Trainers John Keys and John Luttrell were reprimanded for late notification of riders tonight.

### **RACE 1 – KINGS MEADOWS PHARMACY MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES**

**New Release** – Trainer/representative Mrs Leah Wells advised Stewards connections would attempt to have the gelding ridden further forward tonight, ridden accordingly

**Fought For** – Trainer Mr Stephen Lockhart advised Stewards connections would attempt to have the gelding ridden further forward tonight, ridden accordingly. Underwent pre-race veterinary inspection after competing at the Hobart trials on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> March and passed suitable to race.

**Matiano** – Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

**Westwood** – Rider Daniel Moor reported his mount failed to respond to his riding throughout.

**Lord Derby** – Over raced when racing three wide in the early stages.

**Bounce Back** – Over raced in the early stages. Rider Georgie Catania reported the mare failed to respond from the 800 metres. Made respiratory noise on pulling up. Underwent post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities could be detected.

**His Nibs** – Over raced in the early stages.

**Striking Prospect** – Jumped awkwardly. Slow to begin (2L).

**Mystic Spirit** – Approaching the 75 metres was disappointed for run between Matiano and Lord Derby. Rider Chris Graham advised to exercise more care when shifting ground inwards near the 1200 metres when insufficiently clear of Bounce Back.

### **RACE 2 – JUDY'S BODY FASHIONS MAIDEN – 1200 METRES**

**St De Sales** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not started in races for in excess of 12 months, passed suitable to race.

**Sebring Star** – Jumped away awkwardly and slow to begin (2L). Rider Brendan McCoull reported the gelding raced greenly and made a respiratory noise on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and reported to have poor respiratory and heart rate recovery consistent with displaced soft palate.

**Drinks At Rosie's** – Bumped at the start between Silky Star and Mystic Molly. Laid in under pressure in home straight.

**Mystic Molly** – Hampered at the start between Pop A Lefty and Drinks At Rosie's. Over raced in the early stages. Laid in under pressure in home straight.

**Pure Vida** – Rider Sigrid Carr could offer no explanation for the mare's performance.

**Tilmosa** – Rider David Pires reported the mare travelled well, however failed to respond to his riding from the 500 metres.

**Silky Star** – Bumped at the start with Drinks At Rosie's.

### **RACE 3 – GET WELL RICHARD COSSINS CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES**

**Liffey Lad** – Stewards intend to inquire into the reasons for the gelding losing its position approaching the 1200 metres.

**Ariconte** – Over raced in early stages. When questioned rider Chris Graham explained that he was reluctant to ride his mount out to the end of the race as he was mindful of Quiet Wonder laying in and that Ariconte changed stride. Whilst Stewards noted the explanation tendered Mr Graham was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out to the line.

**Aerosport** – Jumped in at the start and raced fierce in the early stages. Rider Anthony Darmanin reported the gelding hung out, locked its jaw and proved difficult to ride. Trainer Barry Campbell reported he would be looking to step the gelding up in distance to the mile and look to race further forward. Warning issued for its racing manners.

**Quiet Wonder** – Approaching the 1100 metres when attempting to allow Aerosport more room, as that gelding was over racing, shifted out and bumped Liffey Lad out on to Total Control who made contact with Mercury Queen. Held up for clear racing room until passing the 200 metres.

**Mr America** – Jumped away awkwardly. Over raced in the early stages.

**Little Elsa** – Rider Troy Baker was found guilty of a charge of careless riding AR137(a), the carelessness being that passing the 400 metres he shifted out and made heavy contact with Aerosport, forcing that horse wider and becoming unbalanced and, as a result, Owens who was trailing was inconvenienced and Mercury Queen who was trailing Owens had to be checked. Mr Baker's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of two Tasmanian race dates commencing midnight 15 March 2017 and expiring midnight 26 March 2017.

### **RACE 4 – ROUTLEY'S MENSWEAR 3YO HCP – 1200 METRES**

**Gemini** – Inconvenienced at start between Gee Gee Double Dee and Happy Halloween.

### **RACE 5 – MERCURE HOTEL LAUNCESTON BM62 HCP – 1400 METRES**

**Speckie** - Declared a late scratching at 6.00pm on veterinary advice when it was found to be lame in the off fore leg. A veterinary certificate must be produced prior to racing again.

**Speranta (NZ)** – Starter reported difficult to load, warning issued. Rider Brendan McCoull reported the mare did not feel comfortable in its action in particular its off fore. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination no abnormalities detected.

**Reann's Diamond** – Raced wide throughout.

**Kool Kash** – Rider Shiralee Maher reported the gelding slipped rounding the turn at the 700m. Track inspected and found of suitable wear.

**Strathalbyn** – Rider Daniel Moor reported the gelding failed to respond to his riding.

## **RACE 6 – AUTOBARN BM82 HCP – 1200 METRES**

**Treasury Bond** – Slow to begin (2L).

**Concentrate** – Queried poor performance. Rider Sigrid Carr explained the gelding failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure and blew excessively post-race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities could be detected. Trainer Cameron Thompson reported that the gelding did not appreciate racing behind runners on the inside part of the track and prefers firmer going. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer reported the gelding pulled up well and he plans to continue on with its preparation.

**Apriano** – Laid out under pressure over concluding stages. Rider Sherry Barr pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding AR137(a), the carelessness being that passing the 900 metres she shifted in when insufficiently clear of Silver Bolt who had to be checked by its rider to avoid that gelding's heels. Ms Barr's licence to ride in races was suspended for one (1) Tasmanian race date, commencing midnight 8 March 2017 and expiring midnight 15 March 2017.

**Silver Bolt** – Checked passing the 900 metres.

## **RACE 7 – SUE'S OF INVERMAY CLASS 2 HCP – 1200 METRES**

**Jo Anconi** – Queried poor performance. Rider David Pires reported the mare over raced and failed to finish off and would benefit from the run after having a let up.

**Tough Missile** – Rider Troy Baker reported his mount over raced.

## **RACE 8 – WHATSONIN.COM.AU BM82 HCP – 2100 METRES**

**Speed Force** – Laid out under pressure in home straight.

**Big Pegg** – Rider Georgie Catania was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground approaching the winning post on the first occasion.
