Comments:

All races were put back one race with Race 10 starting at 6.20pm due to an on-course patron requiring medical treatment prior to the first race.

RACE 1 – FINANCE BROKERS OF TASMANIA MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Gee Gee Mistachips – Starter reported was fractious in barriers, warning issued.

Loose In Vegas – Jumped inwards at start and bumped with Gee Gee Mistachips.

Tilmosa – Miss Two Pairs shifted in at the start away from Genijune and bumped with Monobrow who carried Totally Wicked in onto Some Quest resulting in **Tilmosa** being tightened and losing its position between that gelding and Aljazmic who jumped away awkwardly.

Miss Two Pairs – Raced wide throughout. Rider Ben Allen was issued with severe reprimand for using his whip 7 times prior to the 100 metres.

Sunset Streaker – Laid out throughout.

Genijune – Shifted in soon after the start. Rider Dean Yendall reported he momentarily lost the use of his reins for a short distance passing the 800 metre mark and became unbalanced. Mr Yendall added that the mare failed to respond to his riding at the 600 metres and, in his opinion, will benefit from the run.

Silver Reset – Laid in in the home straight.

RACE 2 – ROSEVEARS HOTEL BM62 HCP – 2400 METRES

Rather Heroic – Over raced throughout.

The Princeling – Rider Raquel Clark reported the gelding was not suited by the slow tempo of the event.

Sir Marmaduke – Over raced throughout.

RACE 3 – TOLL TASMANIA MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE – 1600 METRES

Dubai Hero – Slow to begin (1L). Country Way over raced approaching the 1200 metres, taking Matiano, who was trailing, outwards into the path of Danwish who was already over racing. Danwish then shifted out, inconveniencing Paint Vegas Red and hampering **Dubai Hero**. Dubai Hero then raced wide from that point onwards. Rider Craig Newitt reported that his mount slipped behind on jumping away. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have pulled up slightly lame in the off hind. Stable hand Miss Penny Cawthen was fined the sum of \$200 pursuant to AR175(k) in that she negligently collected the wrong saddle for this horse. In determining penalty, Stewards took into account her guilty plea, the potential consequences of her actions and the precedence under this rule.

Steel Dan – Performed below expectations. Rider Daniel Moor reported the gelding pulled hard and, in his opinion, did not run out the 1600 metre distance and would be more suited over 1400 metres or shorter.

Sir Valentine – Slow to begin (1L).

Pelagia – Slow to begin (1L).

Westwood – Shifted out entering the home straight and bumped with Paint Vegas Red.

RACE 4 – CRE SOLUTIONS CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Aerosport – Jumped away awkwardly. Rider Raquel Clark reported that the gelding had swallowed its tongue and will benefit from the addition of a tongue tie.

No Money No Honey – Rider David Pires was advised to exercise more care when attempting to shift runners wider on the track, Stewards took into account the mare was inclined to lay out. Rider reported the mare raced green in the home straight.

Quiet Wonder – Rider Sigrid Carr reported the gelding overrated in the early stages and laid in in the home straight.

Mr America – Jumped outwards at start and bumped with Assez Bien. Held up for clear racing room in home straight.

Little Elsa – When tiring approaching the 400 metres was tightened for room when Global Squire (B Thornton) shifted out when insufficiently clear. Rider Boris Thornton was advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances.

Global Squire – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. In the home straight, shifted out and bumped with Bounce Back and then raced awkwardly on the heels of Phantasmagoria. Rider Boris Thornton reported the horse was under pressure from the 400 metres and failed to respond to his riding.

RACE 5 – PFD FOOD SERVICES 3YO CLASSIC – 1200 METRES

Mariah's Magic – Jumped away awkwardly.

Gee Gee Double Dee – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with Chillout. Rider Sigrid Carr was reprimanded for careless riding in that approaching the 800 metres she shifted in when insufficiently clear of Chillout.

Chillout - Over raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

Gemini – Jumped away awkwardly. Over raced approaching the 800 metres. Laid in under pressure in the early part of the home straight.

Kenfromthebar – Over raced rounding the 800 metres turn and raced awkwardly.

Southern Belle – Commenced to give ground from the 500 metres before being eased down in the home straight. Rider Stephanie Thornton reported that the filly would benefit from racing down in class.

RACE 6 – STEVE’S LIQUOR GOLD SOVEREIGN – 1200 METRES

So White – Passing the 700 metres rider Boris Thornton reported he felt something amiss in the front legs of the filly and commenced to pull the horse up. As a result, Geegee Rock’n’Run and Kandahar were inconvenienced. Underwent post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormalities could be detected. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer Matthew Brown reported that the filly pulled up well apart from some minor soreness to the shins. Mr Brown further added that he believes the filly may have become unbalanced in the going and therefore gave the impressions to the rider of going amiss. Mr Brown intends on spelling the filly.

Heaven’s Delight – Performed below expectation. Trainer Gary White reported the filly was galloped on on the near hind. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have minor abrasions. Rider Daniel Moor explained that the filly did not handle the quick back up from last Wednesday and, in his opinion, has come to the end of its preparation. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer Gary White reported the filly pulled up with shin soreness and would now be spelled.

Geegee Trendsetter – Jumped outwards at the start and bumped Saint Darella.

Bosporus – Over raced when being restrained rounding the turn near the 800 metres.

Geegee Rock’n’Run – Laid in in the home straight.

Pateena Arena – Laid in in the home straight.

Gee Gee Lanett – Over raced in early stages and laid in in the home straight.

Peristrophe – Hampered at start and lost its position when Gee Gee Lanett jumped outwards, carrying Skwosh outwards, at the same time, So White jumped inwards.

Saint Darella – Dipped in the going rounding the home turn. Track was inspected and was found to be of suitable wear and tear.

RACE 7 – CITY OF LAUNCESTON OPEN HCP – 1200 METRES

Lord Da Vinci – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

Valiant Warrior – Raced wide.

Naadam – Jumped inwards at start.

Treasury Bond – Jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin (1L).

Seajamm – Held up for clear racing room entering the home straight.

I’m Wesley – Slow to begin (1L)

Issawi – Jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin (1L)

RACE 8 – LUXBET LAUNCESTON CUP – 2400 METRES

Unfurl (NZ) - Late scratching at 3.55pm on veterinary advice when the mare was found to be lame in the right fore, must produce a veterinary certificate prior to racing again. Prior to the announcement of correct weight, Stewards ordered all monies invested on Unfurl to be refunded in full. All bets made prior to 3.55 pm were to be paid less sixteen (16) cents in the dollar on the face value of the win ticket and less fourteen cents (14) in the dollar on the face value of the place ticket.

Up Cups – Entering the home straight was tightened and lost its position when Big Pegg laid out and Settler’s Stone shifted in away from Gladstone. Rider Brendon McCoull reported the gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 300 metres.

Geegees Goldengirl – Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the mare travelled well throughout, however was disappointing in the home straight.

Big Duke (IRE) - Rider Ben Allen was fined the sum of \$200 for using his whip eight (8) times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record, totality of this whip use, and that it was a Group 3 event.

Gladstone – Rider Anthony Darmanin was advised to exercise more care when crossing on the home turn on the first occasion. Rider reported that the gelding over raced and was inclined to lay out throughout the event and was disappointed in its performance.

Geegees Baritone – Raced three-wide in the early stages before finding cover. Approaching the 600 metres, was tightened and checked between Big Duke (IRE) and Our Lucky Omens (Daniel Moor) which shifted out when insufficiently clear. Rider Daniel Moor was issued with a severe reprimand for careless riding and will be notified accordingly. Rider Craig Newitt reported he felt something amiss with the gelding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities could be detected.

Miss Hissy – Raced wide in the early stages before crossing to the lead racing out of the home straight on the first occasion. Rider Cory Parish was advised to exercise more care when crossing. Tired from the 700 metres. Rider reported that, in his opinion, the mare did not back up from its last run.

Smoke 'N' Whisky – Over raced in the early stages.

Settler's Stone – Slow to begin (3L).

RACE 9 – LUXBET MOWBRAY STAKES – 1600 METRES

Red Eagle – Rider Nikita Beriman was fined the sum of \$200 for using her whip nine (9) times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account the totality of the whip use, her good record under this rule, and that it was a listed race.

Admiral – Laid in in the home straight. Rider Brendon McCoull reported that he was unhappy with the horse's action and felt it may have been amiss in the near fore. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have soreness in the near fore leg, veterinary certificate required before racing again.

Hellova Street – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

Jerilderie Letter – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

Miss It And A Bit – Jumped away awkwardly and slow to begin (1L). Rider Sigrid Carr reported that she was hit in the face by a clod from the track near the 500 metres and, at the same time, her whip was dislodged from her hand.

Box Of Frogs – Laid out in the home straight.

Powercharged – Rider Ismail Toker was issued a severe reprimand for using his whip six (6) times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his very good record under the rule and totality of his whip use.

RACE 10 – MCKILLOPS INSURANCE BROKERS CLASS 3 HCP – 1600 METRES

Taramaya – Rider David Pires was fined the sum of \$200 for using his whip seven (7) times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account the totality of his whip use and his recent record under the rule.

Scouting Around – Laid in approaching the home turn. Rider Boris Thornton reprimanded for using his whip seven (7) times prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account the totality of his whip use and his very good record under the rule.

Amaword – Laid out rounding the home turn, taking Intriguingly out on to Taramaya.

Intriguingly – Over raced in early stages.

Kompressor – Slow to begin (1L).

Welcome Invader – Laid in on the latter part of the home turn.

Geegees Lillybet – Slow to begin then taking outwards by Mensa Magic.

SUPPLEMENTARY REPORTS

Sunday 5 February 2017 - Tasmanian Racing Club

Race 10 – Tasmanian Horse Transport BM72 Hcp (1400 metres)

O'Reillys Geegee (NZ) – Rider Craig Newitt was fined the sum of \$300 for using his whip on nine (9) occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his record and totality of his whip use. Mr Newitt was further reprimanded for using his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metre mark.

Wednesday 15 February 2017 – Tasmanian Turf Club

Race 2 – Grenville Stud Maiden (1420 metres)

Dad's Girl – Trainer Vern Poke was advised to ensure that his gear is correctly fitted to his runners when saddling.

Sunday 19 February 2017 – Tasmanian Turf Club

Rider David Pires was issued a severe reprimand pursuant to AR83A for his inappropriate language during a Steward's inquiry.

Race 2 – goracingrtasmania.com Mdn/Cl1 (2100 metres)

Northern Command – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a haematoma over its right tricep, must produce a veterinary certificate before racing again.

Race 3 – Gazman Class 1 Hcp (1200 metres)

Farewell Angelina – Queried poor performance. Rider Stephanie Thornton reported that the mare failed to respond to her riding from the 600 metres and, in her opinion, it had come to the end of its preparation. Trainer Scott Brunton explained that the mare had pulled up with a scratchy action and will now be sent for a spell.

Race 4 – Kachoo Style BM62 Handicap (1400m)

Episodes – When question into his lack of vigour of the last 100 metres, Rider Daniel Ganderton explained that the gelding was not responding to his riding and in his opinion did not appreciate the shifty track and is a horse that prefers to race on the synthetic or a firm surface. Mr Ganderton was advised to make more of an effort when riding out to the end of the race.

Race 6 – Brooklyn Park Agistment Tasmanian Oaks (2100 metres)

Toorak Affair – Rider Sigrid Carr was fined the sum of \$400 for using the whip on seven (7) occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account the totality of her whip use, her poor record under this rule and also that it was a listed race.

Race 7 – Armidale Stud Needs Further Vamos Stakes (1400 metres)

Must Be Mink – Rider Dean Yendall was fined the sum of \$200 for using the whip on nine (9) occasions prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account his very good record, the status of the race and the totality of his whip use.
