**Prior to the start of Race 1, Sky advised that due to Gosford being abandoned the start times for today's TRC race meeting would all move back 8 minutes for better coverage.**

Trainer Marion Dalco (Genijune) was fined the sum of \$50 for presenting her horse later than acceptable to the mounting yard prior to the start of Race 3.

### **RACE 1 – A J CONCRETING 2YO MAIDEN – SET WEIGHTS – 1000 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 12.33 pm to 12.41 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Kandahar** – Jumped awkwardly.

**Phar Word** – Difficult to load, warning issued.

**I'm a Lucky Girl** – Rider Craig Luttrell was reprimanded, careless riding, the carelessness being that on the latter part of the home turn and into the home straight, he shifted wider on the track when insufficiently clear of **Gee Gee Lanett** forcing that filly wider. Performed below market expectations. Rider Craig Luttrell reported that the filly failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres and he indicated to the Trainer that the filly would benefit with the addition of a tongue tie and blinkers.

**Trixie Dixie** – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn. Raced greenly in the home straight.

**Words In Motion** – Slow to begin (1L).

**Foreeva** – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

### **RACE 2 – McKAY TIMBER BENCHMARK 82 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 1.08 pm to 1.16 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Gee Gees Top Notch** – Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

**Step the Pedal** – Momentarily held up rounding the home turn.

**Extended Warranty** – Slow to begin (1L).

### **RACE 3 – WOLF BLASS MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS – SET WEIGHTS – 1100 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 1.43 pm to 1.51 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Dragonbite** - Raced greenly throughout. Passing the 800 metres had to be steadied when momentarily tightened for room between **Weekend Whisky** which shifted out slightly and **Starity Miss** which shifted in.

**Euro Express** – Slow to muster early speed (2L).

**Tom Archie** – Jumped away awkwardly and then hampered when Cloudy Bay jumped inwards and My Kingdom shifted out. Raced wide throughout.

**Monobrow** – Raced wide throughout. Performed below expectations. Rider Brendon McCoull stated that the filly raced keenly and was caught wide throughout the event and failed to run on when placed under pressure.

**Starity Miss** – Jumped away awkwardly

**Genijune** – Soon after the start became momentarily unbalanced when contacted by Starity Miss who was carried out by Dragonbite. Approaching the 400 metres steadied off the heels of Starity Miss.

### **RACE 4 – ANDREW WALTER CONSTRUCTIONS MAIDEN 3YO & UPWARDS – SET WEIGHTS – 1400 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 2.18 pm to 2.26 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

This race was delayed two minutes due to Eagle Farm Race 3 running behind schedule.

**Bad Luck** – Slow to begin (1L). Soon after the start checked off the heels of **Gee Gee Mistachips** when that gelding shifted away from **Super Leane** who was carried out by **Gee Gees Free Hero** which jumped awkwardly.

**Gee Gee Mistachips** – Raced wide throughout.

**Gee Gees Free Hero** – Raced wide throughout. Rider Sigrid Carr reported that the gelding was inclined to lay in in the home straight.

**Totally Wicked** – Approaching the 400 metres was held up for clear racing room.

**Shivida** – Slow to begin (1L).

**Ocetra** – Slow to begin (2L). Rounding the turn at the 1200 metres over reacted to Super Leane shifting in and hung out carrying **Shivida** and **Bad Luck** wider on the track.

**Liberty Ann** – Slow to begin (1L).

**One Before You Go** – Over raced in the middle stages.

### **RACE 5 – HOTONDO HOMES MAIDEN CLASS 1 HANDICAP – SET WEIGHTS – 2100 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 2.58 pm to 3.06 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Sir Marmaduke** – Rider Shiralee Maher was reprimanded for careless riding, the carelessness being that rounding the home turn and entering the home straight, she shifted wider on the track when insufficiently clear of **Fearless Filou (NZ)** forcing that mare wider on the track and **Biscay Barb** to its outside was placed awkwardly on that mare's heels.

**Biscay Barb** – Performed below expectations. Rider Daniel Ganderton reported that the gelding over-raced in the early stages and after being inconvenienced rounding the home turn, failed to run on. Mr Ganderton added that in his opinion, the gelding may have come to the end of its preparation.

**Quaternion Eagle** – Hampered soon after the start and lost its position when Sir Marmaduke began awkwardly and shifted out.

**Paint Vegas Red** – Over-raced in the early stages.

**Broadway Velvet** – Queried improved performance. Trainer Bill Ryan explained that the mare has been racing over shorter distances and appreciated the step up to a more suitable distance today.

#### **RACE 6 – CROWN LAGER BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP – 1600 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 3.38 pm to 3.46 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Player One** – Over-raced in the early stages.

**Son of Faith** – Over-raced in the early stages.

**Taramaya** – Over-raced in the early stages before Rider Stephanie Thornton allowed the mare to progress forward approaching the 1000 metres. Threw its head in the air approaching the 800 metres when attempting to be restrained.

**Treat Me Right** – Near the 600 metres steadied off the heels of Fund Trader who shifted in away from Player One.

#### **RACE 7 – A Q MEMORIAL CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1100 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 4.18 pm to 4.26 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Jacques** – Difficult to load, warning issued.

**Scuttlebutt** – Difficult to load, warning issued.

**Global Princess** – Commenced to hang out from the 600 metres and proved difficult to ride before being eased down by its rider. Rider Shuji Amano was then harmlessly dislodged. Mr Amano explained that as he was unable to find cover, the horse began to race keenly and hung out from the 600 metre mark. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormalities. Connections advised that Global Princess has been stood down to one satisfactory trial.

**Almost Art** – Rider Chris Graham was found guilty of careless riding pursuant to AR 137(a), the carelessness being that passing the 800 metre mark he allowed his mount to shift in carrying **Jacques** inwards across the rightful running of **Island Pirate** which had to be checked by its rider. Mr Graham's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of two (2) Tasmanian race meetings, commencing midnight 8 March 2017 and expiring midnight 22 March 2017

**Island Pirate** – Slow to begin (1L). Checked passing the 800 metres.

**Ansaam** – Raced wide throughout.

## **RACE 8 – ROTARY GLENORCHY CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1400 METRES**

The start time for this race was amended from 4.58 pm to 5.06 pm. This information was disseminated via social media and the Course Broadcaster prior to the start of the race.

**Ryan's Daughter** – Refused to jump and took no competitive part in the event. Due to the mare's poor history has been stood down from racing until the completion of two satisfactory consecutive trials. Representative Leah Goodrick explained that the connections will be assessing the immediate racing future of the mare.

**Boart** – Raced keenly. Approaching the 600 metres, attempted to improve into a run where there was barely sufficient room and had to be restrained by its rider.

**Prominent Star** – Slow to muster early speed (3L)
