Comments / Explanations:

Trainer John Blacker was fined \$50 under LR 13.3 for the late notification of riders on his runners in Races 1, 2 and 7.

Trainer Rowan Hamer was fined \$50 under LR 13.3 for the late notification of riders on his runners in Races 2, 4 and 6.

Trainer Angela Brakey was reprimanded under LR 13.3 for the late notification of rider for Hushhama in Race 9.

Apprentice Sherry Barr was advised that she must submit a medical certificate and undergo a concussion test prior to riding trackwork, trials or races.

RACE 1 – LIVE STREAMING ON TASRACING.COM.AU 2YO MAIDEN– 1000 METRES

Double You Tee – Difficult to load. Connections advised warning has been issued.

Silver Road – Laid in over the final 50 metres and had to be restrained off the heels of Need A Queen.

City of Dreams – Laid in in the home straight.

Future Skies – Rider S Amano explained that in his opinion the filly failed to handle the synthetic surface.

Gee Gees Liberty – Jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride (2L).

Need A Queen – Underwent a veterinary examination behind the barriers which revealed a loose temporary incisor.

RACE 2 – TASRACING OFF THE TRACK MAIDEN– 1000 METRES

A number of runners proved slightly difficult to load and fractious in the barriers. Due to the late scratching's and delay to the start Stewards took no further action other than to advise trainers that they would be monitoring the horses' manners in future.

Cimarron's Hero – Jumped inwards at the start bumping with the hind quarters of Orange Encounter. Approaching the 300 metres had to steady off the heels of Orange Encounter which was inclined to lay out and then shifted wider on the track. Approaching the 100 metres layed in under pressure.

Classic Western – Raced wide throughout. Performed below expectations. Rider B McCoull stated that due to being caught wide and the tempo of the race the gelding failed to finish off. He further added that in his opinion the gelding may be better suited to further distance.

Great Expectation – Proved difficult to load. Laid in under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Almighty Attitude – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced for 12 months and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Declared a late scratching at 12.31 pm acting on veterinary advice after it became fractious and reared in the barriers hitting its head resulting in bleeding to the left nostril. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested prior to 12.31 pm be refunded in full. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the mare's barrier manners.

Egalitarian – Declared a late scratching at 12.27 pm by order of Stewards after the rider was harmlessly dislodged and the gelding galloped free for some distance. Prior to the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested prior to 12.27 pm be refunded in full.

Orange Encounter – Reared in the barriers prior to the start. Approaching the 100 metres layed in under pressure.

Divine Plan – Held up over the concluding stages behind the tiring Royal Mouk.

RACE 3 – ALPINE EAGLE @ ARMIDALE STUD MAIDEN– 1350 METRES

Hawthorn – When questioned on the tactics adopted rider Troy Baker explained that he was instructed to have the gelding in a forward position. Troy Baker added that after beginning only fairly he then rode aggressively to fulfil his instructions however the gelding commenced to over-race so he then elected to take up the lead. Troy Baker further stated that the gelding then settled well and raced in a good rhythm between the 900 metres and 500 metres before commencing to weaken. Trainer Angela Brakey confirmed these instructions. Mrs Brakey added that it had been connections intentions to ride the gelding more positively in its last preparation however due to circumstances these tactics were unable to be fulfilled. Mrs Brakey further added that it would be the intention to ride the gelding in a similar manner in future. Mrs Brakey was advised of her obligations under AR.135A if she intends to alter the riding tactics of her runners.

The Financier – Approaching the 400 metres was held up for clear racing room behind the tiring Hawthorn. Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Pura Vida – Approaching the 400 metres was held up for clear racing room behind the tiring Hawthorn.

Annie's Shiraz – Inclined to lay in in the home straight.

Bailee's Moshe – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Jubilance – Proved difficult to load. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the filly's barrier manners.

Tilmosa – Approaching the 400 metres was held up for clear racing room behind the tiring Hawthorn.

Tipperary Mary – Declared a late scratching at 7.45 am by Order of Stewards. Stewards intend to inquire into this matter with Trainer Tegan Keys.

RACE 4 – GORACINGTASMANIA.COM.AU MAIDEN/CLASS 1 DIV 1 – 1650 METRES

Please Dance – Over raced in the early stages. Approaching the 200 metres was tightened for room between The Austrian Oak and It's A Battle which was laying in.

The Austrian Oak – Over raced in the early stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Performed below expectations. Rider Shiralee Maher explained that in her opinion the gelding failed to handle the synthetic surface.

It's A Battle – Jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride (1L). Layed in in the home straight. Rider Chris Graham was advised to exercise more care and reminded that he must stop riding and straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

Parisian Lush – Rider Ismail Toker stated that he elected to roll forward after the mare was caught wide in the early stages and over raced.

Jansz – Jumped in at the start and bumped with Broadway Velvet.

Bossy Bron – Declared a late scratching at 1:45pm acting on veterinary advice when the mare became fractious and kicked out on numerous occasions striking the barrier stalls resulting in lameness to the near hind leg. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate must be submitted and the mare will be required to complete a satisfactory trial before racing again.

RACE 5 – LUXBET MAIDEN/CLASS 1 DIV 2– 1650 METRES

Kryptonian – Rounding the home turn, inconvenienced and carried wider on the track by the riderless Super Leane.

Vallegrande – Rounding the home turn, inconvenienced and carried wider on the track by the riderless Super Leane.

Fought For – Approaching the finish line, inconvenienced when tightened for room by the riderless Super Leane.

Sir Valentine – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

Super Leane – Knuckled severely on jumping and almost fell dislodging rider Sherry Barr. Sherry Barr was examined by the on course ambulance officers and stood down from her remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the left fore bumper.

Total Control – Jumped away awkwardly. Inconvenienced after the start by the riderless Super Leane.

Totally Wicked – Inconvenienced when leading between the 1000 metres and 600 metres by the riderless Super Leane. Rounding the home turn, inconvenienced and carried wider on the track by the riderless Super Leane.

Aljazmic – Approaching the finish line, inconvenienced when tightened for room by the riderless Super Leane. Layed out in the early part of the home straight.

Pelagia – Approaching the finish line, inconvenienced when tightened for room by the riderless Super Leane. Rider B McCoull was reminded of his obligations regarding the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres. Stewards took into account that Pelagia was being hampered by a riderless horse.

RACE 6 – BIRDCAGE TAVERN CLASS 1 HANDICAP– 1150 METRES

Correct weight was delayed while Stewards viewed the film of the start with respect to Lonhwan. After doing so the gelding was declared a starter.

Cranbrook – Rider B McCoull reported that the gelding hung in throughout the race.

Majestic Bow – Attended to by the farrier behind the barriers prior to the start. The start was delayed when the gelding had to be re-shod. Approaching the 600 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of Cranbrook which was inclined to lay in and as a result Gee Gees Talk Fest which was following had to be steadied. Rider Chris Graham was severely reprimanded under AR 137(a) careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift ground outwards abruptly near the 100 metres when insufficiently clear of Lads Curfew.

Christopher Mac – Inconvenienced at the start between Lads Curfew and Strategic Moves which jumped inwards. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor abrasions to the right fore leg and left hind leg.

Meteor Strike – Unbalanced on jumping when bumped by Westerly Haze.

Jacques – Held up for clear racing room between the 400 and 300 metres.

Lads Curfew – Passing the 100 metres, restrained off the heels of Majestic Bow (Chris Graham) which shifted out when not clear.

Gee Gee Pureblonde – Jumped away awkwardly.

Lonhwan – Reared as the gates opened and missed the start (10L). Connections were advised that the gelding must complete two consecutive satisfactory trials before racing again.

RACE 7 – LUXBET CLASS 5 HANDICAP – 1150 METRES

O'Lonh Star – Got its head up when being restrained approaching the 800 metres. Layed in in the home straight. Performed below expectations. Rider D Pires stated that the gelding was left flat footed when the pace quickened from the 400 and failed to respond to his riding from that point.

Blaze Forth – Got its head up when being restrained approaching the 800 metres.

Concentrate – Had to be re-saddled behind the barriers. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Rearview – Jumped away awkwardly.

Commanding Dash – Over raced in the early stages.

RACE 8 – SIMONS DESIGN CENTRE BM62 HANDICAP – 1880 METRES

Eastender – Bumped with Treat Me Right on jumping away. Rider B McCoull advised that the gelding layed in throughout.

Princess Atilla – Approaching the 100 metres was restrained when tightened for room between Shiralee (N Punch) which was taken out by Ruby's Wu (S Maher) when tiring and Mystic Spirit (B Muhcu) which was inclined to lay in. All riders were advised to exercise more care when allowing their mounts to shift ground.

Ruby's Wu – Jumped out at the start inconveniencing Toakio Tower.

RACE 9 – DEVONPORT MOTHER’S DAY HIGH TEA CLASS 3 HANDICAP – 1350 METRES

Storm Gust – Stood flat footed and was slow into stride (approximately 5L). Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the gelding.

Speranta – Over raced in the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover.

Charlemagne’s Girl – Inconvenienced passing the 1000 metres by Speranta which was over-racing.
