Comments / Explanations:

Trainer Scott Brunton was fined the sum of \$50 for his late notification of riders for tonight's events.

RACE 1 – SCOTT BRUNTON MAIDEN/CLASS 1 HCP – 1600 METRES

Dubai Hero – Slow to begin (1L) and raced wide throughout.

Westwood – Slow to begin (1L). Rider Brendon McCoull reprimanded for using his whip on 7 occasions prior to the 100 metres.

Assez Bien – Slow to begin (1L). Held up for clear racing room on the latter part of the home turn and in the home straight. Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres when Teddy's Fault laid out.

Cincha – Bumped with Country Way on jumping away. Laid in under pressure in home straight.

Super Leane – Tightened passing the 200 metres when Aerosport laid in.

Totally Wicked – Raced wide throughout.

Gee Gee Mistachips – Over raced in the early stages.

Miss Warrior – Under pressure from the 800 metres and tired from the 600 metres. Rider Boris Thornton explained the filly felt awkward in its action and failed to respond to his riding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormalities could be detected. Trainer Adam Trinder advised the filly will be sent for a spell.

RACE 2 – JOHN BLACKER 2YO MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

Geegee Blackprince – Rider Sigrid Carr reported the colt raced greenly throughout.

Nordic Thunder – Shifted in near the 800 metres when insufficiently clear of Trixie Dixie who was racing keenly. Rider Brendon McCoull advised to exercise more care.

Rhode Away – Began awkwardly and was slow to begin (2L).

Words In Motion – Raced wide throughout.

J'nine's Delight – Inclined to lay in throughout the event.

Jayemara – Jumped inwards at start and bumped with Nordic Thunder.

Copperhead Road – Slow to begin (3L).

RACE 3 – TASRACING APPRENTICE SERIES BM62 HCP – 1200 METRES

Speckie – Approaching 400 metres when racing in restricted room was inconvenienced when Tara's Gem (Stephen Brown) shifted in when insufficiently clear. Rider Stephen Brown advised to exercise more care when in similar circumstances.

Bedrock Dreams – Performed below market expectation. Rider Nathan Punch explained that his mount failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres and, in his opinion, will benefit from the run as the mare was blowing excessively post-race.

Astro Miss – Acting on a report from the starter that the mare was difficult to load, warning issued on the mare's manners. Over raced.

Cyclone Jess – Laid out under pressure in home straight.

RACE 4 – STUART GANDY MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Epidexios – Slow to begin (1L).

Sebring Star – Raced wide throughout.

Miss Chat A Lot – When racing keenly, shifted out rounding the turn at the 700 metres, taking Epidexios wider on the track.

RACE 5 – NATIONAL APPRENTICE SERIES HEAT 4 CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

The Austrian Oak (NZ) – Jumped away awkwardly, slow to begin (1L). Performed below market expectation. Rider Hayley McCarthy reported the gelding raced flat throughout the event. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be making a profound respiratory noise on returning to scale. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer Cameron Thompson explained that the gelding possibly has a virus and he will be taking blood samples. Mr Thompson further added that the respiratory noise is due to a throat operation and is normal for the gelding.

Mercury Queen – Slow to begin (1L). Raced wide throughout.

Schillie Billie – Over raced in early stages.

Please Dance NZ – Jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 6 – BARRY CAMPBELL MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Dragonbite – Rider Craig Luttrell severely reprimanded for shifting in when insufficiently clear of Gee Gees Free Hero approaching the 1200 metres. Tired noticeably from 300 metres and eased out of the event. Rider Craig Luttrell reported the gelding felt amiss in the near fore. Underwent post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a very poor heart rate recovery. Veterinary certificate of fitness required before racing again. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer John Luttrell explained the gelding had pulled up well, however will be getting bloods tested as the horse may be suffering from a virus.

Shivada – Rider Hayley McCarthy reported the gelding hung out in the event.

Blushing Pink – Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with Stringer.

Genijune – Tired noticeably from the 300 metres.

Ocetra – Rider Mehmet Ulucinar was found guilty of a charge of careless riding, the carelessness being that approaching the 400 metres he attempted to take a run between Genijune and Dragonbite where, in the opinion of Stewards, there was insufficient room and, in doing so, made contact with both runners, with all three runners becoming unbalanced. Blushing Pink, who was following, was inconvenienced. Mr Ulucinar's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of one (1) Tasmanian race date, to commence at midnight 26 March 2017 and expire at midnight 29 March 2017.

RACE 7 – LEON, DEAN & TRENT WELLS BM72 HCP – 1400 METRES

Blaze Forth – Laid out away from Harvey Bay entering the home straight and carried Ash For Cash wider on the track.

Harvey Bay – Laid in under pressure from approximately the 150 metre mark until near the 50 metre mark, carrying Stella Etoile inwards.

Spihro – Laid out under pressure in the home straight.

Taramaya – Jumped away awkwardly and slow to begin. Performed below market expectation. Rider Georgie Catania explained the mare was inclined to hang out throughout the event and, in her opinion, may have come to the end of its preparation. Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer representative David Brunton advised the mare will be going for a freshen up.

RACE 8 – GRAEME MCCULLOCH CLASS 3 HCP – 1200 METRES

O'Lonh Star – Over raced in early stages.
