RACE 1 – LENDING 4U 3YO MAIDEN – 1150 METRES

Brundah Bob – Proved difficult to load. Connections were advised the gelding must complete a satisfactory official trial before racing again. Slow into stride.

Century Arrow – Laid in passing the 300 metres and brushed with Chase And Status.

Gee Gee Pureblonde – Shifted in approaching the 200 metres. Rider B McCoull was advised to make every effort to ensure he keeps his mounts straight in future.

Midnight Quest – Commenced awkwardly and lost ground. Restrained approaching the 200 metres. When questioned Apprentice N Punch advised that he had anticipated a run to the inside of Annie's Shiraz with the run not eventuating. Apprentice Punch was advised that in future he was to ensure he has sufficient room before attempting to take a run.

The Financier – Over raced early.

Amber In Paris – Raced wide throughout. Rider D Pires was fined \$100 under AR 144 in that he failed to weigh in for fourth place.

Annie's Shiraz – Carried inwards approaching the 200 metres by Gee Gee Pureblonde. Rider accidentally dropped his whip near the 400 metres.

RACE 2 – WILLIAM STREET MEATS PTY LTD MAIDEN – 900 METRES

Classic Western – Bumped with **Gasnier** passing the 600 metres.

Kangarello – Raced wide throughout.

Smell The Honey – Slow into stride.

Gasnier – Laid in in the home straight.

Orange Encounter – Fractious in the barriers. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the filly for her barrier manners.

Southern Belle – Steadied approaching the 600 metres.

Sunset Streaker – Jumped awkwardly. Raced wide throughout. Passing the 200 metres steadied away from the heels of **I'm A Lucky Girl** and in doing so over reacted, getting its head in the air.

Treme – Slow into stride.

I'm A Lucky Girl – Rider C Luttrell reported that the filly laid out throughout.

RACE 3 – MOTHER'S DAY HIGH TEA AT SPREYTON MAIDEN – 1650 METRES

Red Amoure – Just prior to a start being effected, the gelding lunged forward becoming wedged under the front barrier gate. After eventually being removed was declared a late scratching at 2.27 pm by order of Stewards. Prior to declaring correct weight Stewards ordered all monies invested to be refunded. There were no betting deductions applicable. Connections were advised that Red Amoure must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have swelling on both sides of its neck. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate must be submitted prior to Red Amoure racing again.

Super Leane – Raced wide throughout.

Totally Wicked – Laid out throughout.

Shivida – Laid out in the home straight.

Blushing Pink – Caught wide in the early stages.

Costly Affair – Rider B McCoull reported that the mare raced ungenerously throughout.

Courte Choux – Connections submitted a veterinary certificate passing the filly fit to race today.

RACE 4 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

The Austrian Oak – Raced wide throughout.

Airlie Magic – Shifted in abruptly approaching the 200 metres.

Gee Gees Cool Gal – Commenced awkwardly.

Gemini – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Inclined to lay out over the final 100 metres.

Jansz – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Pelagia – Rider B McCoull was granted permission to ride ½ kg over the allotted weight (55.5kg). Inconvenienced at the start. When questioned rider B McCoull explained that he had anticipated to be further forward today. However, after receiving interference at the start he was placed in a rearward position. He further stated that the filly failed to accelerate when put under pressure but had worked home well in the straight.

RACE 5 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE CLASS 4 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

Blaze Forth - Rider Chris Graham was reprimanded under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 7 occasions prior to the 100 metres. In assessing penalty Stewards took into consideration the totality of his whip use in the race and his record under the rule.

Speckie – Laid in in the home straight.

Charlemagne's Girl – Raced wide in the early stages. Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Rearview – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Raced wide throughout.

Can't Decide – Slow into stride (1L).

Tambro's Game – Laid in over the final 100 metres. Rider Sigrid Carr pleaded guilty to a charge under AR 137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on 7 occasions prior to the 100 metres. In assessing penalty Stewards took into consideration the totality of her whip use in the race and her record under the rule.

and suspended Ms Carr for one (1) Tasmanian race meeting to commence at midnight 23 April 2017 and to expire at midnight 30 April 2017.

RACE 6 – HARDING’S HOTMIX EASTER CUP BM72 HANDICAP – 1650 METRES

Shiralee – Connections advised that the gelding would be ridden further forward today. The gelding was ridden accordingly.

Schillie Billie – Commenced awkwardly. When questioned rider Troy Baker explained that the mare over raced and in his opinion failed to run out the distance.

RACE 7 – LUXBET BM68 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

Steel Moon – Passing the 200 metres was momentarily tightened for room between Meconsul which shifted in and Dalehill which shifted out.

Gee Gees Style – Stumbled shortly after the start. Rider Sherry Barr reported that the gelding returned with its tongue over the bit.

King’s Spirit – Laid in in the home straight.

Crystal Flame – Inconvenienced on jumping.

Lonhwan – Became fractious in the barriers prior to the start and reared before getting its off side hind leg caught on the barrier sideboard. After being removed the gelding was declared a late scratching at 4.47pm acting on veterinary advice. Prior to correct weight being declared Stewards ordered all monies invested on Lonhwan to be refunded. Deductions of four cents for the win and five cents for the place were ordered. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate must be submitted prior to Lonhwan racing again and must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again.

Manna Trust – Underwent a veterinary examination prior to racing today as it had not raced for over 12 months and was passed fit to race.
