

STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

RACE 1 – TASMANIAN ST LEGER MAY 21ST MAIDEN – 1220 METRES

Majestic Bow – At the turn into the straight shifted outwards carrying Pura Vida and I Feel Love wide. Jockey A. Darmanin was reprimanded under AR 137 (a) for careless riding for allowing his mount to shift out when not clear.

Brundah Bob – Warning was issued to Trainer Mr D Brazendale regarding the loading manners of this gelding. Ms S Maher was reminded of her obligations in the use of the whip when her mount is out of contention.

Mystic Molly – Passing the 800M checked.

I Feel Love – Raced wide throughout. Carried wide at the turn into the straight. Returned with a laceration to the near knee. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to the mare starting in a race again.

Pura Vida – Carried wide at the turn into the straight.

Movido – Slow to begin.

Sarmady – Approaching the 700M restrained off the heels of Majestic Bow and lost ground when the pace eased.

Stewards inquired into the reason for Mystic Molly (G. Catania) checking near the 800 metres. Jockey B. Muchu was found guilty to a charge of careless riding pursuant to AR 137 (a) for allowing his mount to shift in near the 800 metres when not clear of Mystic Molly causing that mare to check. Jockey B. Muchu was suspended from riding in races for a period of one (1) race meeting effective from mid-night 17 April 2017 to mid-night 23 April 2017. In arriving at this penalty Stewards took into account Jockey Muchu's good riding record.

RACE 2 – LUXBET MAIDEN /CL1 – 2130 METRES

Quaternion Eagle – A post-race veterinary examination revealed that the gelding had severed an off hind superficial flexor tendon and was consequently euthanised.

Eastender – Slow to begin.

Akbar Jay – Restrained near the 1800 metres. Inconvenienced passing the 500 metres.

Fought For – Over raced passing the winning post the first time.

Sir Valentine – Over raced passing the winning post the first time.

Gee Gee Mistachips – Raced wide early.

New Release – Approaching the 500 metres was disappointed for a run between Matiano and Quaternion Eagle.

Stewards inquired into the injury suffered by Quaternion Eagle (S. Thornton) near the 1800metres. It was established that at this stage of the race the pace had eased and New Release (M. Ulucinar) had commenced to race keenly. Jockey M. Ulucinar had attempted to settle New Release but the gelding struck Quaternion Eagle above the off hock. The Stewards deemed it to be a race incident.

RACE 3 – NORTHERN HUNT CLUB BM62 HCP – 1620 METRES

Strathalbyn – Commenced awkwardly. When questioned regarding the disappointing performance the rider, Mr B McCoull explained that the gelding had a tendency to over race in the early and middle stages and as a consequence he shifted wide to settle the gelding, however when placed under pressure did not run on.

RACE 4 – MARSHALL BATTERIES CLASS 5 HCP – 1220 METRES

Prior to correct weight the rider of the second horse jockey A Darmanin requested to view the photo finish print.

Apriano – Lay out in the straight.

Gee Gee Spitfire – Rider Ms S Carr advised the Stewards that the gelding did not feel free in its action and as a consequence she eased the gelding down. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Lazy Democracy – Bumped on jumping. Held up approaching the 400 metres.

Astro Miss – Proved extremely difficult to load. As a consequence, trainer Mr S Davis was advised that the mare would be required to trial prior to starting in a race again. Bumped heavily with Lazy Democracy on jumping and shortly after commenced to over race getting its head in the air.

RACE 5 – SENIORS FESTIVAL RACEDAY IN JUNE CLASS 1 HCP – 1220 METRES

Gee Gees Free Hero – Raced ungenerously throughout. Steadied approaching the 800 metres when held tight by Mariah's Magic on its outside. After this Gee Gees Free Hero commenced to over race. On pulling up the rider dismounted and a subsequent veterinary examination revealed a fracture to the distal off hind femur. Gee Gees Free Hero was euthanised. When questioned jockey Ms S Carr advised that the gelding had never felt comfortable throughout and had shifted ground constantly.

Mariah's Magic – The rider was questioned in relation to the filly being ridden forward tonight. Apprentice Ms S Thornton explained that it was her intention to settle mid field however the filly had commenced well and was racing keenly and under those circumstances she elected to go forward.

Gemini – Raced wide throughout.

Can't Decide – Slow into stride. Restrained approaching the 1000 metres when tightened by Gee Gees Free Hero.

RACE 6 – RELAY FOR LIFE BM72 HCP – 1420 METRES

O'Reillys Geegee (NZ) – The whip of rider Ms G Catania snapped during the running of this race.

Dangerpet – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – SKY/ATA TRAINER’S TRUST CLASS 2 HCP – [DISTANCE] METRES

Impulsive Lager – Rider Ms S Carr reported that the gelding did not handle the track conditions.

Appmat – Commenced to race keenly getting its head up passing the 1200 metres.

Qui Samer – Collided on jumping between Life’s Quest and Appmat with the rider becoming extremely unbalanced.

Princess Atilla – Proved extremely difficult to load and as a consequence Trainer Mr M Trinder was advised that the mare would be required to trial satisfactory before starting in a race again.

RACE 8 – CANCER COUNCIL TASMANIA BM72 HCP – 2130 METRES

Son Of Faith – Over race in the early and middle stages.

Divine Denoa – Buffeted on jumping between Hyperbole and Son Of Faith.

Follow My Dust – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Bumped with Treat Me Right close to the winning post.

Treat Me Right – Bumped close to winning post.
