

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

RACE 1 – CASCADE BREWERY MDN/CLASS 1 – 1600 METRES

Matiano – Raced wide in the middle stages and made the turn into the straight wide. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormalities could be detected.

Eastender – Held up approaching the 600 metres and near the 500 metres angled outwards and made heavy contact with Assez Bien.

Assez Bien – Slow into stride. Raced wide from the 600 metres and bumped heavily near the 500 metres. When questioned, rider Daniel Ganderton explained that he elected to make a run on the outside as he had clear running. Bumped passing the 200 metres. Assez Bien underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be lame in the off fore leg. Trainer Mr K Hamilton was advised that a veterinary certificate of soundness must be produced before Assez Bien next races.

Akbar Jay – Bumped heavily shortly after the start.

Cloudy Bay – Raced wide in the early stages.

Synapse – Slow into stride.

Drinks At Rosie's – Veered outwards on jumping, bumping heavily.

Betting transactions will be further investigated on this event.

RACE 2 – LUXBET 2YO HCP – 1200 METRES

Gee Gee Lanett – Laid inwards under pressure.

Gee Gees Queenie – Fractious in the saddling stall prior to the race and, as a consequence, underwent a veterinary examination and, again, was examined at the barrier and passed to take its place in the field. Buffeted at the turn into the straight when Clean Acheeva lay outwards.

Clean Acheeva – Slow into stride. Hung outwards from the 600 metres and at the turn into the straight shifted outwards, making contact with Gee Gees Queenie. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent abnormalities could be detected.

Stewards questioned rider Chris Graham (Clean Acheeva) and Sigrid Carr (Gee Gees Queenie) in relation to an incident approaching the turn and on straightening. C Graham advised that Clean Acheeva had commenced to hang out approaching the turn and despite his efforts to keep the filly straight, Clean Acheeva had continued to lay out and bump with Gee Gees Queenie. Stewards accepted that Clean Acheeva was laying out and C Graham had endeavoured to correct that filly from shifting out.

RACE 3 – THE BOATHOUSE MAIDEN – 1200 METRES

Lads Curfew – Slow into stride and shortly after, the buckle on the off side stirrup leather worked loose placing rider Bulent Muhcu at a severe disadvantage. After this, the gelding could not be ridden out and took no competitive part in the race.

Ten Of Eight – Hung inwards in the straight.

Sebring Star – Got its head up in the early stages of the race.

Mystic Molly – Raced wide in the early and middle stages. Rider Georgie Catania was reprimanded for using her whip six (6) times prior to the 100 metres.

RACE 4 – TASSIE INSTANT MARQUEES MAIDEN – 1400 METRES

Kryzor – Raced wide throughout.

New Release – Commenced awkwardly.

Striking Prospect – Stewards approved a late blinker change on the gelding. Carried inwards shortly after the start.

French Connection – Lay inwards in the straight.

RACE 5 – WHAT'S ON IN APP CLASS 1 HCP – 1400 METRES

Liffey Lad – Stewards approved a late gear change of a Norton bit addition. Over raced in early and middle stages getting its head in the air. Bumped at 1100 metres

Gemini – Approaching the 900 metres restrained and lost ground.

Global Princess – Bumped at 1100 metres.

Apprentice Chris Graham (**It's A Battle**) was found guilty of a charge of careless riding AR137(a) in that near the 900 metres he has allowed his mount to shift in when not clear, causing **Gemini** (Anthony Darmanin) to restrain and lose ground. C Graham's licence to ride in races for a period of 2 race dates, commencing midnight 5 April 2017 and expiring midnight 12 April 2017.

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN ST LEGER ON 21 MAY BM82 HCP – 1600 METRES

Beaufort Lad – Lay inwards from the 600 metres and bumped Hyperbole approaching the 100 metres.

Hyperbole – Bumped Beaufort Lad leaving the 100 metres.

Stable Foreman Mr Stuart Brunton was fined the sum of \$300 pursuant to AR140A(3) for failing to properly saddle Cheryl's Horse in that he left a lead bag off during the saddling procedure. The absence of the lead bag was discovered whilst in the parade ring and Cheryl's Horse was returned to the saddling stalls and correctly saddled.

RACE 7 – GREAT NORTHERN BEER CLASS 3 HCP – 1200 METRES

Love Magic – Lay inwards under pressure.

RACE 8 – CITY OF LAUNCESTON CLASS 1 HCP – 1200 METRES

Kryptonian – Slow to begin.

Strategic Moves – Slow to begin. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Stewards intend to inquire into the whip use of rider Sigrid Carr.

Scuttlebutt – Rider Troy Baker reported that the filly did not handle the track conditions this evening.

Apprentice Chris Graham (Liffeybeau) was fined the sum of \$200 pursuant to AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip on seven (7) occasions prior to the 100 metres
