Trainers with multiple runners engaged in any race were questioned as to their intended driving tactics.

RACE 1 – JUBILEE BAKERY STAKES – 2200 METRES

Pre race blood samples were taken from THESE DAYS and TAURISI

An application from the connections to drive DEVIL OF TYNE (Craig Hayes) to drive that horse less aggressive was approved. The horse was caught 3 wide early and restrain to the rear of the field.

KWIATKOWSKI (Ricky Duggan) was obliged to race 3 wide early and worked forward to obtain the position outside the leader near the 1600 metres.

DEVIL OF TYNE and LORD JONES NZ (Natalee Emery) were obliged to race 3 wide early and were both restrain to the rear of the field.

Rounding the home turn BALDOCK (Gareth Rattray) hung in and had to be steadied off the sulky of LORD JONES NZ.

YAHOLYTERROR NZ (Mark Yole) returned after the race with blood present in its off side nostril. A post race Veterinary examination confirm that blood was only present in the one nostril. The horse was stood down until it completes a satisfactory official trial.

A post race sample was taken from the second placegetter ART OF MY ART.

RACE 2 – LEES ORCHARD PACE – 1680 METRES

A pre race sample was taken from IM BARNEY RUBBLE NZ

IM BARNEY RUBBLE NZ (Troy Hillier) was out of position at the start. The horse will be given its last chance in the draw. IM BARNEY RUBBLE NZ hung in shortly after the start when being restrained.

CHIRAC (Rohan Hillier) was 3 wide early and worked forward to obtain to the position outside the leader near the 1000 metres. I AM CAMELOT (Ricky Duggan) which tailed CHIRAC was left 3 wide without cover until it obtained the position outside the leader near the 800 metres. This left FERNCO BOBBY G NZ (Mark Yole) 3 wide without cover.

BURITON BAILEY NZ (Jack Laugher) which was obliged to race 3 wide commenced to give ground near the 300 metres and shifted it making contact with a marker peg.

RACE 3 – CLEGHORN STANDARDBREDS PACE DIVISION ONE – 2000 METRES

CARDINAL RINGO (Rohan Hadley) broke in the later stages of the score up, however was in position as the start was affected. No action was taken.

Passing the winning post on the first occasion CARDINAL RINGO jumped and began unbalanced and raced roughly for a stride.

PUT MBACK (Jack Laugher) raced 3 wide early and worked forward to obtain the position outside the leader near the 1600 metres.

FATHFUL JET (John Walters) left a tailing position near the 1600 metres and worked forward 3 wide to obtain the position outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

Near the 250 metres, CAPTURE ME (Rohan Hillier) hung in and away from BLACK OPS (Mark Yole), resulting in OLIVERS MATE (Allister Woods) having to be steadied off JILLIBY GIGI (Ricky Duggan).

JILLIBY GIGI was held up for clear running in the later stages of the home straight.

CARDINAL GIGI was commenced to lose ground passing the 400 metres underwent a post race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities.

A post race sample was taken from the winner DAYRAID.

RACE 4 – 6TY⁰ BANDBOX FINAL – 2200 METRES

Pre race samples were taken from JOES LITTLE GIRL, PLAYING ARKABELLA, HUIFFER and EL JAYS MYSTERY.

SUZY SHUFFLE (Nicholas Brockman) was out of position at the start despite the efforts of its driver. Given the horse racing manners it was placed out of the draw in future starts.

EL JAYS MYSTERY (Ricky Duggan) broke shortly after the start. Given the horses record its will continue out of the draw.

PLAYING ARKABELLA (Rohan Hillier) was obliged to race 3 wide early and worked forward until it obtained the position outside the leader near the 1800 metres.

SAFARI OAKEY contacted marker pegs near the 900 metres and again at the 250 metres. Driver R Hadley was issued with a reprimand pursuant to Rule 163 (1) (c).

Near the 50 metres HOLLY HALO was disappointed for a run between HUIFFIER (Barrie Rattray) and EL JAYS MYSTERY which shifted up the track slightly.

Driver T Rattray (HARSHALI) was fined \$100 pursuant to Rule 162 (1)(y) for failing to adhere to the minimum sectional times.

A post race sample was taken from the winner PLAYING ARKABELLA.

RACE 5 – KEVIN GILLIES MEMORIAL (STANDING START) – 2698 METRES

Pre race samples were taken from JANE GRANT and SCOOTERWILLREV.

SCOOTERWILLREV (Craig Hayes) galloped out at the start, then raced 3 wide and worked forward to the led approaching the 2000 metres.

HILLVIEW JAKE (Rohan Hillier) galloped out and continued to do so for some distance. The horse was given its last chance in the draw for standing starts.

LE PREMIERE (Taylor Ford) over raced in the early and middle stages.

TIMELY SOVEREIGN (John Walters) left the running line near the 1800 metres and progressed forward 3 wide until it obtained the position outside the leader passing the 1400 metres.

Near the 300 metres MAVIS MERLE (Gareth Rattray) and ANOTHER SWINGER (Mark Yole) locked sulky wheels for a short distance.

LAUGHYAHEADOFF (Allister Woods) and MUSSELROE BAY (Rodney Ashwood) both yielded ground over the final 600 metres to be beaten in excess of 100 metres with issued with their last chance to race truly.

Post race samples were taken from TIMELY SOVEREIGN and MAVIS MERLE.

RACE 6 – ROBERTS EQUINE SUPPLIES GLOBE DERBY FINAL – 220 METRES

Pre race samples were taken from MCADEM, HARJEET, WILLIAMTELL, USAIN JOLT and SEA DOUBLE UGRANT.

FIERY TURBULENCE (John Walters) was inconvenienced in the later stages of the score up by HAFTER (Gareth Rattray) which hung up.

Near the 1900 metres JOHNS LEGACY (Craig Hayes) had to be checked and contacted the sulky of WILLIAMTELL (Paul Ashwood). At a subsequent inquiry, Driver P Ashwood (WILLIAMTELL) was found guilty of a charge pursuant to Rule 163(1)(a)(iii) in that he allowed his horse to shift down the track when insufficiently clear of JOHNS LEGACY (Craig Hayes). Mr Ashwood's licence to drive in races was suspended for a period covered by 2 race meetings to commence at midnight 26 May 2017.

ROCKNROLL TURBO (Rohan Hillier) raced 3 wide and worked forward to obtain the position outside the leader near the 1700 metres.

USIAN JOLT (Ricky Duggan) raced 2 wide from the 1200 metres.

Upon entering the home straight WILLIAMTELL had to be steadied to avoid SEA DOUBLE UGRANT (Mark Yole) which shifted it. On issuing a reprimand to driver M Yole (SEA DOUBLE UGRANT) Stewards noted that SEA DOUBLE UGRANT had a tendency to hung in and Mr Yole was attempting to apply pressure to the outside rein.

Passing the 200 metres, HAFTER broke and galloped. Given the horses record a warning was issued.

A post race sample was taken from ROCKNROLL TURBO.

RACE 7 – LONGFORD EQUINE CLINIC STAKES (STANDING START) – 2200 METRES

Pre race samples were taken from WASHIES CHANCE NZ and KARALTA DAZZLER

ELECTRIC OLLIE NZ (Rohan Hillier) galloped out and lost ground. Given the horses record it was placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

BLACKJACKHANOVER (Samantha Gangell) gallop out at the start. The horse will continue out of the draw in future standing starts.

RACE 8 – ISLAND BLOCK & PAVING TWO YEAR OLD – 1680 METRES

KARALTA DEMON (Kent Rattray) broke in the score up and was out of position. KARALTA broke again near the 900 metres. The horse was stood down for 10 days and 1 satisfactory trial.

RUN WICK (Rohan Hillier) was out of position at the start. The horse was given its last chance in the draw.

ARK FURY (John Walters) hung in in the middle stage and later stages.

A post race sample was taken from the winner SIMLAN BEACH.

RACE 9 – CROWN LAGER – AUSTRALIA'S FINEST STAKES – 2200 METRES

Pre race samples were taken from KARALTA STARDUST and WHY WENT WRONG

As driver B Parker was indisposed Stewards permitted A Collins as the replacement driver on AVALON AVA. B Parker will be required to provide a medical certificate prior to driving in races.

AVALON AVA (A Collins) was out of position at the start. The horse was given its last chance in the draw.

THE SNIPERMAN (Lee Simmonds) was out of position at the start. The horse was given its last chance in the draw.

ADELE SAID (Todd Rattray) left the running line to work 3 wide near the 1800 metres.

FALCON HARRY (Ricky Duggan) also left the running line and trailed ADELE SAID until that horse obtained the position outside the leader near the 1400 metres and then it worked forward and obtained the position outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

Near the 1600 metres CHENIN VALLEY (Rohan Hillier) left the running line momentarily, however when it was unable to work forward regains its position in the running line.

Near the 150 metres FALCON HARRY shifted up the track and had to be steadied of ADELE SAID.

RACE 10 – LUXBET.COM STAKES DIVISION TWO 2200 METRES

Pre race samples were taken from THIRLSTANE KING and RILEY COYOTE

SWEET PEA JASPER (Samantha Gangell) raced 3 wide early, worked forward to obtain the position outside the leader near the 1200 metres. SWEET PEA JASPER gave ground over the final 300 metres to be beaten in excess of 60 metres. The horse was issued with its last chance to race truly. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

TISU BOMBELLE (Gareth Rattray) was held up for clear running in the early stages of the home straight.

REGAL IDEA (Hannah Van dongen) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight.

RACE 11 – MAXFIELD DRILLING PTY LTD PACE DIVISION THREE – 2200 METRES

Pre race samples were taken from JAY DUB NZ and ANIMI SUB IGNIS

ANIMI SUB IGNIS (Christian Salter) was fractious in the score up and was therefore out of position at the start. The horse will remain out of the draw in future mobile starts.

ANIMI SUB IGNIS hung in and contacted a marker peg near the 1900 metres.
