1st**RACE 1 – CURTAINS AND BLINDS – GRADE 6 – 515 METRES**

Desert Racer and Quintessa were slow out. Soon after the start Cawbourne Dawnie and Sweet Abbella bumped. Shortly after, Cawbourne Lilly and Kalaway Betty bumped, checking both greyhounds. On the first turn, Desert Racer and Cawbourne Dawnie bumped, checking both greyhounds. At the same time, Cawbourne Lilly galloped on the heels of Sweet Abbella. Shortly after, Sweet Abbella checked off the heels of Desert Racer. On the second turn Quintessa checked off the heels of Desert Racer. On the third turn Quintessa galloped on the heels of Desert Racer. In the home straight Lest We marred the running of Gotta Be you. Lest We underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have spike wounds to the left hind toes. Lest We has been stood down from racing for a period of 5 days. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr R Stocks in relation to the race manners of Lest We in the home straight. Acting on their own observations, viewing the official replays and taking evidence from Mr Stocks, Stewards were of the opinion that Lest We turned its head outwards towards Gotta Be You and made head and muzzle contact with that greyhound and, in doing so, marred the running of that greyhound pursuant to GAR 69(1). Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(2)(a) Lest We has been stood down from racing for a period of 28 days at Launceston and until the completion of a satisfactory trial. Sweet Abbella underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected.

RACE 2 – KINGSLEY JARMAN FENCING – JM – 278 METRES

Manila Sal was slow out. Soon after the start Prancing Black checked off the heels of Miss Fencer. Shortly after, Miss Fencer, Jack Halestorm and Slip Streamer bumped. At the same time Manila Sal checked off the heels of Devil's Gate. In the back straight Slip Streamer, Jack Halestorm and Miss Fencer bumped. On the first turn, Slip Streamer, Jack Halestorm, Prancing Black and Miss Fencer bumped, checking Jack Halestorm, Miss Fencer, Slip Streamer and Stylish April. On the home turn Manila Sal and Devil's Gate bumped, checking both greyhounds. Shortly after, Miss Fencer galloped on the heels of Devil's Gate, checking Miss Fencer, Devil's Gate and Jack Halestorm. A post-race swab sample was taken from Arnhem Invader, winner of the event.

RACE 3 – LUXBET RACING CENTRE – FFA – 278 METRES

Dilston Loch stumbled on box rise and, as a result, was very slow out. Soon after the start, Wynburn Hornet, Provenance, Senor Slamma, Dilston Delight and Centre Pine bumped, checking Provenance, Senor Slamma and Dilston Delight. In the back straight Provenance checked off the heels of Centre Pine, severely checking Dilston Delight which contacted the rail. On the first turn Wynburn Hornet crossed to the rail, checking Centre Pine. Dilston Delight underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. Dilston Loch underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have superficial grazes to the top of the toes on the right hind paw. Dilston Loch has been stood down from racing for a period of 5 days.

RACE 4 – ULVERSTONE PET FOODS – GRADE 4(1) – 515 METRES

Lucky Nineteen was slow out. In the front straight, Bel Air Mist and Softie Sue bumped, checking Softie Sue. Approaching the first turn Sizzling Bandit and Bassett bumped, checking Bassett and Bel Air Mist. On the second turn, Sizzling Bandit, Bassett and Bel Air Mist bumped. On the third turn, Sizzling Bandit checked off the heels of Bassett, checking Bel Air Mist.

RUN ON: 1 4 5 3 2 6 7 MARGINS: 2 ½ x 2 ¼ TIME: 30.06

RACE 5 – LAUNCESTON MITSUBISHI – GRADE 4(2) – 515 METRES

Adam's Snow was slow out. In the front straight Redhot Coles and Adam's Snow bumped. Shortly after Take The Crown, Redhot Coles and Adam's Snow bumped. Approaching the first turn Take The Crown and Adam's Snow bumped, checking both greyhounds. Take The Crown underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have a laceration to the tip of the tail and superficial grazes to both hind metatarsals. Take The Crown has been stood down from racing for a period of 5 days.

RACE 6 – SIMONS CARPET ONE – GRADE 5(1) – 515 METRES

Izzy A Prince was slow out. Soon after the start, Tom Tom Drum and Adam's Lilly bumped. Approaching the first turn Adam's Lilly crossed to the rail, checking Tom Tom Drum, Hello Birdy, Platinum Cye and Devil's Gullet. As a result, Izzy A Prince checked off the heels of Tom Tom Drum. On the first turn Adam's Lilly galloped on the heels of Runout Babe, checking Runout Babe which then raced wide rounding the first and second turn. Shortly after, Frosty's Capable and Izzy A Prince bumped. On the home turn Frosty's Capable checked off the heels of Izzy A Prince. Entering the home straight Adam's Lilly and Tom Tom Drum bumped. Approaching the finish Platinum Cye, Adam's Lilly, Tom Tom Drum and Hello Birdy bumped. Runout Babe underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have muscle sheath damage to the gracilis. Runout Babe has been stood down from racing for a period of 21 days.

RACE 7 – GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP – INV – 515 METRES

Bobby Bound was slow out. Soon after the start, Quiet Bay and Drum Grohl bumped. At the same time Coffee Elizabeth and Wynburn Toozy bumped. Approaching the first turn Lady Rappa and Drum Grohl bumped and, as a result, both greyhounds raced wide rounding the first turn. On the second turn Wynburn Toozy, Coffee Elizabeth and Bobbie Bound bumped, checking Coffee Elizabeth and Wynburn Toozy. Entering the home straight, Wynburn Toozy and Lady Rappa bumped. Lady Rappa underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. Tax Man Wins underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the greyhound to have a fracture to the tail. Tax Man wins has been stood down from racing for a period of 14 days.

RACE 8 – LAUNCESTON VETERINARY HOSPITAL – GRADE 5(2) – 515 METRES

Vrontios and Cash Money were slow out. In the front straight Cheeky Ella and Aware bumped. At the same time Ramsey De Kahn and Harry Steiger bumped. Approaching the first turn Vrontios, Cash Money, Cheeky Ella and Aware bumped, checking Cash Money, Cheeky Ella and Aware. As a result, Aware galloped on the heels of Ramsey De Kahn. On the home turn Vrontios and Scruffy Squaw bumped. Cash Money underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. Aware underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected.

RACE 9 – WINNING EDGE KIBBLE GRADUATION/TRIAL QUALIFYING SERIES – MIXED 4/5 – 515 METRES

Inanna Star, Brusha Borne and Real Stylist were slow out. In the front straight Inanna Star and Brusha Borne bumped, checking Inanna Star. Approaching the first turn Brusha Borne checked off the heels of Almachino. At the same time, Inanna Star and Satin Stylist bumped. Entering the back straight Real Stylist and Tah Jen bumped, checking Tah Jen. Brusha Borne underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected.

RACE 10 – WAYNE GROVES AUTOMOTIVE – GRADE 5(3) – 515 METRES

Platinum Judy and Bulla's Boy were slow out. On the first turn Bridwood Goldy, Nebraska Beach and Demon Lad bumped, checking Demon Lad. On the second turn Nebraska Beach crossed to the rail, checking Bridwood Goldy and Bigtime To Excel. Approaching the home turn Nebraska Beach checked off the heels of Suzy La Rue. On the home turn and in the home straight Bigtime To Excel marred the running of Suzy La Rue and, as a result, Nebraska Beach was hampered. Bigtime To Excel underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury could be detected. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr D Polley in relation to the race manner of Bigtime To Excel rounding the home turn and in the home straight. Acting on their own observations, viewing the official replays and taking evidence from Mr Polley, Stewards were of the opinion that Bigtime To Excel had turned its head inwards and made head and muzzle contact with Suzy La Rue on several occasions and, in doing so, marred the running of that greyhound pursuant to GAR 69(1). Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(2)(a) Bigtime To Excel has been stood down from racing for a period of 28 days at Launceston and until the completion of a satisfactory trial.
