Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – ALLEN WILLIAMS MEMORIAL PACE HEAT FIVE – 2090 METRES

MEMORY OF LOVE after showing gate speed then tired to finish beaten 71 metres and has now been placed on its last chance to race truly.

FOUR OUNCES which tired to finish distanced has now been stood from racing for 14 days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials. Trainer Ben Yole advised that the mare would no longer continue in his stable.

MON MON POPPY broke in the latter part of the score up and then tailed the field taking no competitive part in the event. MON MON POPPY will continue out of the draw.

ABS BOY which broke in the score up will continue right out of the draw for mobile starts. The gelding then broke free of interference whilst racing in a trailing position on the first turn and has now been stood down from racing for a period of 10 days and until completion of a satisfactory trial. Stewards enquired into the reasons for ABS BOY then racing rough whilst attempting to shift from a trailing position on the back of LOCKAWAY KACIE in the back straight on the final occasion and after taking evidence from drivers Danny Malone (ABS BOY) and Maree Blake (LOCKAWAY KACIE), Mr Malone pleaded guilty to a charge of careless driving for allowing his drive ABS BOY to contact the sulky of LOCKAWAY KACIE (Maree Blake). Mr Malone was fined the sum of \$100.

RACE 2 – STNA WINTER ROSTER MARCH 18 PACE – 1609 METRES

The start of this event was delayed due to an Alexandra Park Harness race running behind schedule.

RUSTY RED COMET broke in the score up and was out of position at the start and has been placed out of the draw.

MARTYS FOR REAL tired after racing outside the leader.

SIGN OF ORO which raced three wide then hung in racing off the back straight on the final occasion and contacted the sulky of ISINBAEVA LEIS and broke. SIGN OF ORO has now been placed on its last chance to race truly.

RACE 3 – SNTA/TPC JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS PACE – 2090 METRES

UNION FORCE tired after racing three wide in the early stages to finish in eleventh place beaten 134 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities. After taking evidence from drivers Tim Yole (UNION FORCE), Paul Williams (METRO DIGBY) and Braden Howlett (WASONIE SNAKE), Mr Yole was found guilty of a charge under AHRR149(1) “a driver shall take all reasonable and permissible measures during the running of a race to ensure their drive is given full opportunity to win or obtain the best possible placing.” The particulars of the charge were that Mr Yole progressed forward from his wide draw and persisted in racing four wide and later three wide around the first turn, and then continued to challenge for the position outside the leader down the back straight until after the start of the last mile which the Stewards stated was the major contributing factor in his horse then tiring to finish eleventh (11th), beaten 134 metres, and further stated his actions did not give UNION FORCE the full opportunity to win or obtain the best possible placing and were not reasonable or permissible given the established racing pattern and exposed form of both his own drive and the runners drawn to his inside. After hearing submissions on penalty Mr Yole’s licence to drive in races was suspended for eight (8) race dates, commencing midnight tonight and expiring at midnight on 23 March 2017.

DO IT FOR DAVE which was out of position at the start will continue out of the draw.

Stewards inquired into the reasons for ALPINION (Paul Hill) breaking on the home turn whilst racing between CAMPAIGN DRIVE (Todd Rattray) and THATSWHATSHESAID (Christian Salter). Mr Salter was found guilty of a charge under AR163(1)(a)(iii) a driver shall not cause interference, the particulars being that, after shifting from the peg line to the running line racing off the back straight when OUR PERCIUS NZ (Gareth Rattray) shifted three wide, a short time later Mr Salter then continued to shift wider on the track in an endeavour to get to a three wide position to the outside of OUR PERCIUS NZ whilst, at that stage, ALPINION, CAMPAIGN DRIVE and DO IT FOR DAVE were all racing to his outside. As a consequence, ALPINION was then taken wider on the track and contacted the sulky of CAMPAIGN DRIVE (Todd Rattray) with its off hind leg and then broke. Mr Salter’s licence to drive in races was suspended for four (4) race dates. Mr Salter sought and was granted a deferment with his suspension to commence at midnight 4 March 2017 and to expire at midnight 18 March 2017.

Mr Salter also pleaded guilty to a charge for misconduct in misconducting himself during the inquiry under the provisions of AR231(2) and was fined the sum of \$200.

RACE 4 – STNA JUNIOR UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM PACE – 2090 METRES

BURITON BAILEY NZ was claimed by Michael Laughner of Westbury.

Post-race swab samples were taken from ANINCHOFHISLIFE, winner of this event.

RACE 5 – STINGAS DEVELOPMENT SQUAD PACE – 2090 METRES

PLAYING ARKABELLA was unable to muster sufficient gate speed to hold the lead from its inside barrier.

There were no racing incidents during the running of this event.

RACE 6 – RELISH CATERING PACE – 2090 METRES

Stewards will inquire into the reasons for PLATINUM BELLE (Adrian Collins) contacting marker pegs rounding the home turn.

GENERAL

CARRICK PARK PACING CLUB 18 FEBRUARY 2017 – RACE 2

Driver Paul Hill pleaded guilty to a charge under AR156(2) the particulars being that he used his whip in a free hand manner as the driver of IDEN AMRAK in the home straight on sixteen (16) occasions. Mr Hill's licence to drive in races was suspended for three (3) race dates commencing midnight tonight and expiring midnight 5 March 2017.
