr Rowan Hamer explained that he would be assessing the gelding's immediate racing future. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormalities could be detected.

**Golden Kiss** – Held up for clear racing room for a short distance entering the home straight.

**Cosmic Angel** – Late scratching at 5.35pm on veterinary advice after an incident in the float en-route to the track.

**Swinging Ali** – Tactics queried. Rider Sigrid Carr explained it was her intention to ride more positively from the outside barrier but raced further forward than anticipated as she did not want to be caught wide. Trainer Royston Carr explained it was his intentions to have the gelding ridden more positively from its outside draw with the rail out 9 metres however, was not expecting the gelding to race as far forward as it did. Stewards noted the explanations of both rider and trainer and advised Mr Carr of his obligations under the rule when varying tactics.

### RACE 2 – GRENVILLE STUD MAIDEN – 1420 METRES

**His Nibs** – Bounded in the air at the start. Over raced early stages. Raced wide throughout. Inconvenienced on home turn as French Connection laid out and Goodbye Lonesome laid in.

**Broadway Velvet** – Fractious in barriers, stood down to one satisfactory trial. Slow to begin (1L).

**Dad's Girl** – Re-saddled behind barriers prior to start. Difficult to load, warning issued.

**Ocetra** – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**Acronym** – Rider Georgie Catania momentarily lost the use of her near side rein rounding the home turn. Rider G Catania was advised to ride her mounts out to the end of the race.

**Dance South** – Fractious in barriers, stood down to one satisfactory trial. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

### **RACE 3 – PALENTINO BRED BY MACLEAY MAIDEN – 1220 METRES**

**Euro Express** – Raced wide throughout.

**Eastender** – Held up for clear racing room from the 400 metres until passing the 200 metres when able to shift in and obtain clear racing room. Rider Raquel Clark reported the gelding raced greenly throughout.

**Shivida** – Late scratching at 3.52pm when trainer Peter Luttrell reported the gelding had a boil on its jaw.

**The Financier** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after slipping in stalls and was passed suitable to race. Inconvenienced and lost its position at the start between Silky Star and Torre Velasca. Over raced in early stages.

**Bossy Bron** – Late scratching at 6.50pm on veterinary advice when the mare had a haematoma on right hind leg. Vet certificate required prior to racing again.

**Pop A Lefty** – Fractious in barriers, warning issued.

**Indigo Express** – Fractious in barriers, warning issued. Bumped at start by Gee Gee Pureblonde as that gelding jumped outwards. Trainer Angela Brakey reported that connections would be assessing the filly's immediate racing future.

**Torre Velasca** – Entering the home straight had to be steadied off the heels of Gee Gee Pureblonde who was carried out by Silky Star who in turn shifted away from Global Princess when that mare improved into a run.

### **RACE 4 – MAGIC MILLIONS 2YO CLASSIC – 1220 METRES**

**Bosporus** – Checked at start between Heavens's Delight which jumped inwards and Knees Are Bung which jumped outwards.

**Knees Are Bung** – Trainer Brendan McShane advised Stewards that they would look to ride the colt further back in the field tonight.

**Koppar Champion** – Rider Hayley McCarthy reported the gelding raced greenly.

**Phar Word** – Rounding the turn near the 700 metres was momentarily tightened and lost ground to the inside of Skwosh who was racing tightly to the inside of Oceania Hope. Passing the 600 metres had to be steadied off the heels of Knees Are Bung when that colt laid in. Raced greenly. Rider Sigrid Carr harmlessly dislodged on returning to mounting yard.

**Regal Red** – Jumped away awkwardly and soon after the start became unbalanced when taken out by Phar Word who in turn was taken out by Oceania Hope. Race wide throughout. Rider Anthony Darmanin reported the gelding raced greenly and was field shy.

**Oceania Hope** – Passing the 400 metres was momentarily tightened by the tiring Regal Red. Rider Georgie Catania reported the filly, in her opinion, has come to the end of its preparation.

**Heaven's Delight** – Rider Daniel Moor reprimanded for careless riding when he shifted in when insufficiently clear of Derasa approaching the 800 metres.

**Skwosh** – Rider Boris Thornton harmlessly dislodged en-route to barriers.

#### **RACE 5 – F&W STEWART SILVER INGOT CLASS 3 HCP – 1420 METRES**

**Gallow Gate** – Rider Daniel Moor reported the gelding was off the bit early in the event and raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

**Ryan's Daughter** – Slow to begin (4L). After considering submissions from trainer Adam Trinder and the mares history, Stewards issued a warning against the mare and advised Mr Trinder that a repeat performance will result in the mare being stood down.

**Leconte** – Re-saddled behind the barriers. Raced wide throughout.

**Scouting Around** – Fractious in barriers, warning issued.

**Streak On** – Over raced in early stages when being restrained. Laid out rounding home turn.

**Commanding Dash** – Checked at start between Gallow Gate and Killin Falls. Over raced approaching the 1000 metres.

#### **RACE 6 – TASBREEDERS MAGIC MILLIONS 3YO CLASSIC – 1220 METRES**

**Mulley's Idol** – Laid in under pressure over concluding stages.

**Happy Halloween** – Laid out under pressure in home straight.

**It's A Battle** – Rider Troy Baker was harmlessly dislodged en-route to barriers. It's A Battle then galloped free for some distance before being captured by barrier attendants. Underwent pre-race veterinary inspection and passed suitable to race. Raced wide throughout. When questioned, rider Troy Baker explained that the colt raced keenly and did not respond to his attempts to restrain and ride with cover back in the field. Mr Baker's comments were noted.

**Gemini** – Approaching the 1000 metres over raced when being restrained.

**The Wicked Witch** – Jumped in at the start and bumped with Miss Two Pairs losing ground.

#### **RACE 7 – ALPINE EAGLE @ ARMIDALE SYDESTON NIGHT CUP – 2130 METRES**

**Siorca** – Rider Troy Baker explained that when the pace increased at the 800 metres the gelding was left flat-footed.

**Smoke 'N' Whisky** – Bumped with Electric Crimson when improving into the race rounding the home turn.

#### **RACE 8 – PETER & DONNA MURPHY WEDDING ANNIVERSARY BM72 HCP – 1220 METRES**

**Just Call Me Fred** – Rider Daniel Ganderton was severely reprimanded for using his whip 7 times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his recent record and totality of his whip use.

**Seajamm** – Jumped inwards at start and bumped with Ash For Cash.

**Race 1 - Wolf Blass Maiden – 3yo & Upwards – Set Weights – 1100 Metres**

**Gold Phoenix** – Trainer Scott Brunton explained that the filly had pulled up with a degree of mucus and a scratchy action but overall he was disappointed with the filly's performance. Mr Brunton advised he is yet to decide the immediate plans for the filly.

**Race 10 - Tasmanian Horse Transport BM72 Handicap – 1400 Metres**

**Cheryl's Horse** – Rider Stephanie Thornton was issued with a severe reprimand for using her whip 7 times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into consideration her record and totality of her whip use.
