On the first turn Can Bee and Keep Ya Fresh bumped soon after Keep Ya Fresh and Can Bee bumped checking Can Bee. On the home turn Beaver Creek and Can Bee bumped. In the home straight Keep Ya Fresh and Can Bee bumped. Cawbourne Dawnie raced wide in the home straight. Beaver Creek underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have muscle soreness to its left shoulder. Beaver Creek has been stood down from racing for a period of 5 days. Can Bee underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have muscle soreness left tensor fasciae. Can Bee was stood down from racing for a period of 5 days. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr R Ransley in relation to the racing manners of Can Bee on the home turn and entering the home straight. Acting on their own observations, viewing the official replays and taking evidence from Mr Ransley Stewards were of the opinion that Can Bee had turned its head outwards and made head and muzzle contact with Beaver Creek and by doing so had marred the running of that greyhound pursuant to GAR 69(1). Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(2)(a) Can Bee has been stood down from racing for a period of 28 days at Launceston only and until the completion of a satisfactory trial. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr M Louth in relation to Beaver Creeks racing manners, in particular rounding the home turn and in the home straight.

Stewards were of the opinion that Kinloch Country had turned its head outwards and made head and muzzle contact with Cheeky Ella on a number of occasions and by doing so had marred the running of that greyhound pursuant to GAR 69(1). Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(2)(a) Kinloch Country has been stood down from racing for a period of 28 days at Launceston only and until the completion of a satisfactory trial.
